

# Word Study for --- HADAREZER





**2Sa 10:16 And Hadarezer sent, and brought out the Syrians that I were I beyond the river: and they came to Helam; and Shobach the captain of the host of Hadarezer IwentI before them.**

**2Sa 10:19 And when all the kings [that were] servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.**

**1Ch 18:03 And David smote Hadarezer  
king of Zobah unto Hamath, as he went  
to stablish his dominion by the river  
Euphrates.**

**1Ch 18:05 And when the Syrians of  
Damascus came to help Hadarezer  
king of Zobah, David slew of the  
Syrians two and twenty thousand men.**

**1Ch 18:07 And David took the shields of  
gold that were on the servants of  
Hadarezer, and brought them to  
Jerusalem.**

**1Ch 18:08 Likewise from Tibhath, and  
from Chun, cities of Hadarezer,  
brought David very much brass,  
wherewith Solomon made the brazen  
sea, and the pillars, and the vessels of  
brass.**

**1Ch 18:09 Now when Tou king of  
Hamath heard how David had smitten  
all the host of Hadarezer king of  
Zobah;**

**1Ch 18:10 He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.**

**1Ch 19:16 And when the Syrians saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they sent messengers, and drew forth the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and Shoplach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.**

**1Ch 19:19 And when the servants of Hadarezer saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they made peace with David, and became his servants: neither would the Syrians help the children of Ammon any more.**
