**Deu 29:28 And the LORD rooted them out
of their land in anger, and in wrath, and
in great indignation, and cast them into
another land, as it is this day.**

**2Ki 03:27 Then he took his eldest son
that should have reigned in his stead,
and offered him [for] a burnt offering
upon the wall. And there was great
indignation against Israel: and they
departed from him, and returned to
their own land.**

**Neh 04:01 But it came to pass, that
when Sanballat heard that we builded
the wall, he was wroth, and took great
indignation, and mocked the Jews.**

take hold of them.**




**Psa 78:49 He cast upon them the

mine indignation.**


**Isa 10:25 For yet a very little while, and

hailstones.**


**Isa 34:02 For the indignation of the

the Lord GOD.**




**Dan 08:19 And he said, Behold, I will


**Hab 03:12 Thou didst march through

against the two brethren.**




**Mat 26:8 But when his disciples saw it,
