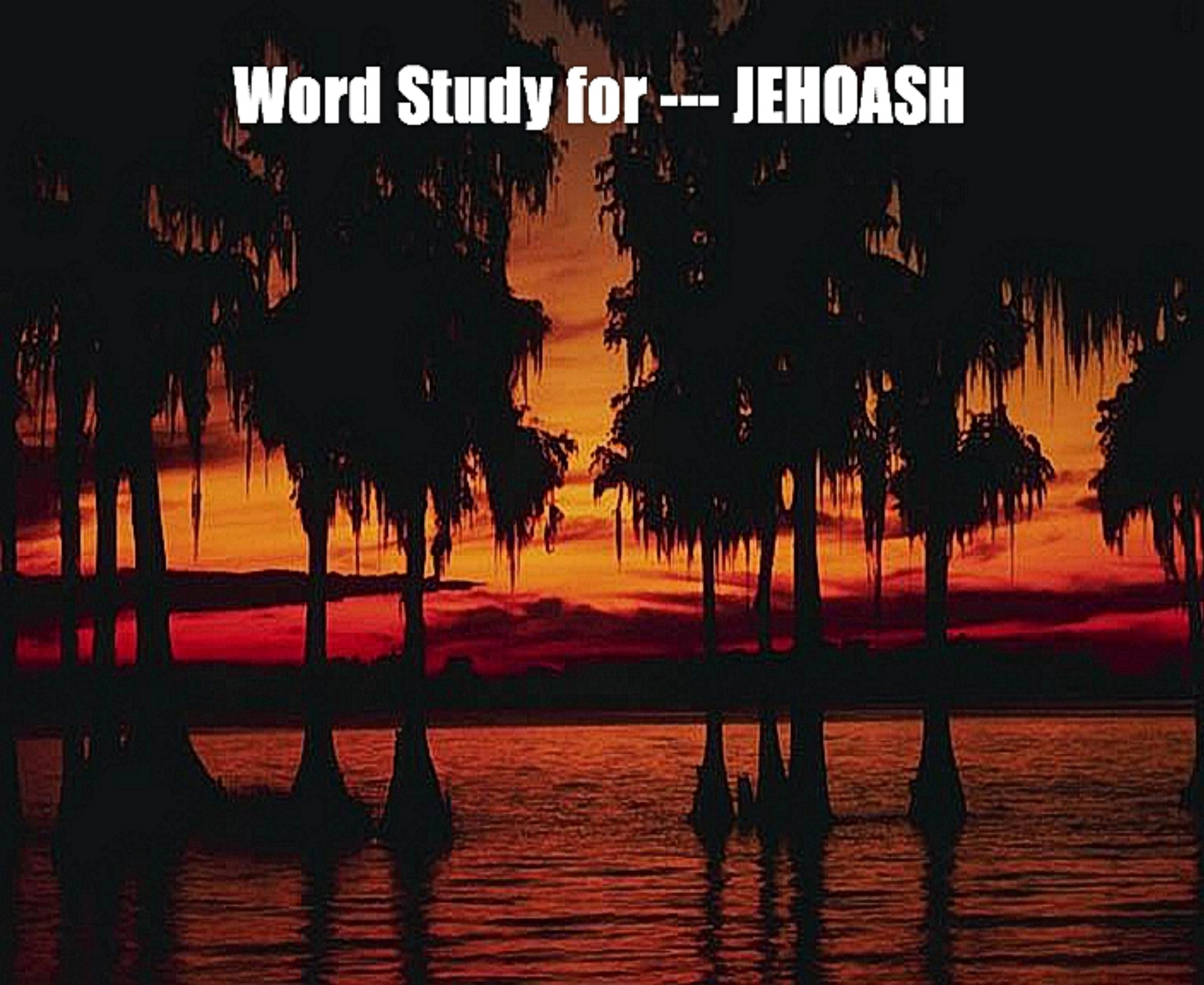

**2Ki 11:21 Seven years old [was]
Jehoash when he began to reign.**

**2Ki 12:01 In the seventh year of Jehu
Jehoash began to reign; and forty
years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his
mother's name [was] Zibiah of
Beersheba.**

**2Ki 12:02 And Jehoash did that which
was right in the sight of the LORD all
his days wherein Jehoiada the priest
instructed him.**

**2Ki 12:04 And Jehoash said to the
priests, All the money of the dedicated
things that is brought into the house
of the LORD, (even) the money of every
one that passeth (the account), the
money that every man is set at, (and)
all the money that cometh into any
man's heart to bring into the house of
the LORD,**

**2Ki 12:06 But it was [so, that] in the
three and twentieth year of king
Jehoash the priests had not repaired
the breaches of the house.**

2Ki 12:07 Then king Jehoash called for Jehoiada the priest, and the lotherl priests, and said unto them, Why repair ye not the breaches of the house? now therefore receive no l morel money of your acquaintance, but deliver it for the breaches of the house.

2Ki 12:18 And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold that was found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent it to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.


**2Ki 13:10 In the thirty and seventh year
of Joash king of Judah began Jehoash
the son of Jehoahaz to reign over
Israel in Samaria, and reigned
sixteen years.**

2Ki 13:25 And Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz took again out of the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities, which he had taken out of the hand of Jehoahaz his father by war. Three times did Joash beat him, and recovered the cities of Israel.




**2Ki 14:08 Then Amaziah sent
messengers to Jehoash, the son of
Jehoahaz son of Jehu, king of Israel,
saying, Come, let us look one another
in the face.**

2Ki 14:09 And Jehoash the king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, The thistle that I wasl in Lebanon sent to the cedar that I wasl in Lebanon, saying, Give thy daughter to my son to wife: and there passed by a wild beast that I wasl in Lebanon, and trode down the thistle.

2Ki 14:13 And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

**2Ki 14:15 Now the rest of the acts of
Jehoash which he did, and his might,
and how he fought with Amaziah king
of Judah, [are] they not written in the
book of the chronicles of the kings of
Israel?**

2Ki 14:16 And Jehoash slept with his fathers, and was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel; and Jeroboam his son reigned in his stead.

**2Ki 14:17 And Amaziah the son of Joash
king of Judah lived after the death of
Jehoash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel
fifteen years.**
