

**Jud 18:07 Then the five men departed,
and came to Laish, and saw the people
that [were] therein, how they dwelt
careless, after the manner of the
Zidonians, quiet and secure; and [
there was] no magistrate in the land,
that might put [them] to shame in [any]
thing; and they [were] far from the
Zidonians, and had no business with [
any] man.**

**Jud 18:14 Then answered the five men
that went to spy out the country of
Laish, and said unto their brethren, Do
ye know that there is in these houses
an ephod, and teraphim, and a graven
image, and a molten image? now
therefore consider what ye have to do.**

**Jud 18:27 And they took the things
which Micah had made, and the priest
which he had, and came unto Laish,
unto a people that were at quiet and
secure: and they smote them with the
edge of the sword, and burnt the city
with fire.**

**Jud 18:29 And they called the name of
the city Dan, after the name of Dan
their father, who was born unto Israel:
howbeit the name of the city I wasl
Laish at the first.**

1Sa 25:44 But Saul had given Michal his daughter, David's wife, to Phalti the son of Laish, which [was] of Gallim.

2Sa 03:15 And Ishbosheth sent, and took her from [her] husband, [even] from Phaltiel the son of Laish.
