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





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Word Study for --- LOOPS



**Exo 26:04 And thou shalt make loops
of blue upon the edge of the one
curtain from the selvedge in the
coupling; and likewise shalt thou
make in the uttermost edge of [
another] curtain, in the coupling of the
second.**



**Exo 26:05 Fifty loops shalt thou make
in the one curtain, and fifty loops shalt
thou make in the edge of the curtain
that [is] in the coupling of the second;
that the loops may take hold one of
another.**

Exo 26:10 And thou shalt make fifty loops on the edge of the one curtain [that is] outmost in the coupling, and fifty loops in the edge of the curtain which coupleth the second.



Exo 26:11 And thou shalt make fifty taches of brass, and put the taches into the loops, and couple the tent together, that it may be one.

**Exo 36:11 And he made loops of blue on
the edge of one curtain from the
selvedge in the coupling: likewise he
made in the uttermost side of [another]
curtain, in the coupling of the second.**

Exo 36:12 Fifty loops made he in one curtain, and fifty loops made he in the edge of the curtain which [was] in the coupling of the second: the loops held one [curtain] to another.

**Exo 36:17 And he made fifty loops upon
the uttermost edge of the curtain in
the coupling, and fifty loops made he
upon the edge of the curtain which
coupleth the second.**
