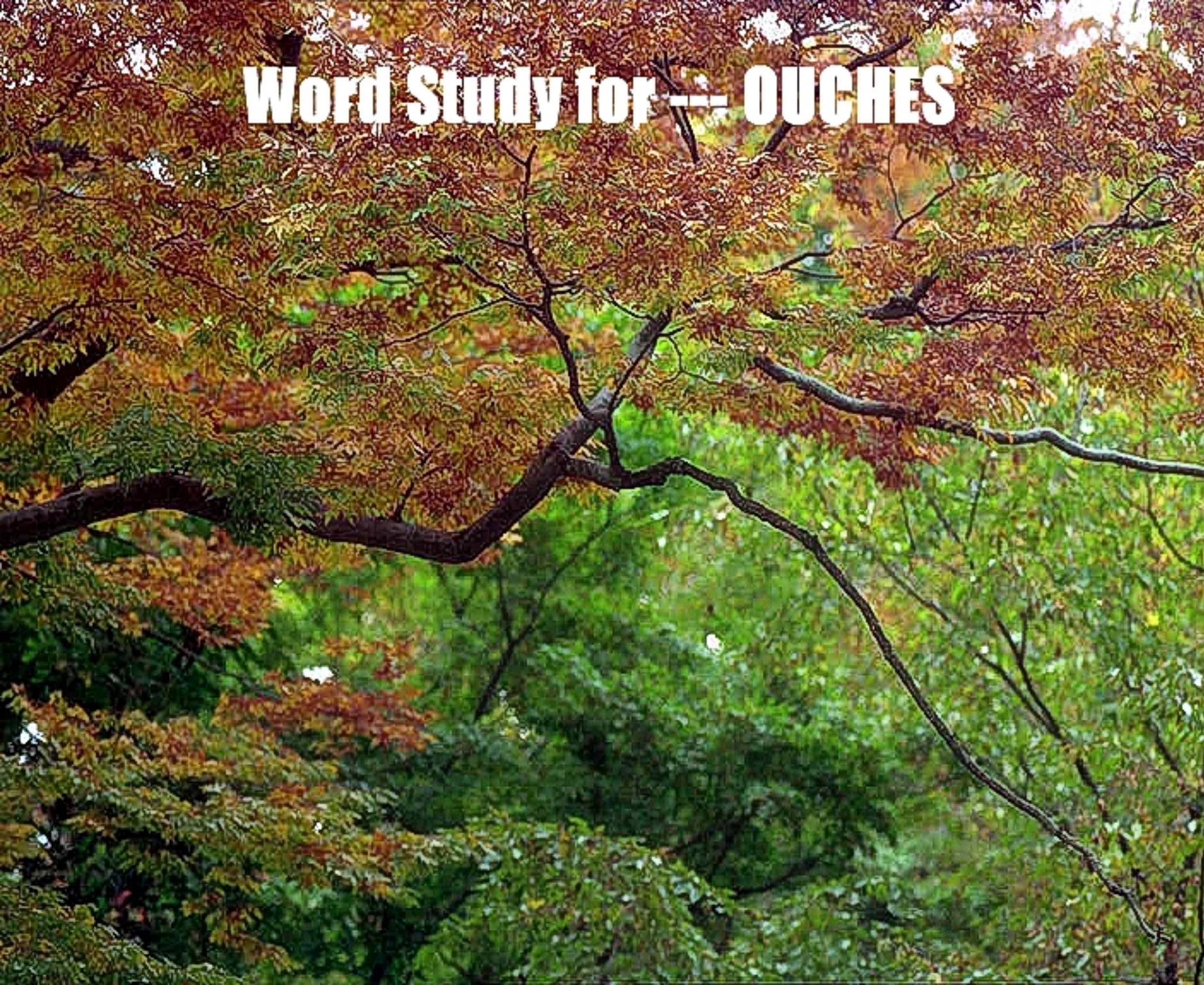



Word Study for --- OUCHES





**Exo 28:11 With the work of an engraver
in stone, [like] the engravings of a
signet, shalt thou engrave the two
stones with the names of the children
of Israel: thou shalt make them to be
set in ouches of gold.**

**Exo 28:13 And thou shalt makeouches
of gold;**

**Exo 28:14 And two chains [of] pure gold
at the ends; [of] wreathen work shalt
thou make them, and fasten the
wreathen chains to the ouches.**

**Exo 28:25 And [the other] two ends of
the two wreathen [chains] thou shalt
fasten in the twoouches, and put [
them] on the shoulder pieces of the
ephod before it.**

Exo 39:06 And they wrought onyx stones enclosed in ouches of gold, graven, as signets are graven, with the names of the children of Israel.

**Exo 39:13 And the fourth row, a beryl,
an onyx, and a jasper: (they were)
enclosed in ouches of gold in their
enclosings.**

**Exo 39:16 And they made two ouches
of gold, and two gold rings; and put
the two rings in the two ends of the
breastplate.**

**Exo 39:18 And the two ends of the two
wreathen chains they fastened in the
two ouches, and put them on the
shoulderpieces of the ephod, before it.**
