

himself, and said, Set on bread.



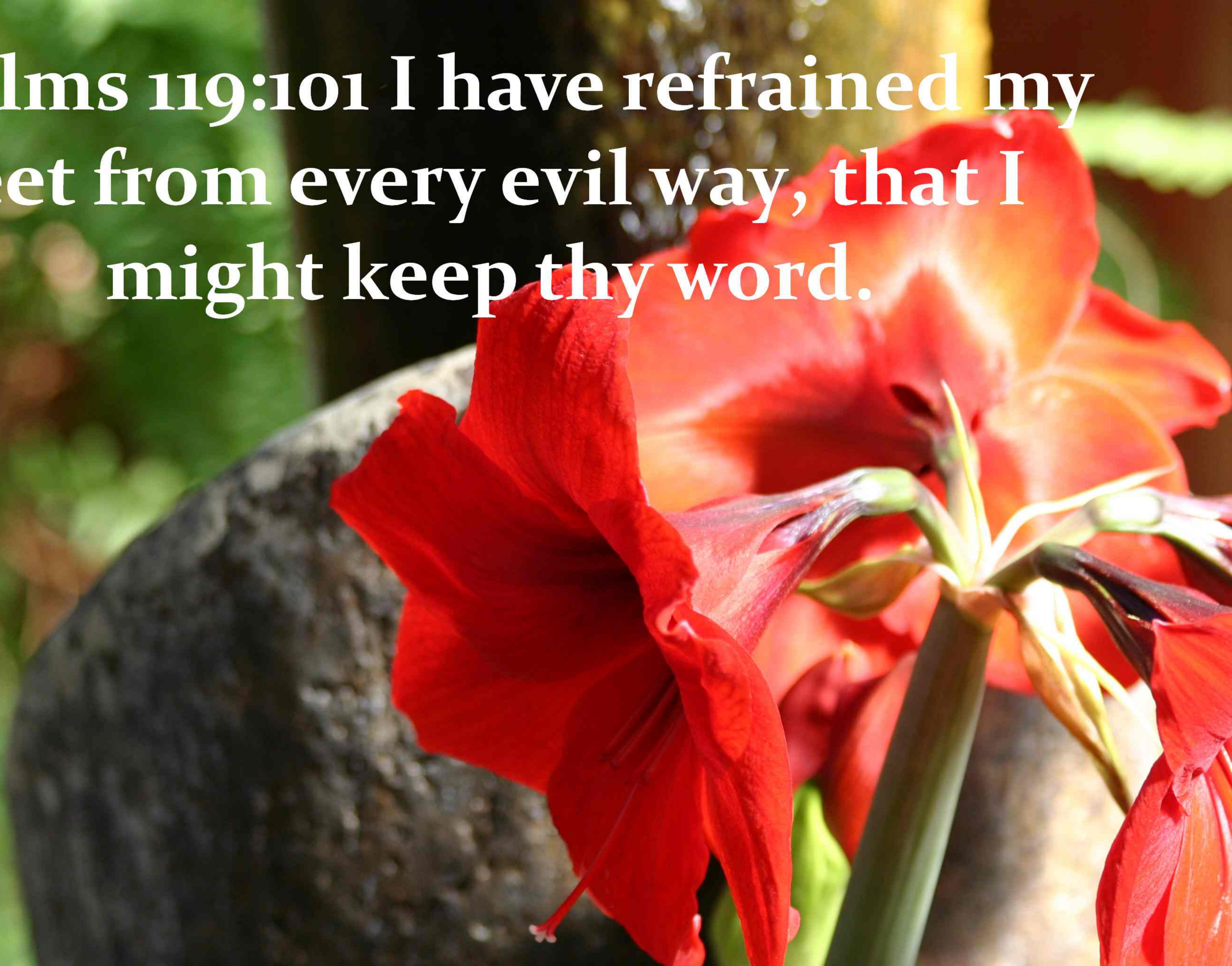

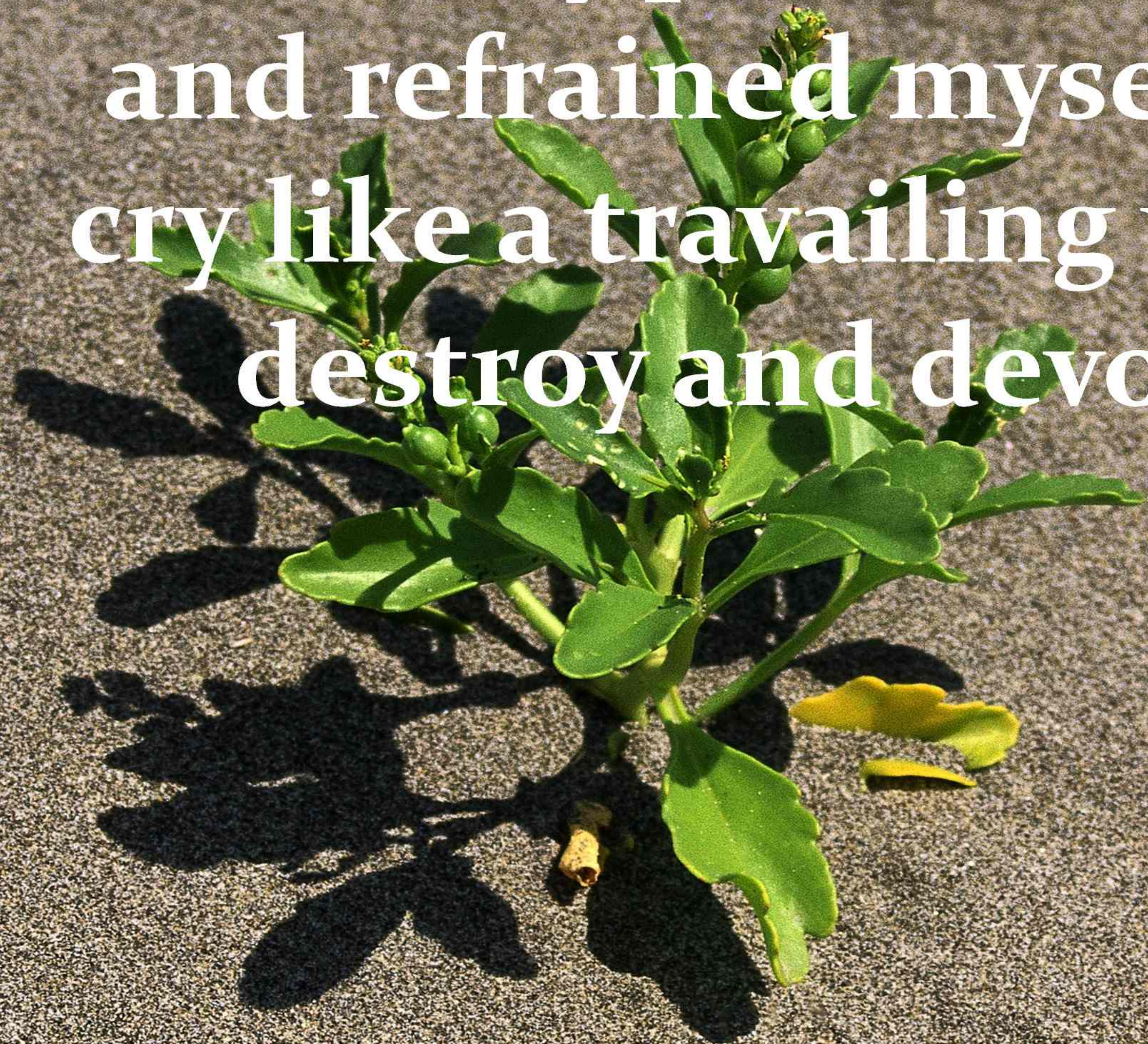




Psalms 119:101 I have refrained my
