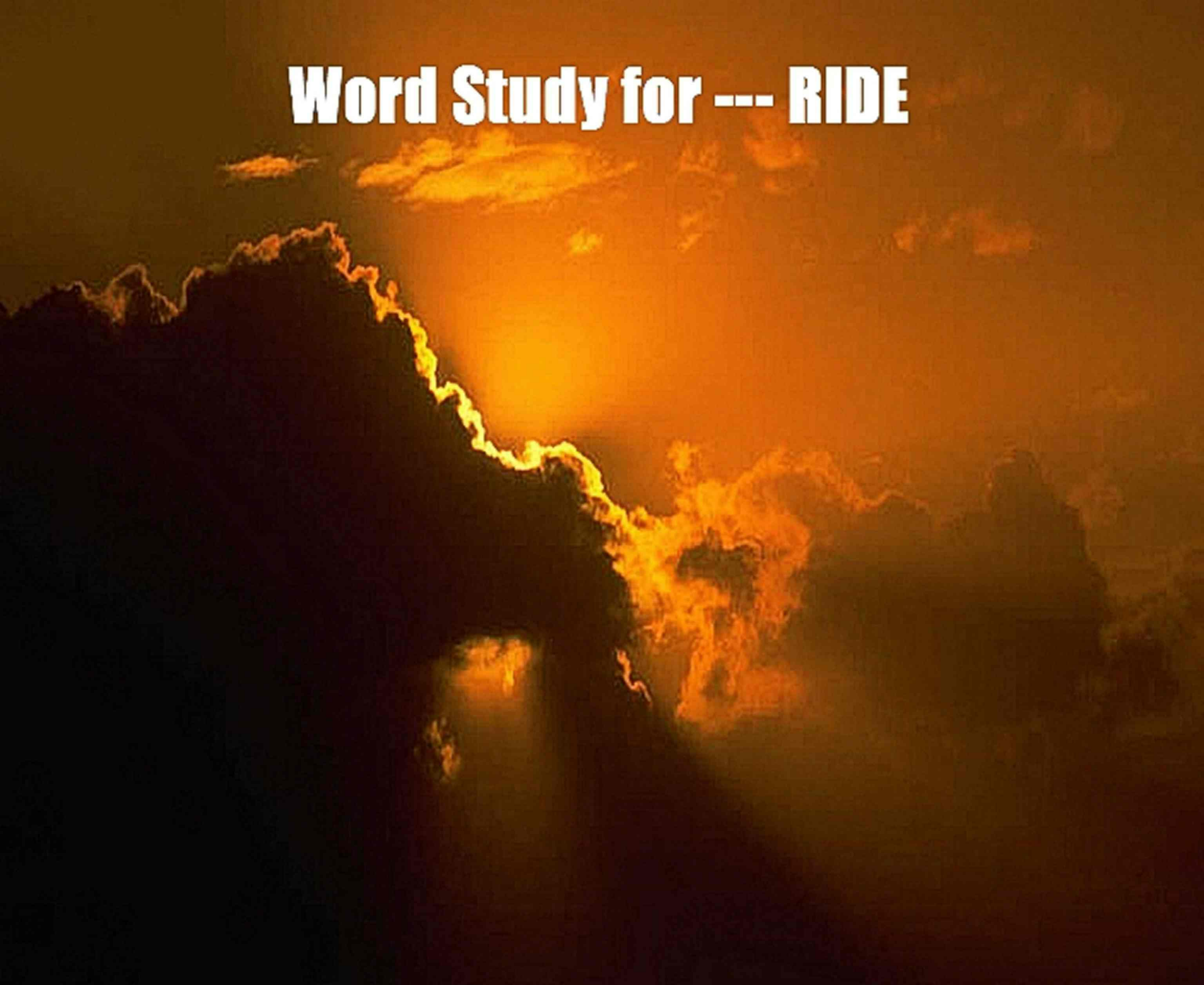
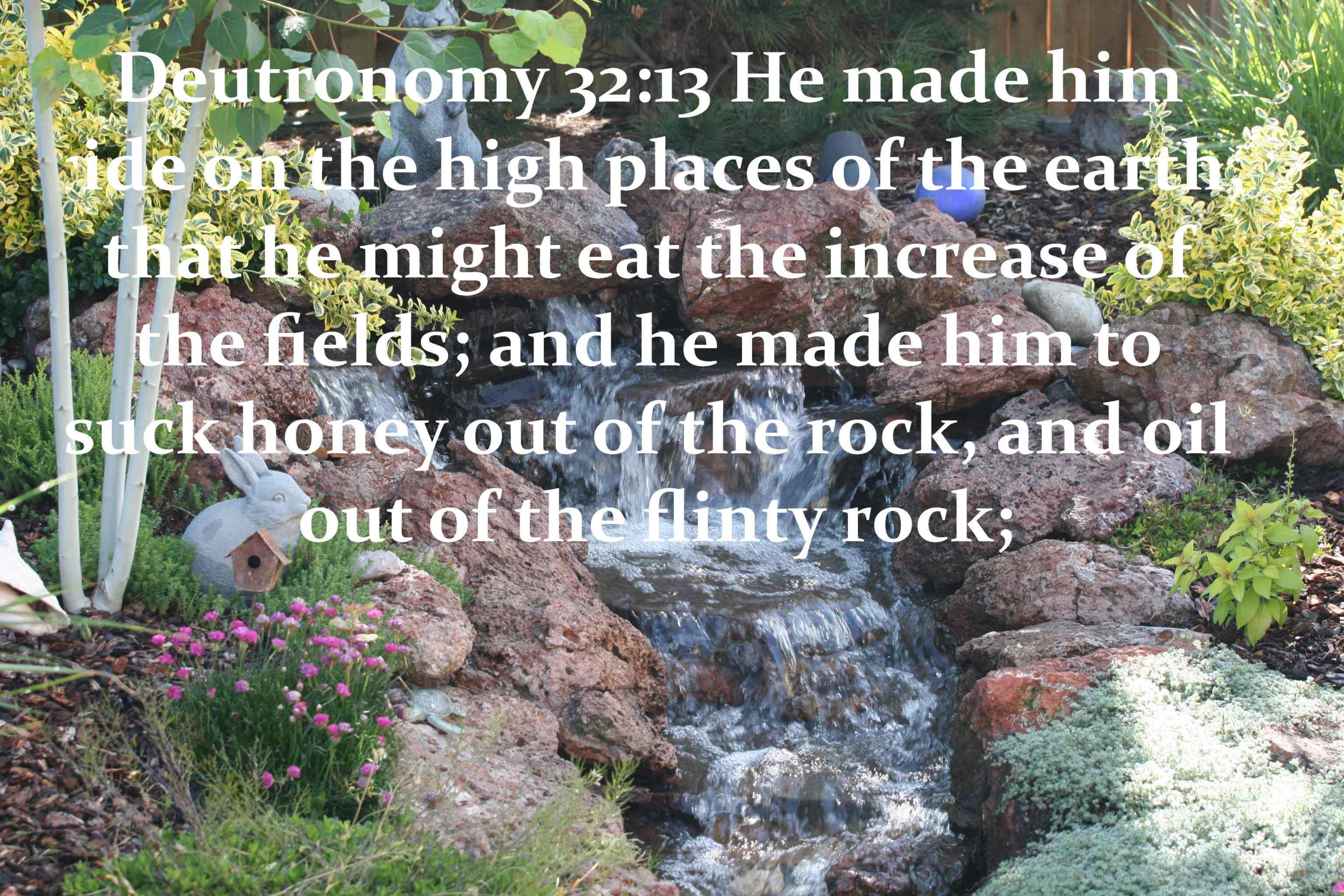

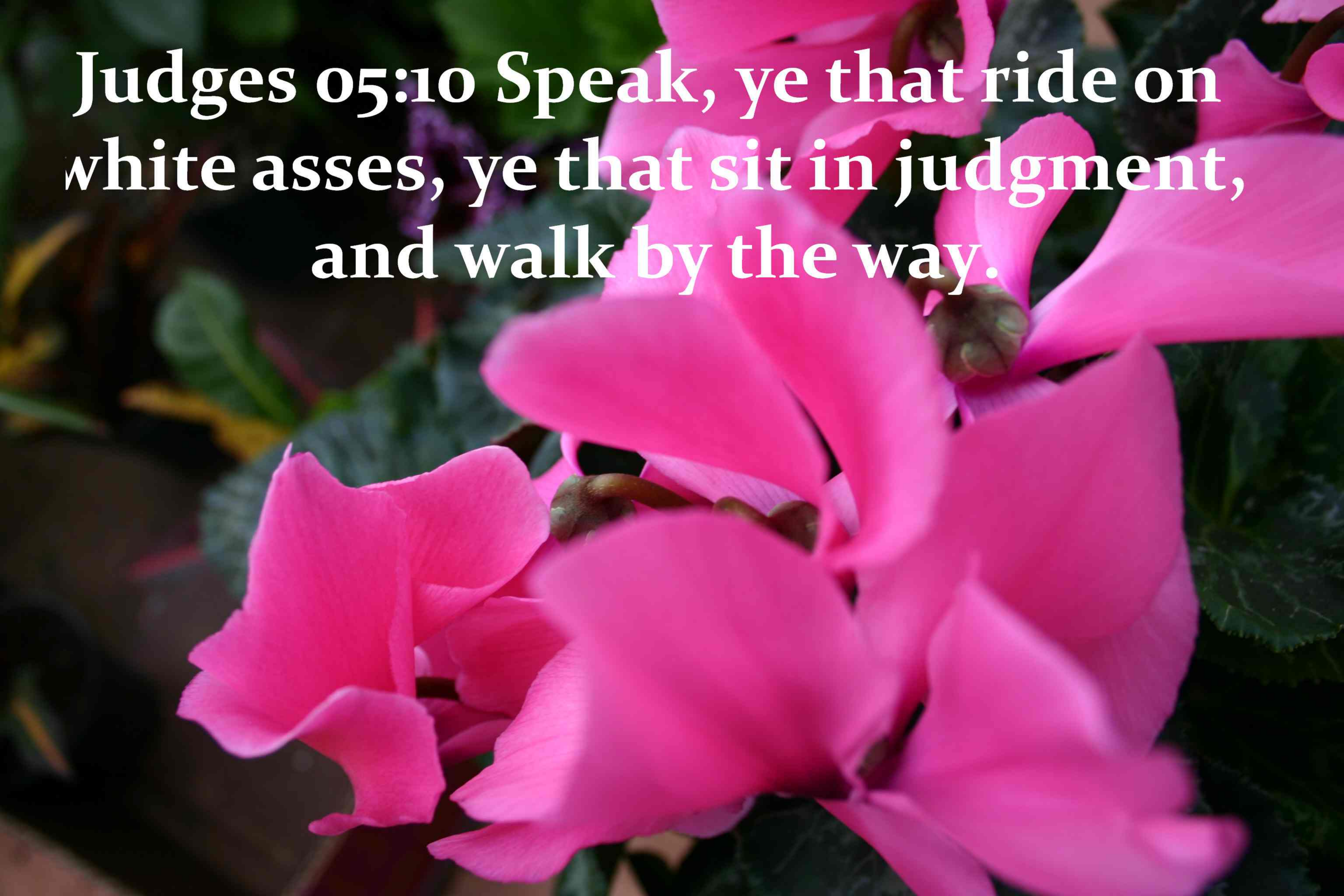


Genesis 41:43 And he made him to

ruler over all the land of Egypt.

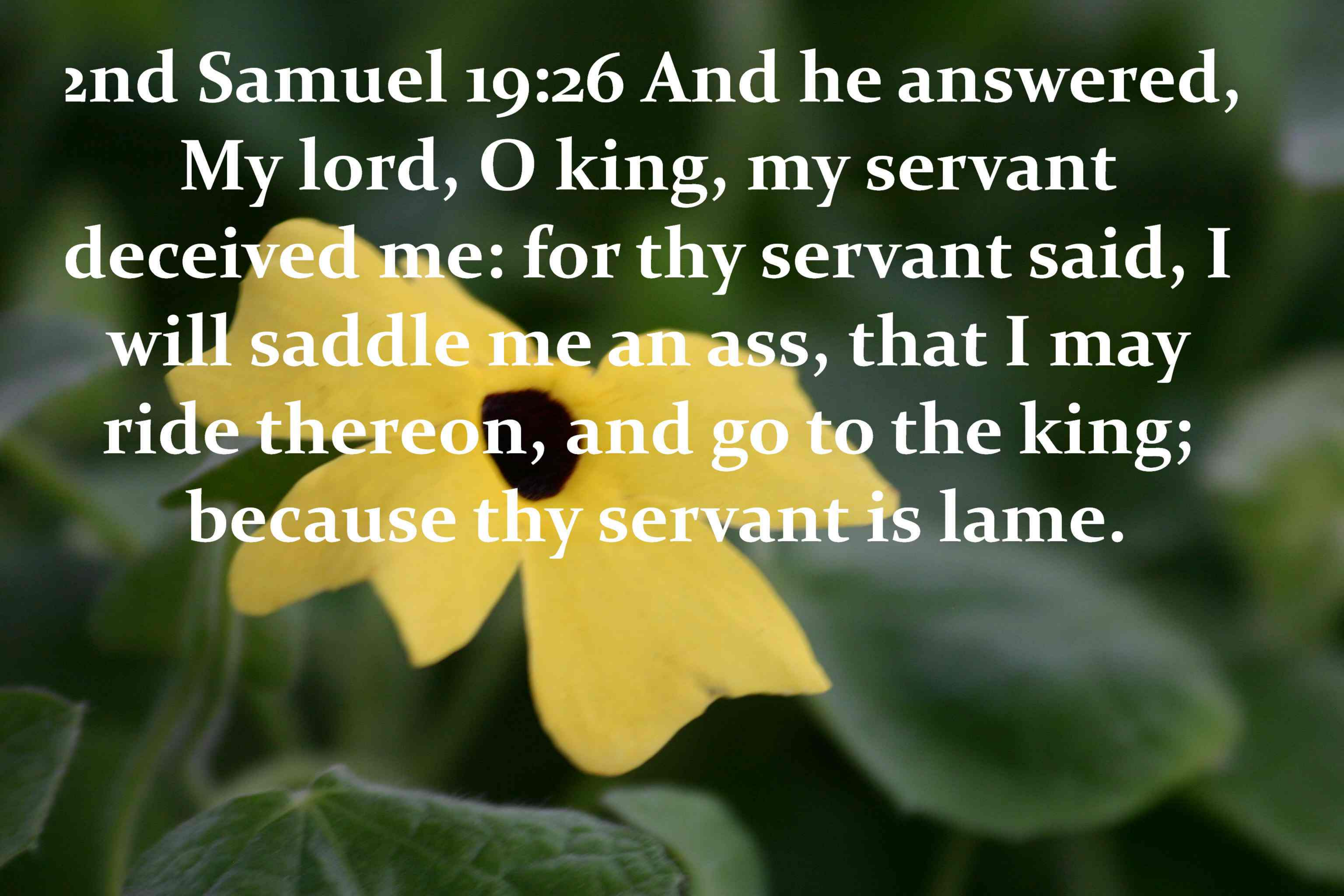


Deuteronomy 32:13 He made him

out of the flinty rock;

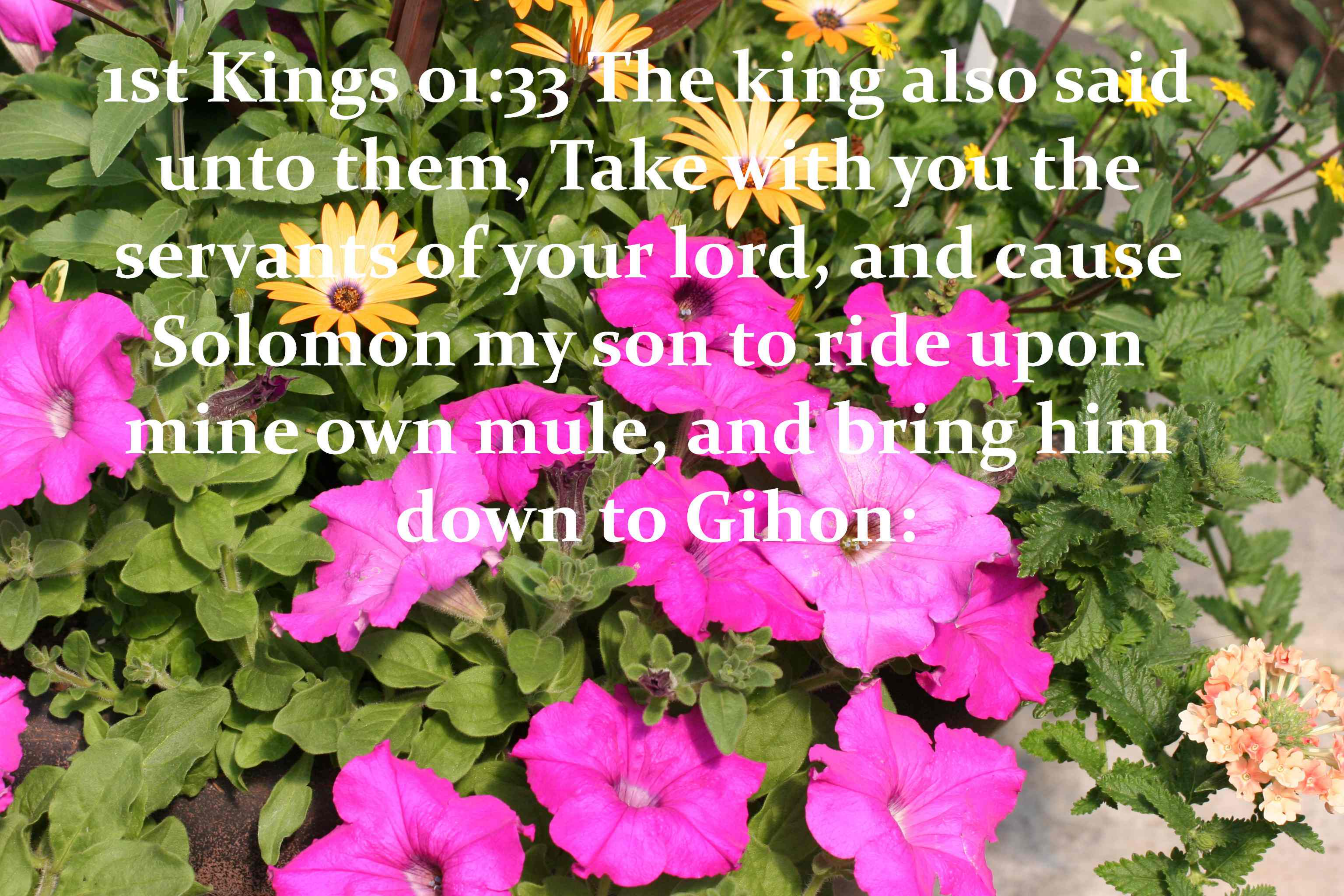

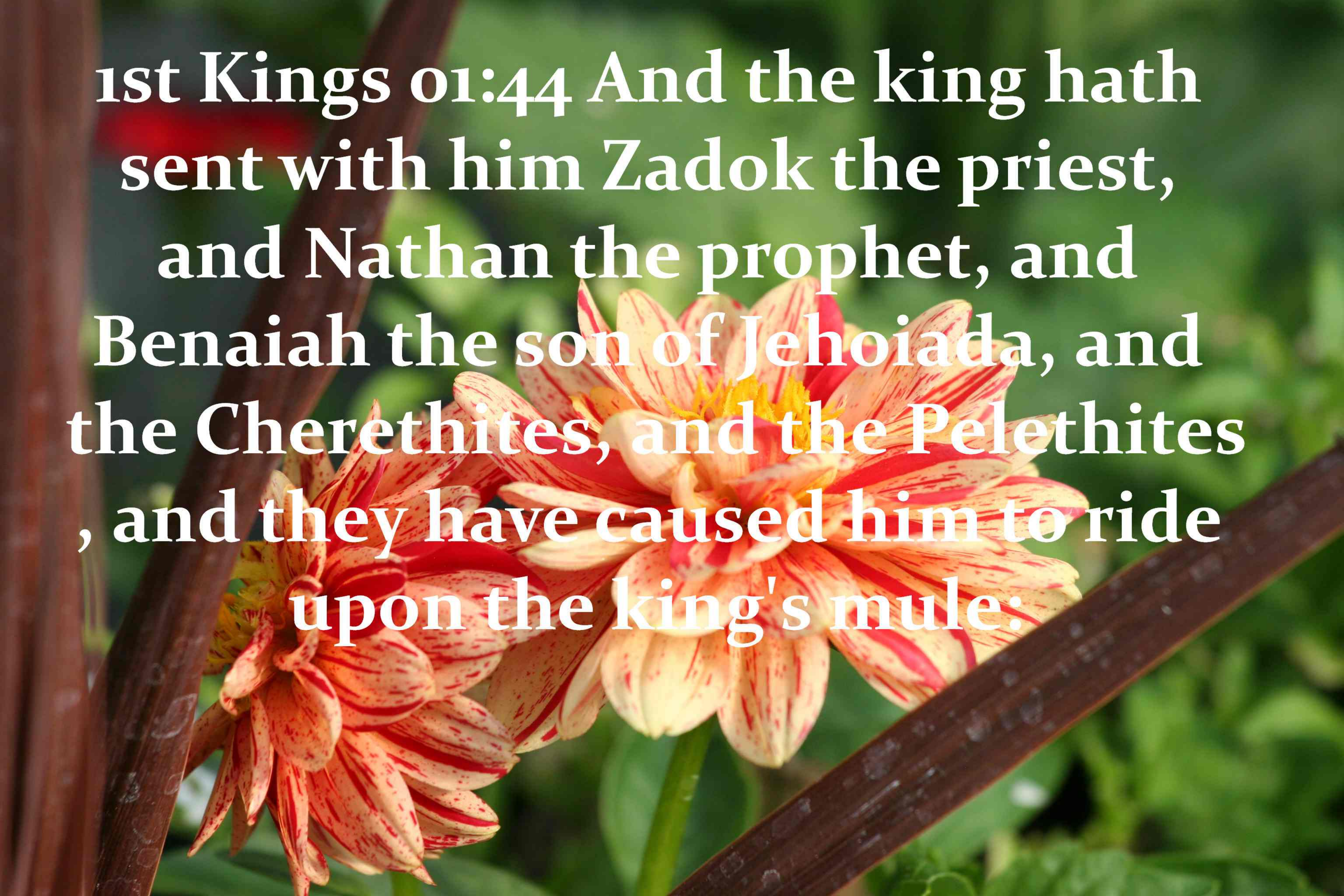

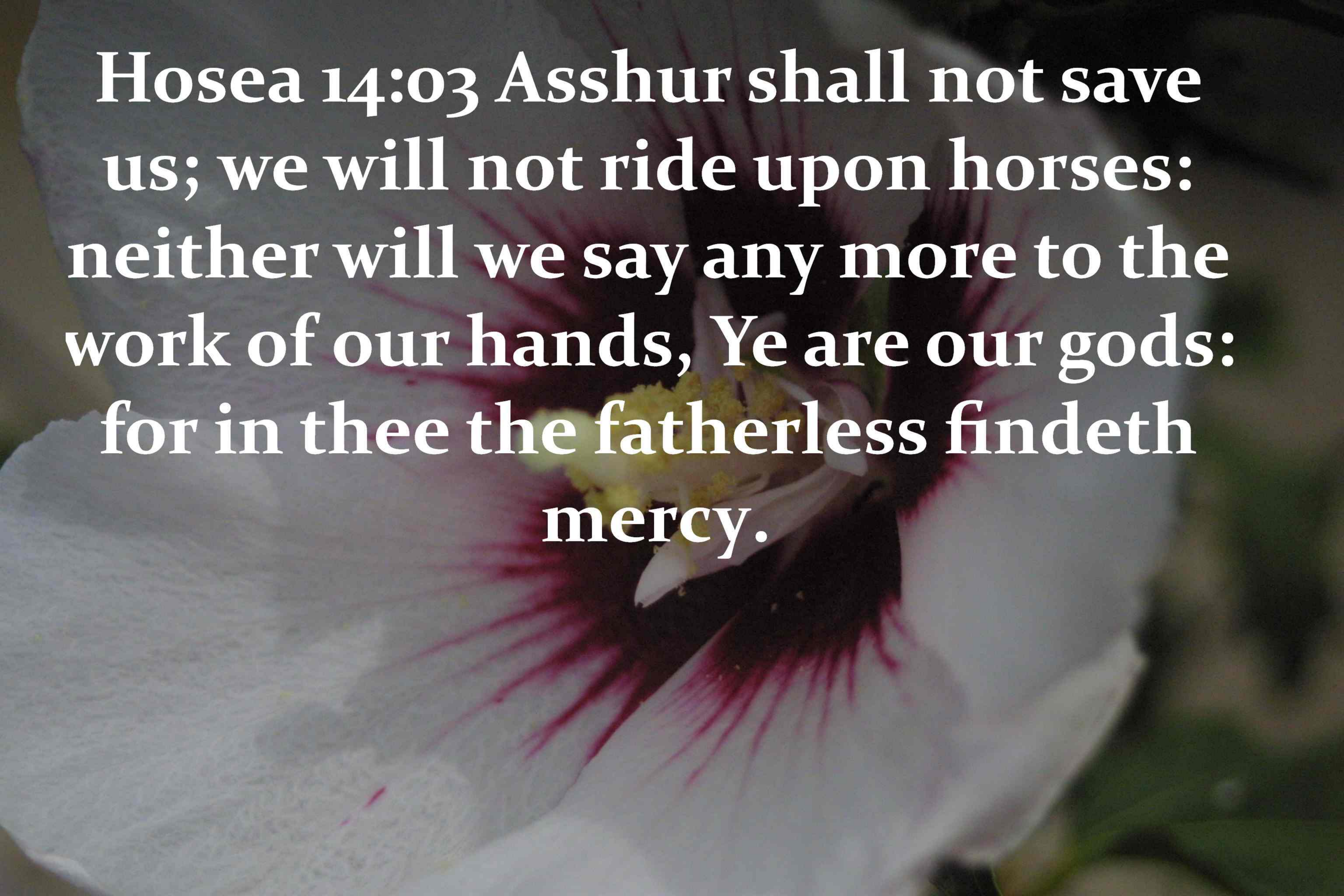
Jeremiah 06:23 They shall lay hold

Babylon.



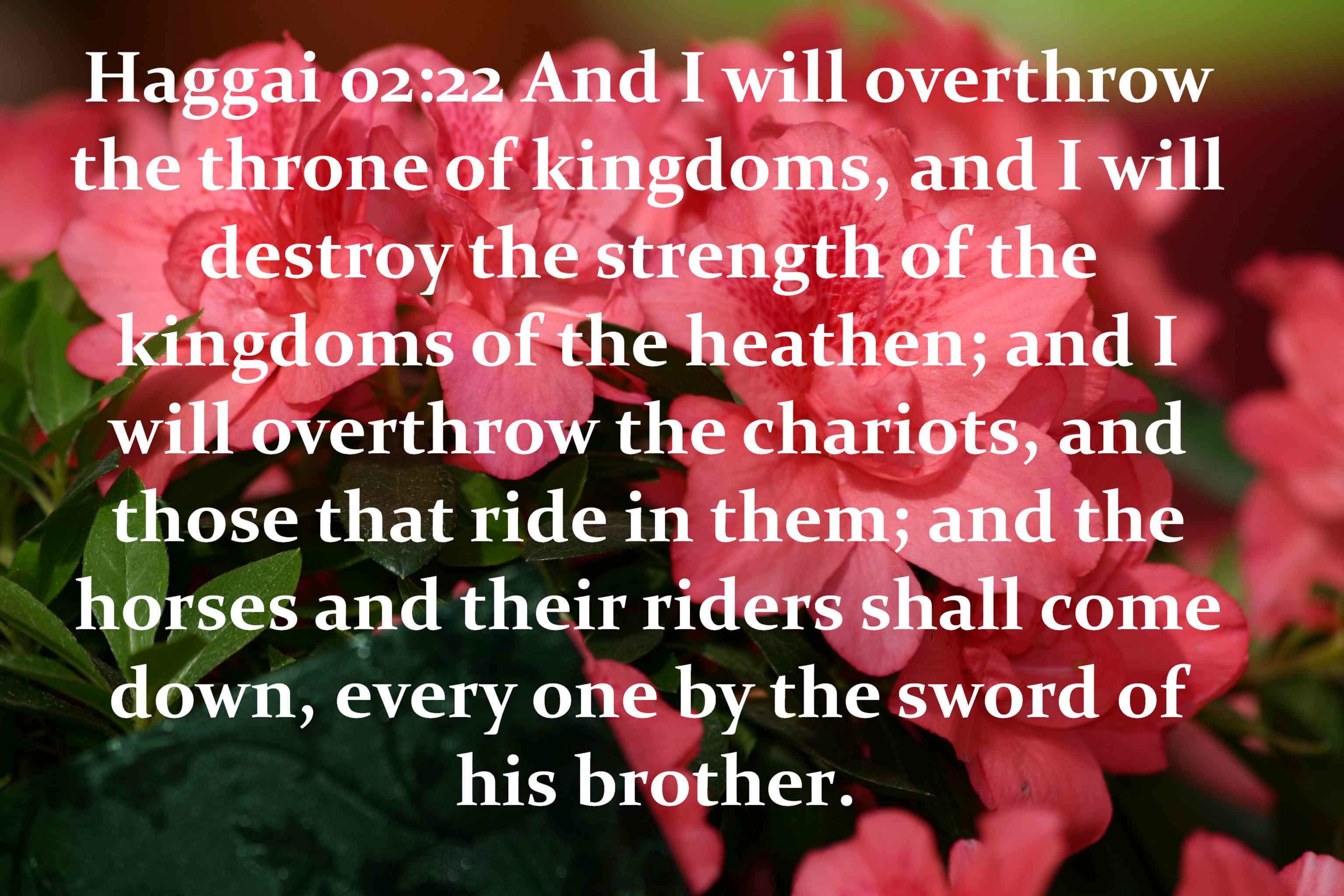
Hosea 10:11 And Ephraim is as an
