









Nehemiah 02:10 When Sanballat

welfare of the children of Israel.






Nehemiah 02:19 But when


**Mehemiah 04:01 But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.**



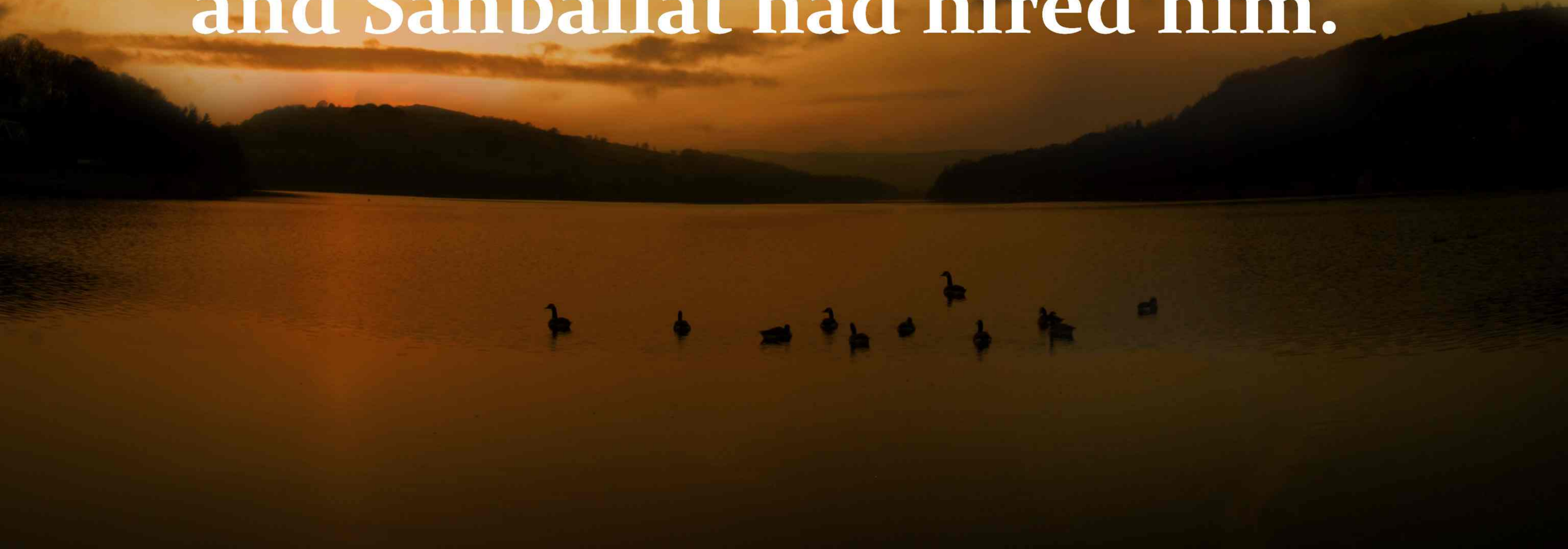
Nehemiah 06:02 That Sanballat

do me mischief.




Nehemiah 06:05 Then sent

and Sanballat had hired him.








Nehemiah 06:14 My God, think
