was in Shushan the palace,






**Esther 01:02 That in those days,

the king's palace;






Esther 02:03 And let the king

son of Kish, a Benjamite;




Esther 02:08 So it came to pass,

Hegai, keeper of the women.






Esther 03:15 The posts went out,


Esther 04:16 Go, gather together all

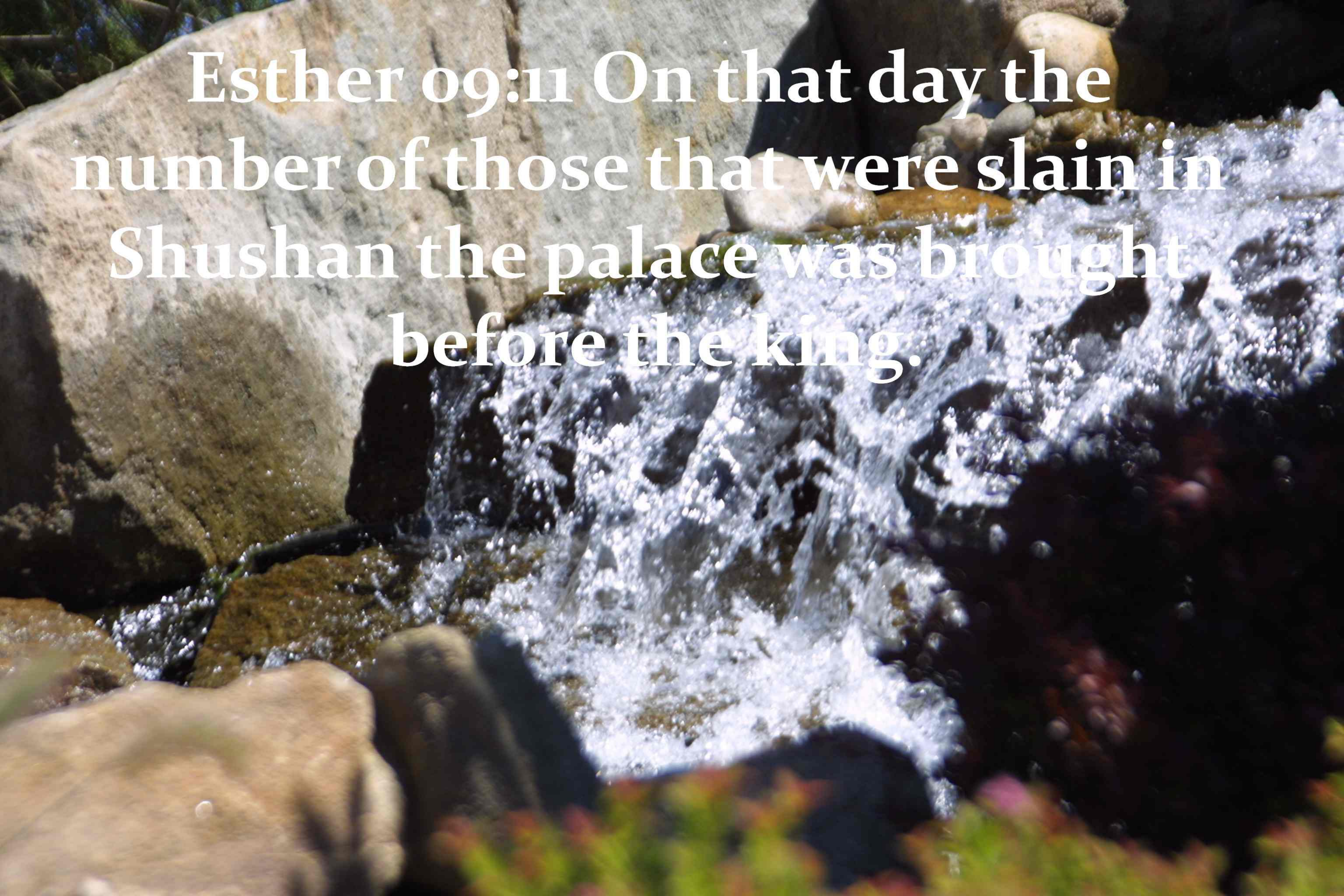

five hundred men.




Esther 09:11 On that day the




Esther 09:14 And the king

and they hanged Haman's ten sons.






Esther 09:15 For the Jews that were
