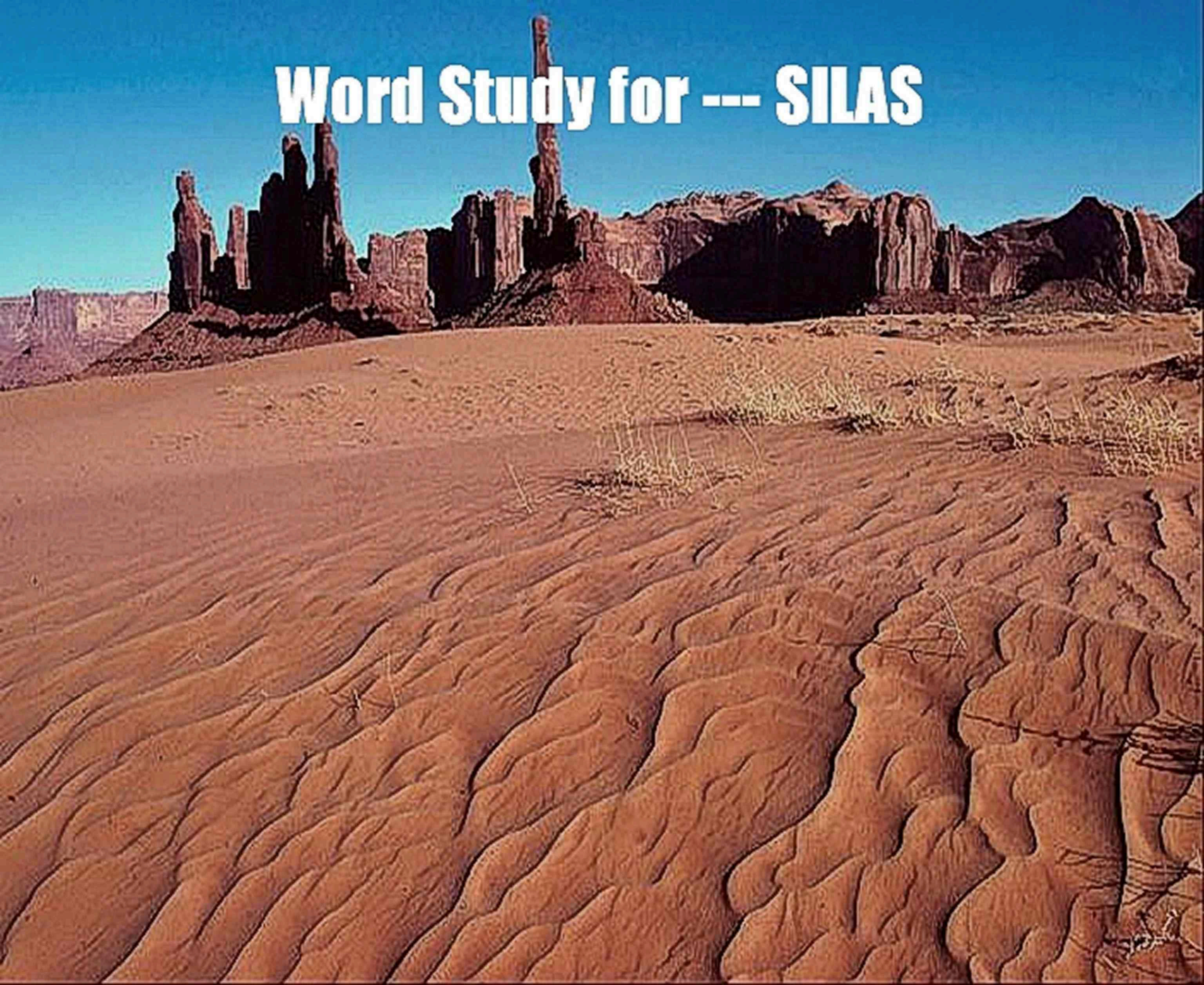



# Word Study for --- SILAS

unto the grace of God.

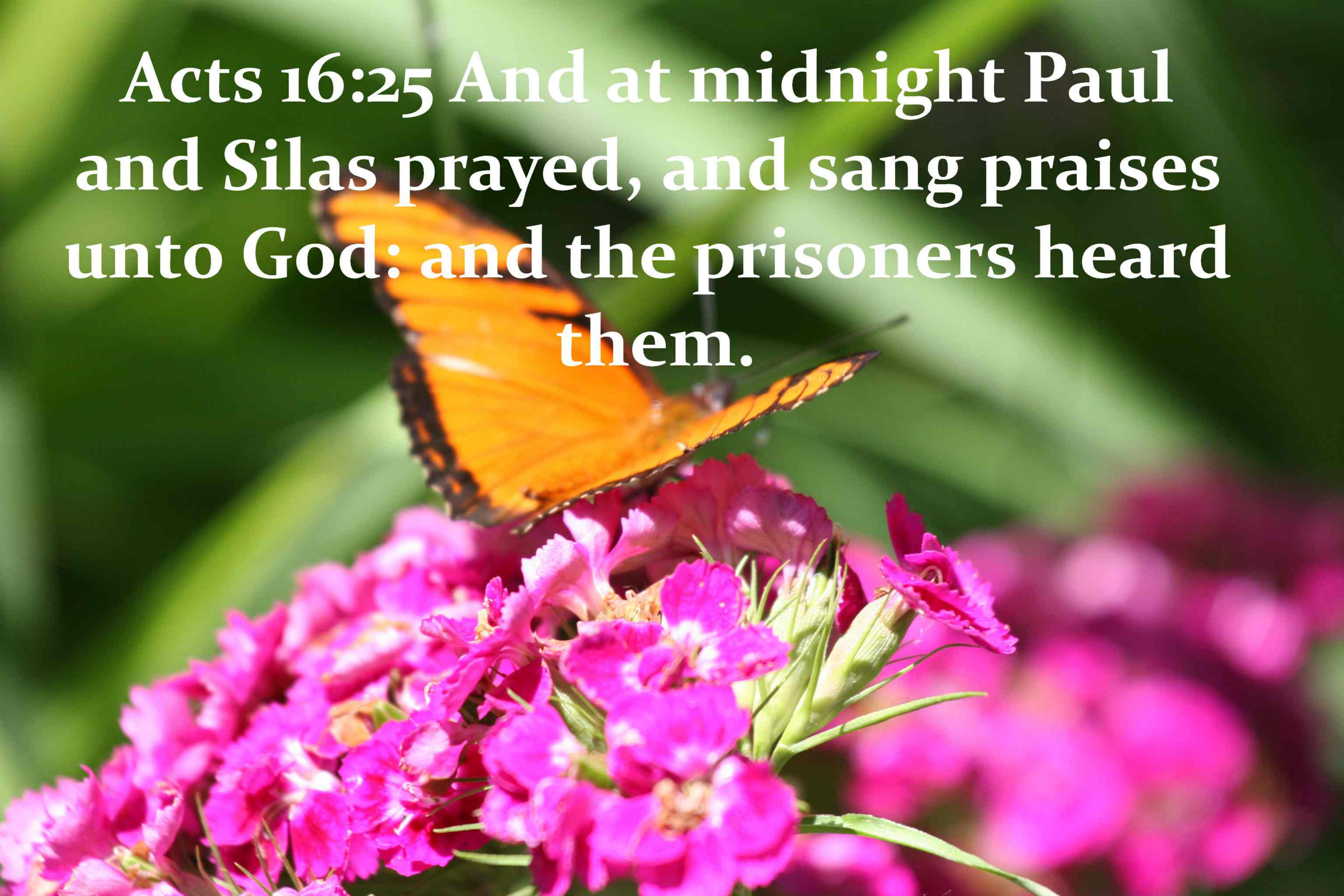


**Acts 16:19 And when her masters

marketplace unto the rulers,**






Acts 16:25 And at midnight Paul

them.




Acts 16:29 Then he called for a light,

the chief women not a few.

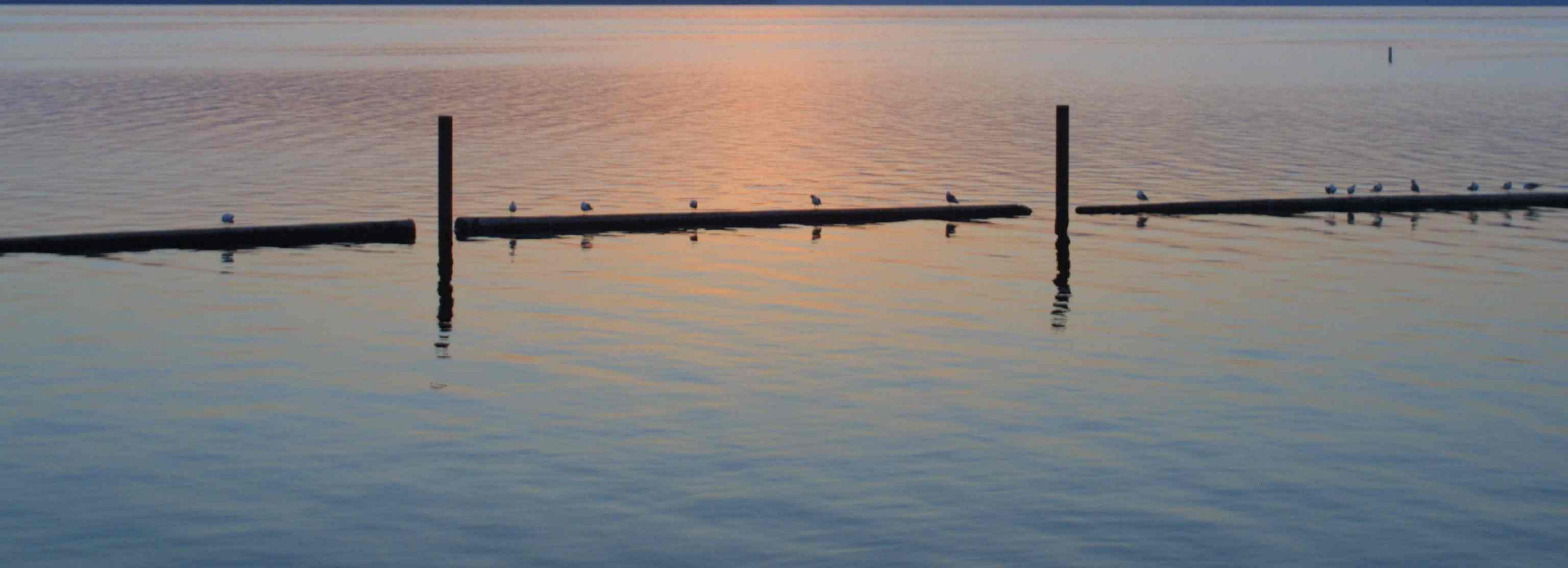


Acts 17:10 And the brethren

Timotheus abode there still.


