clothes, and be clean.



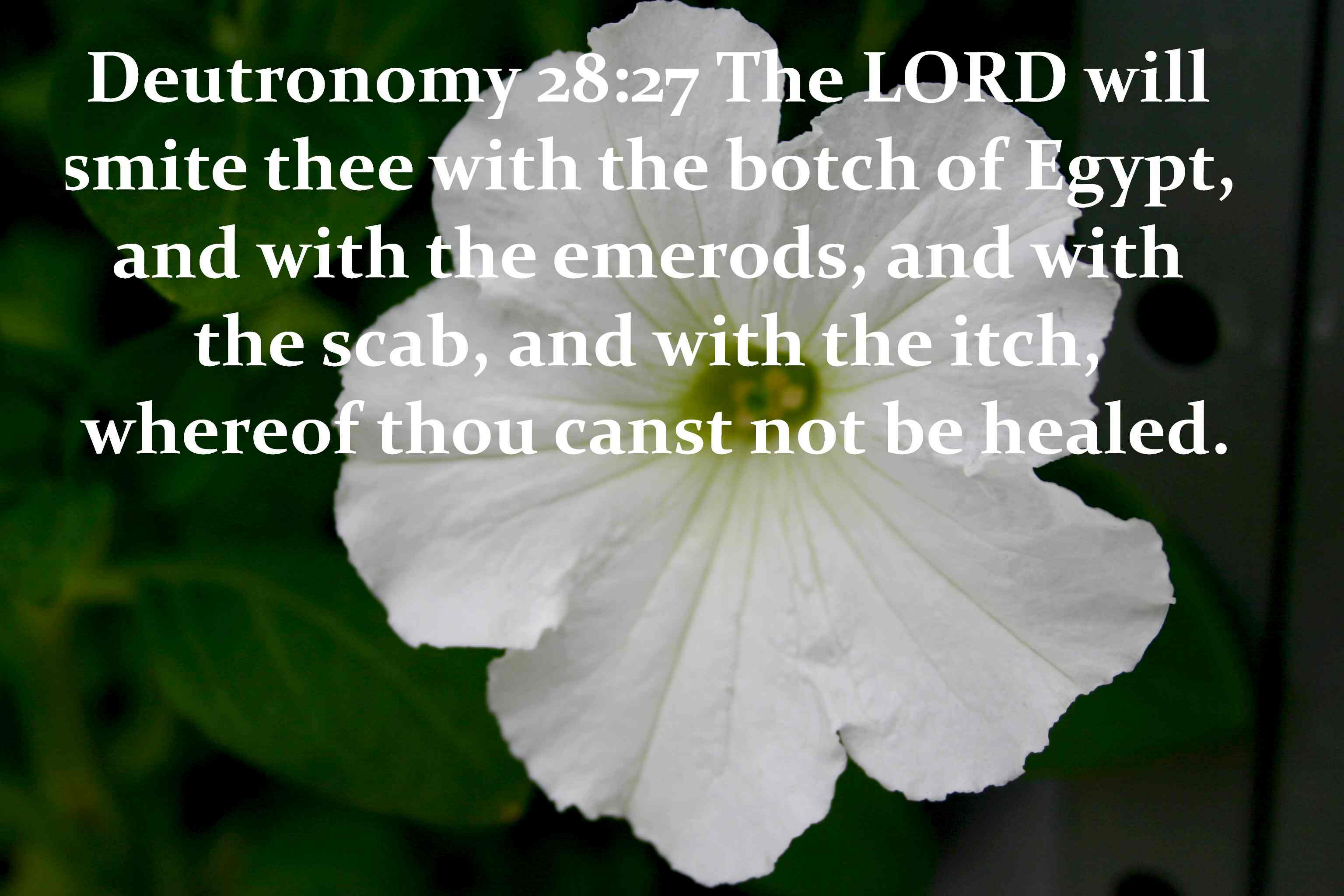
Leviticus 13:07 But if the scab
