
2nd Kings 19:21 This is the word

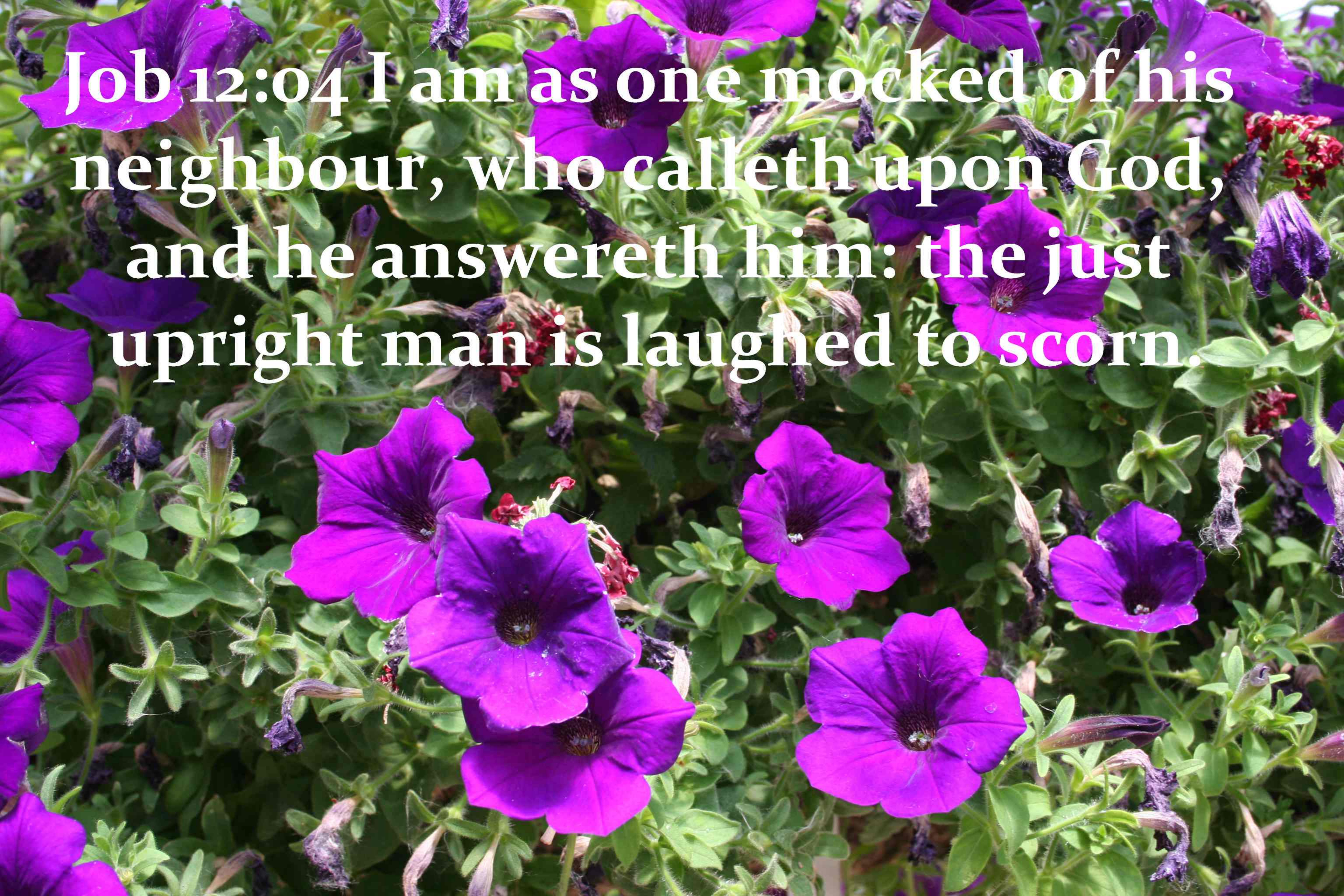

against the king?

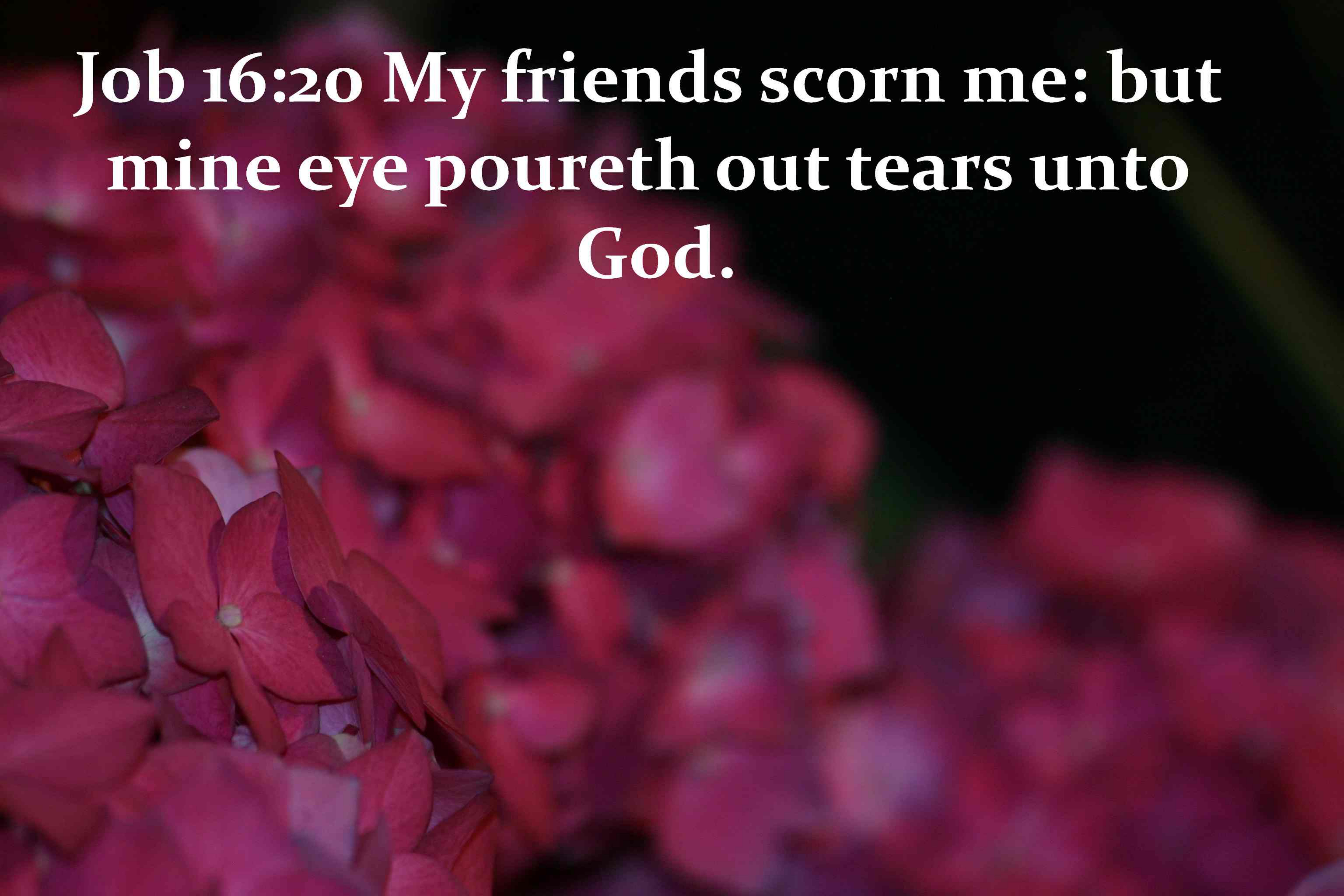
