





Leviticus 12:02 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a woman have conceived seed, and born a man child: then she shall be unclean seven days; according to the days of the separation for her infirmity shall she be unclean.



Leviticus 12:05 But if she bear a
maid child, then she shall be
unclean two weeks, as in her
separation: and she shall continue
in the blood of her purifying
threescore and six days.

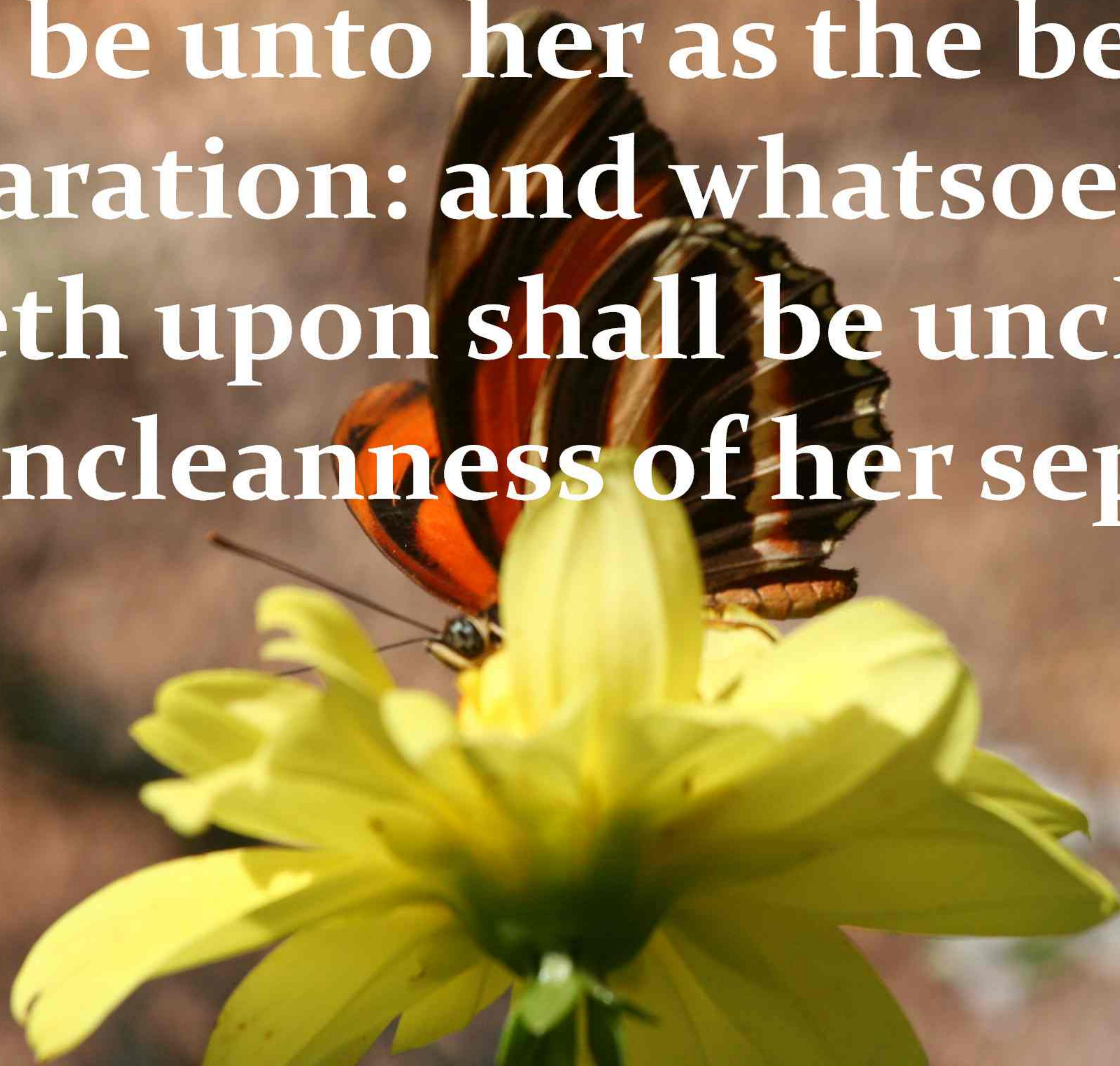

shall be unclean.

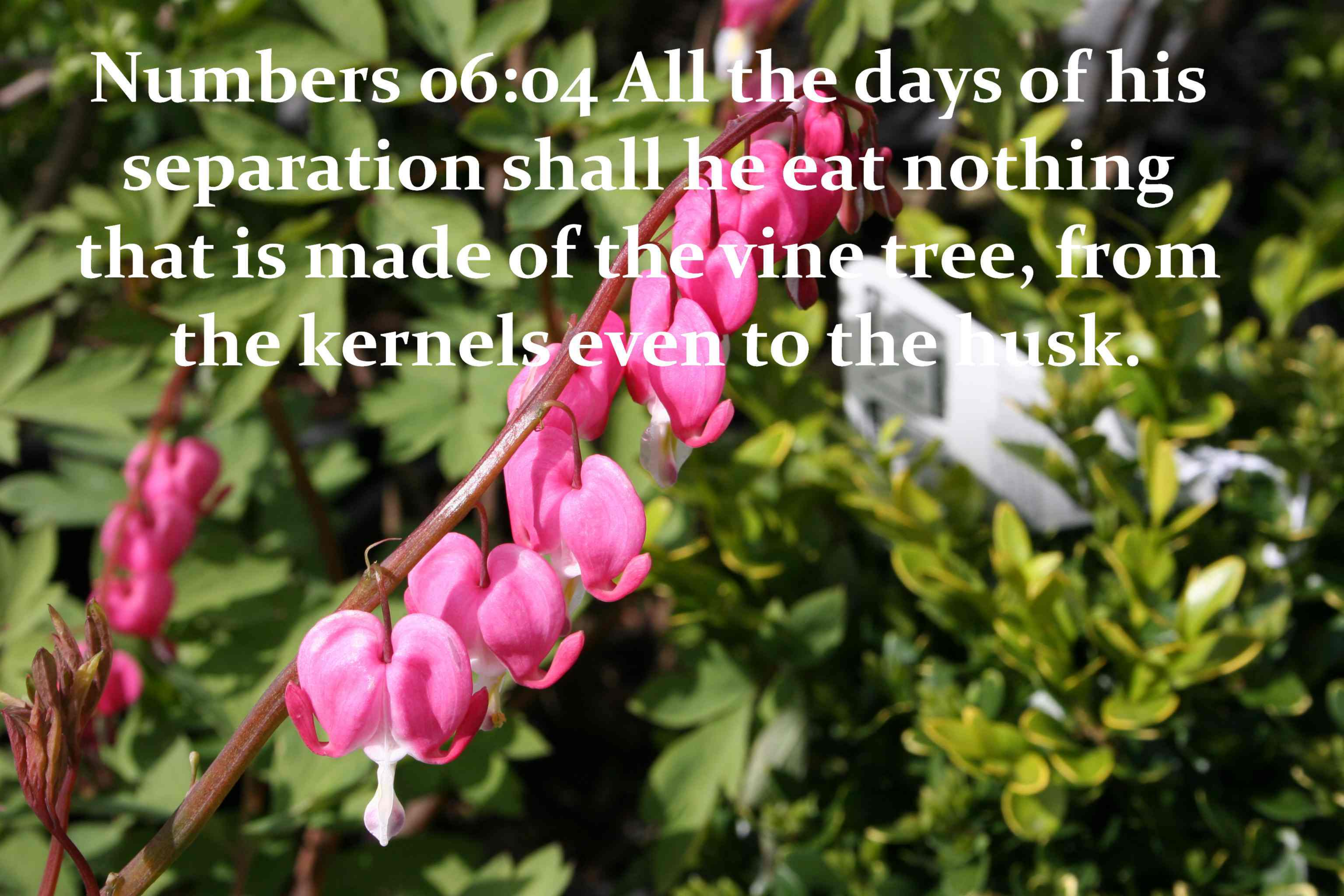


Leviticus 15:25 And if a woman

the kernels even to the husk.




Numbers 06:05 All the days of the


Numbers 06:08 All the days of his

LORD.




Numbers 06:12 And he shall


Numbers 06:13 And this is the law


Numbers 06:19 And the priest shall

hair of his separation is shaven:








Numbers 19:13 Whosoever

shall be unclean; his uncleanness




Numbers 19:20 But the man that shall be unclean, and shall not purify himself, that soul shall be cut off from among the congregation, because he hath defiled the sanctuary of the LORD: the water of separation hath not been sprinkled upon him; he is unclean.
