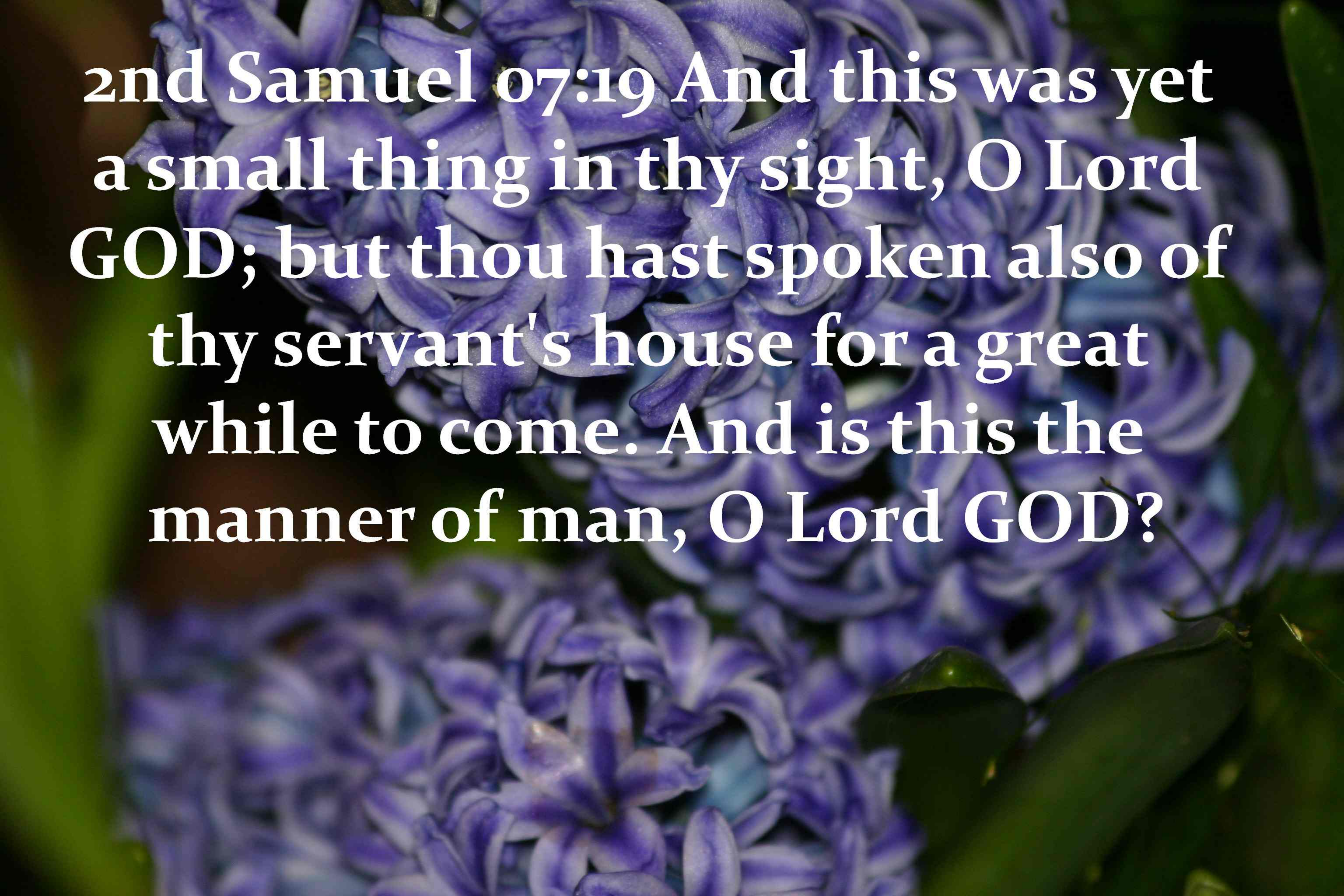

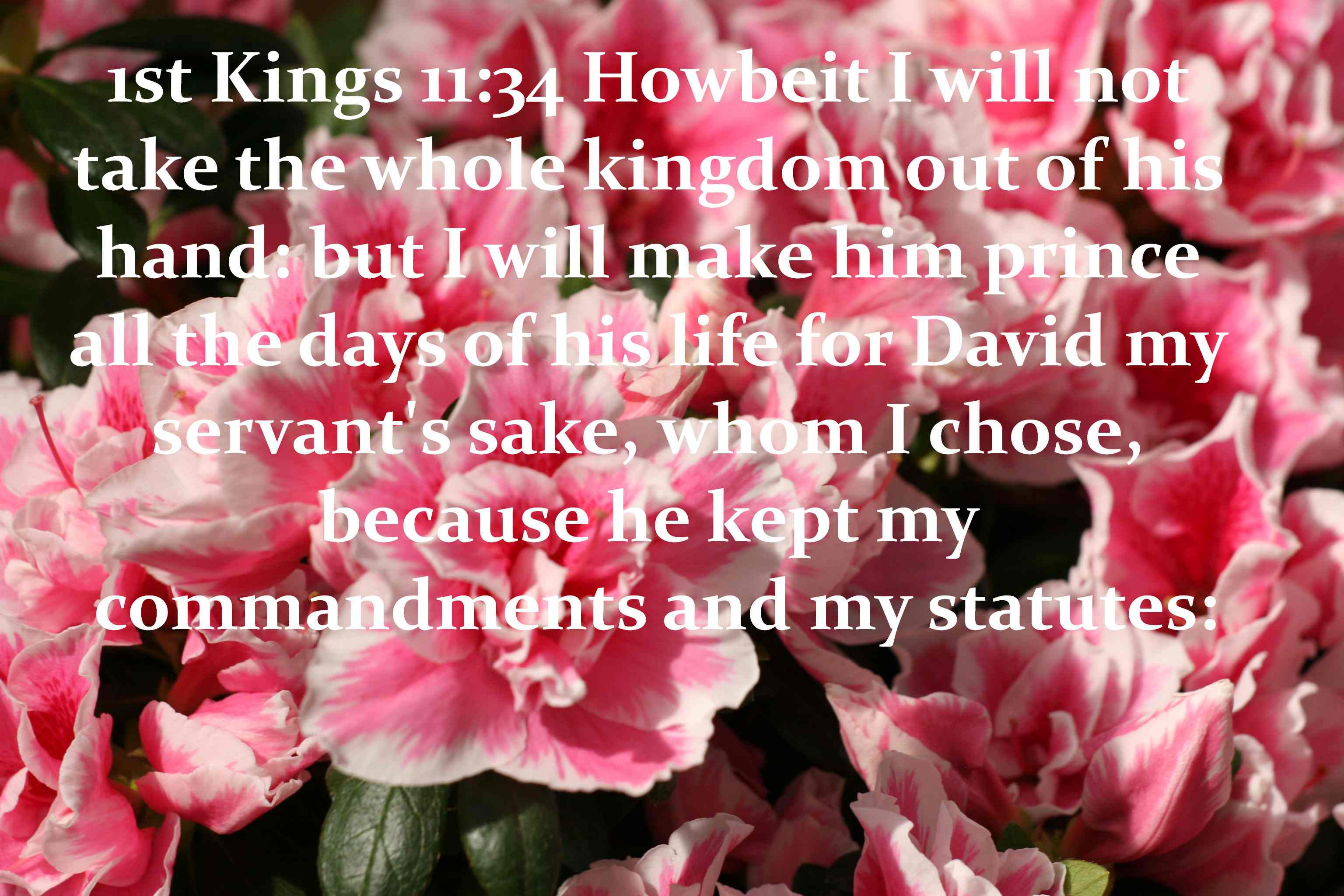

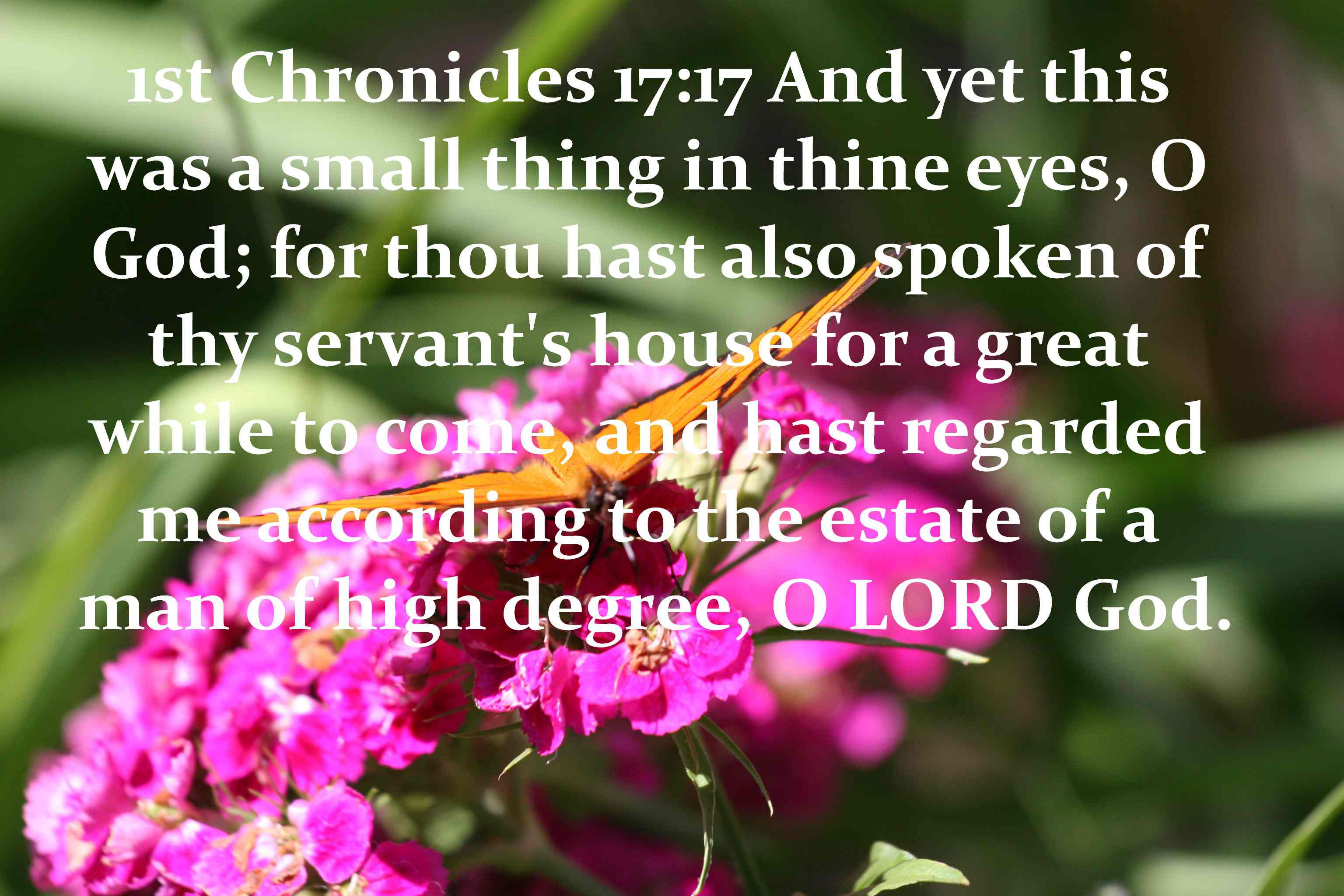
1st Kings 11:13 Howbeit I will not

commandments and my statutes:

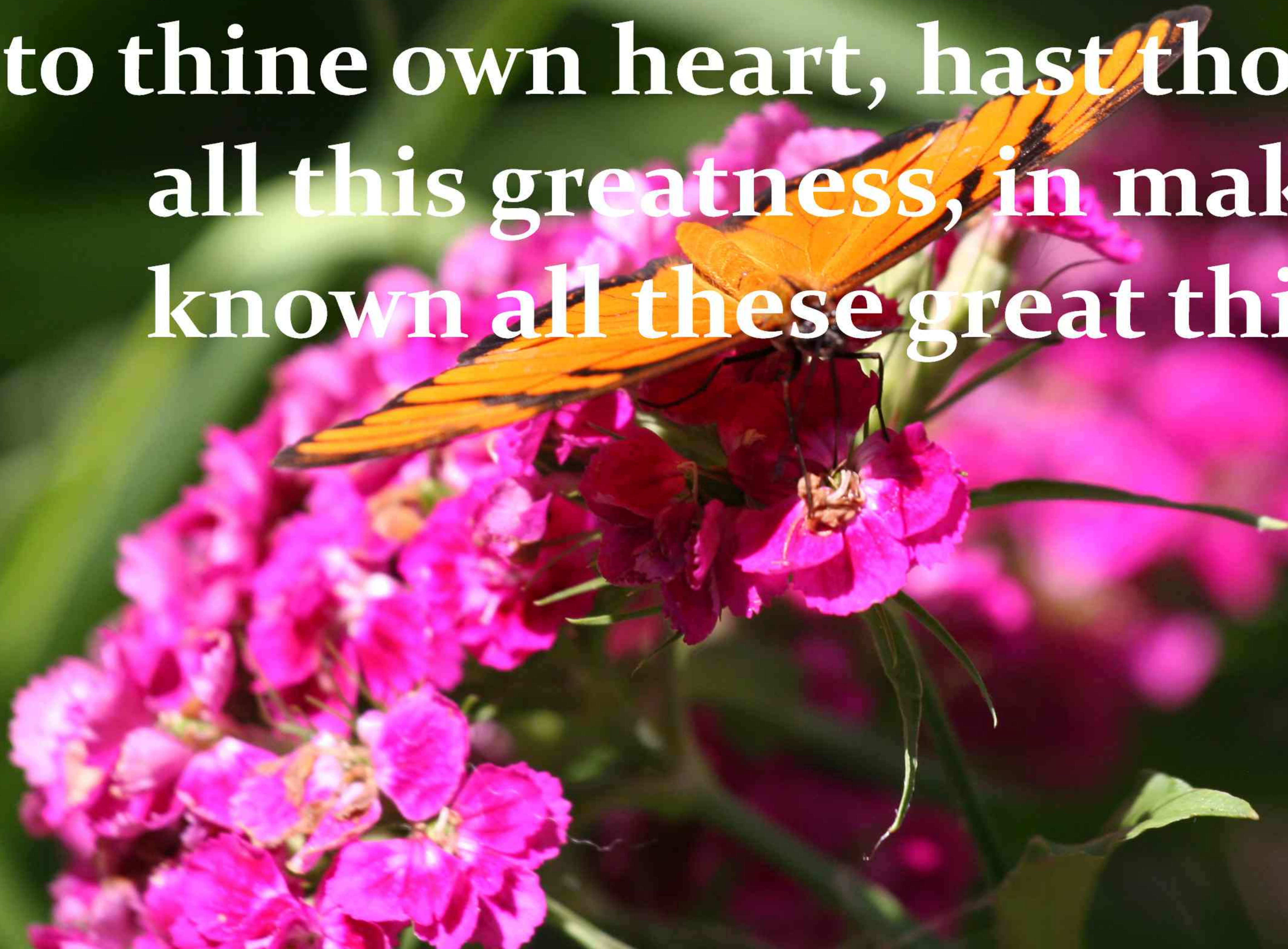


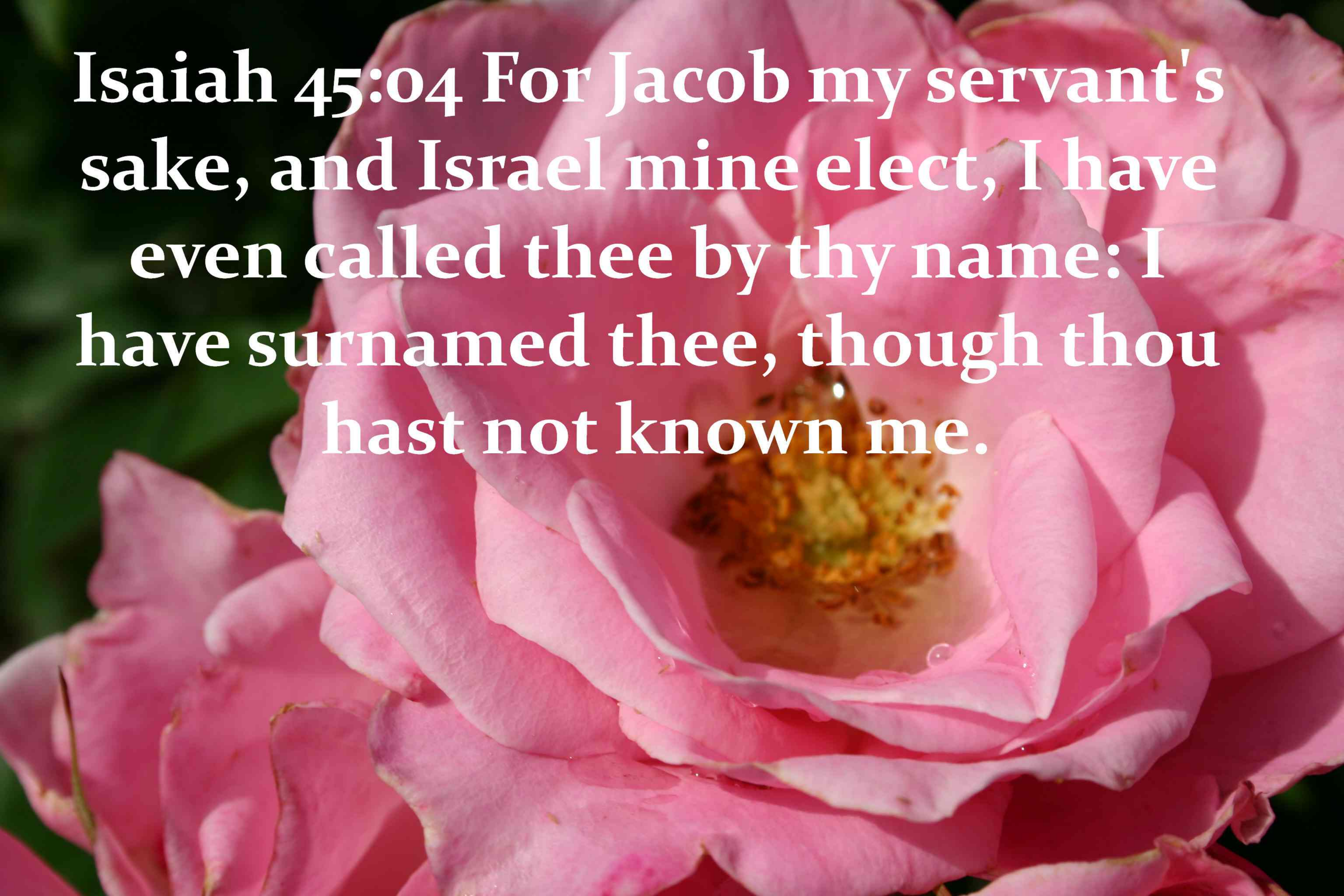
2nd Kings 08:19 Yet the LORD

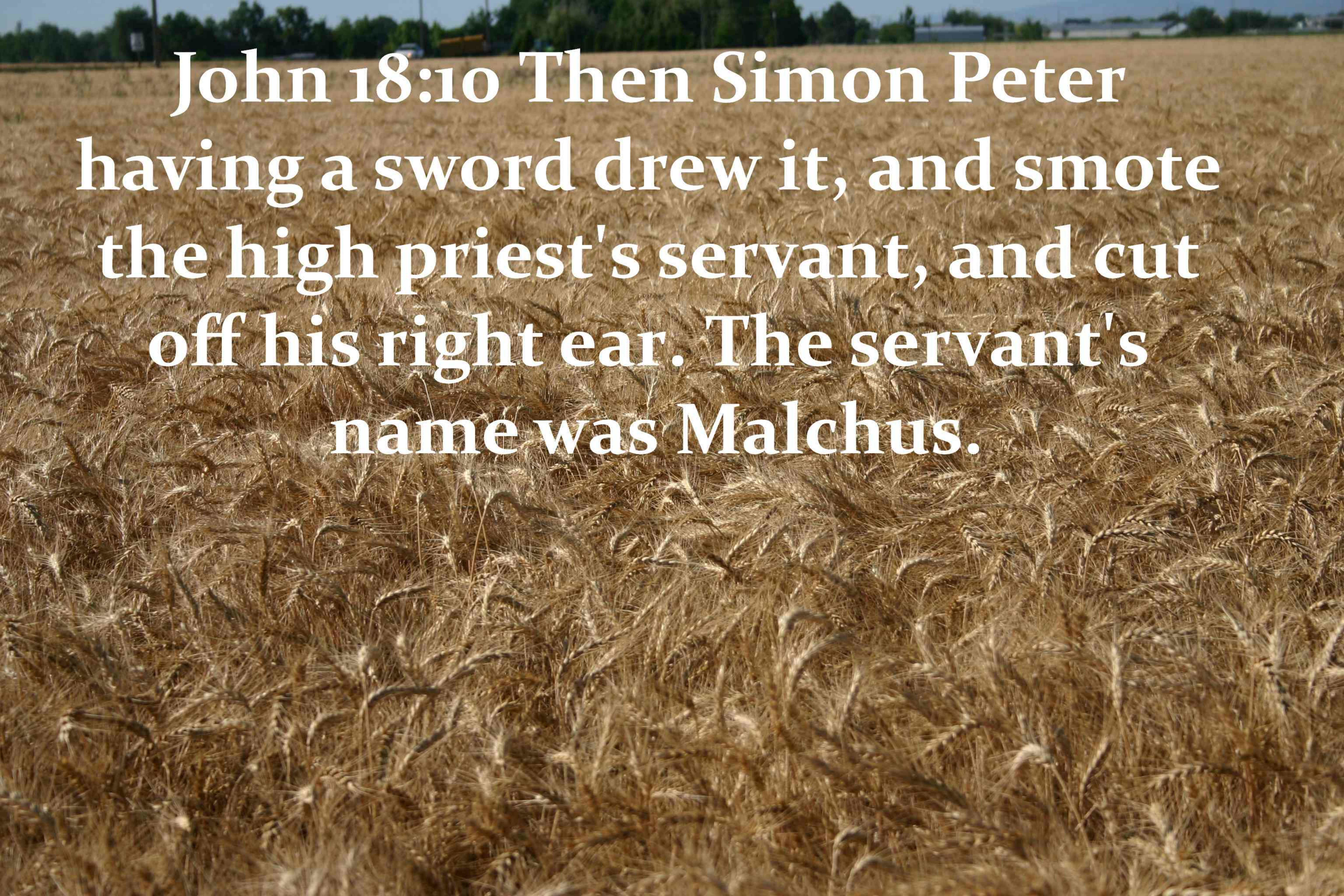
1st Chronicles 17:17 And yet this
