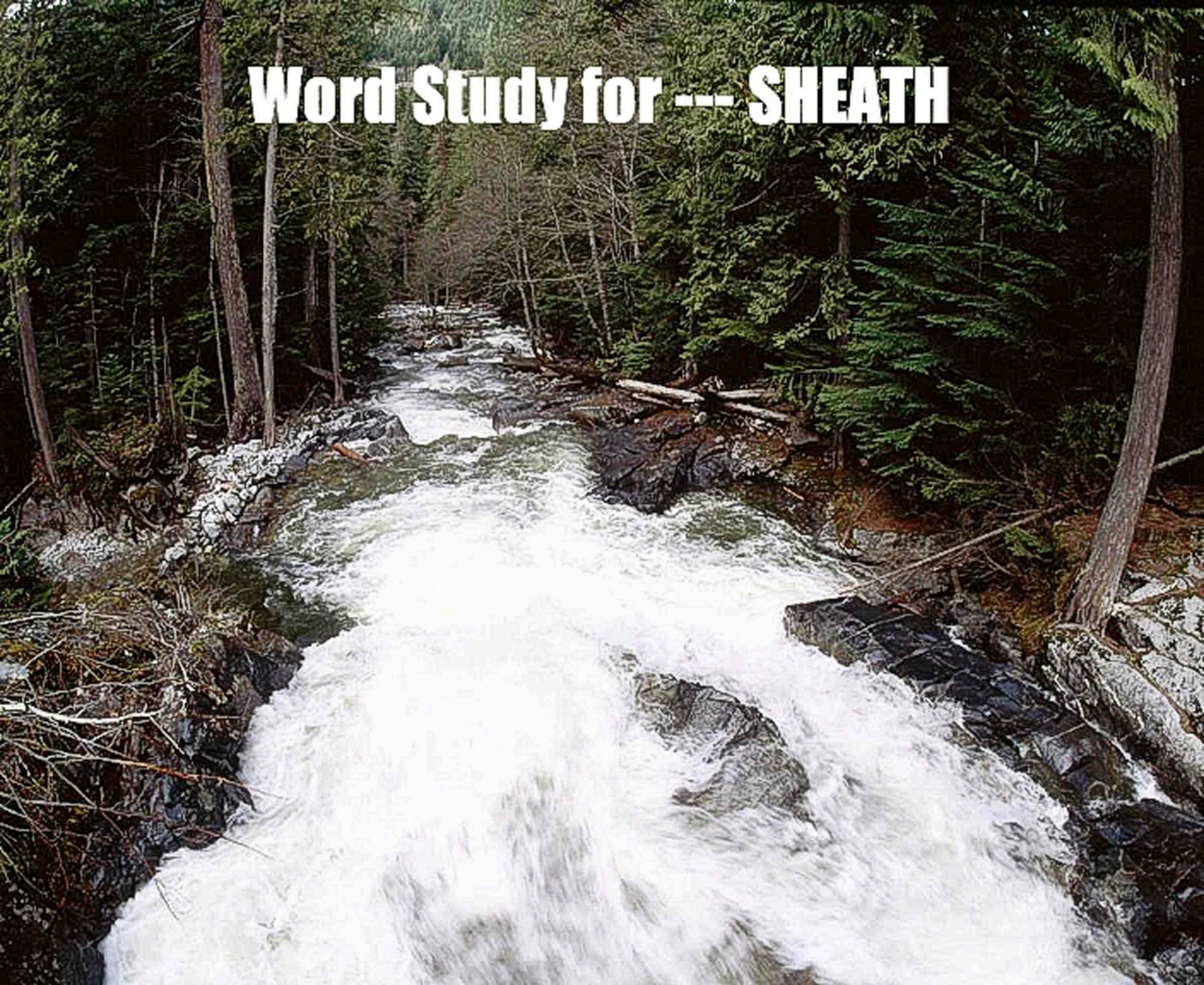









1st Samuel 17:51 Therefore David


2nd Samuel 20:08 When they were

thereof.








Ezekiel 21:03 And say to the land of


Ezekiel 21:04 Seeing then that I
