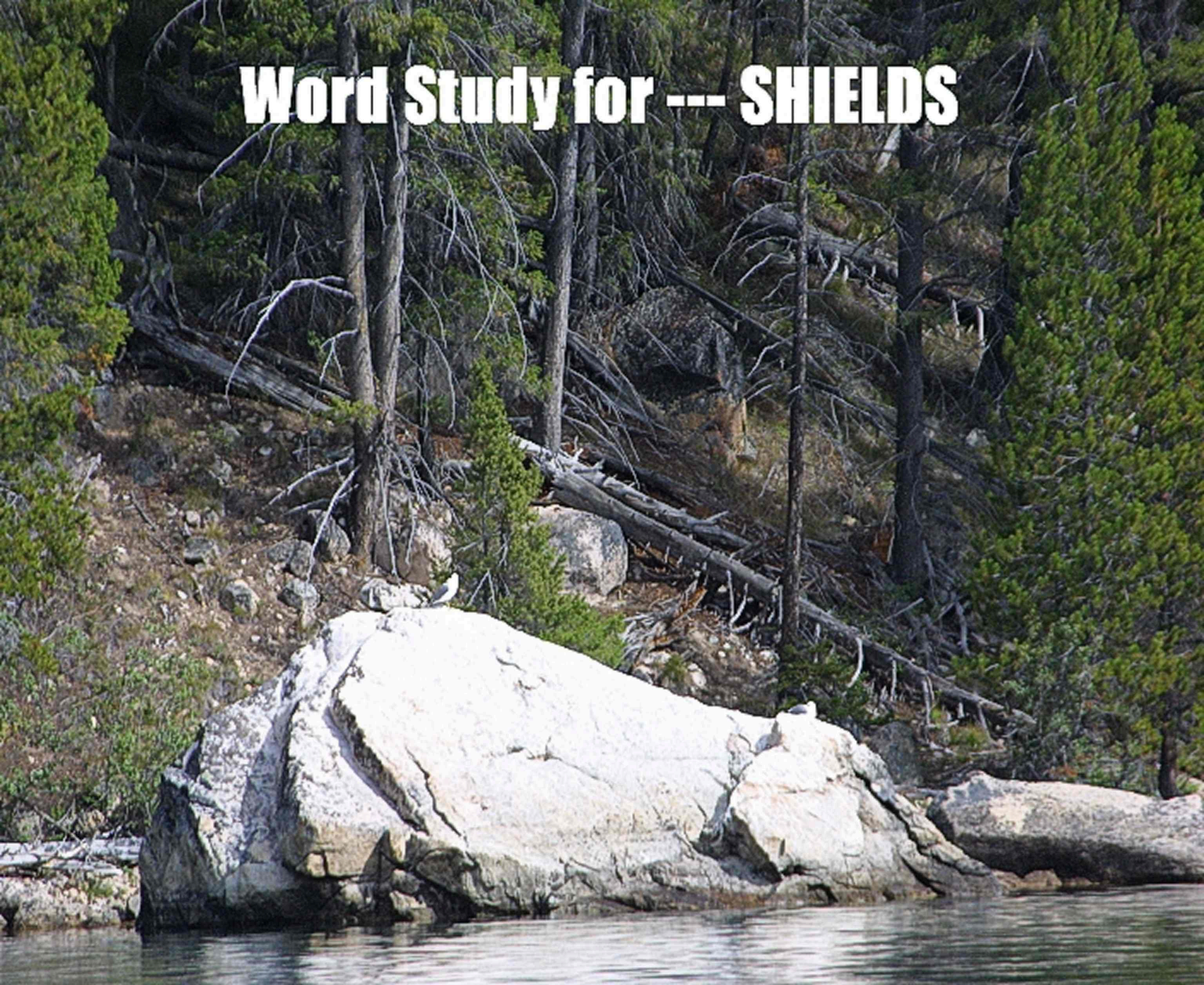


# Word Study for --- SHIELDS




1st Kings 10:17 And he made three

LORD.



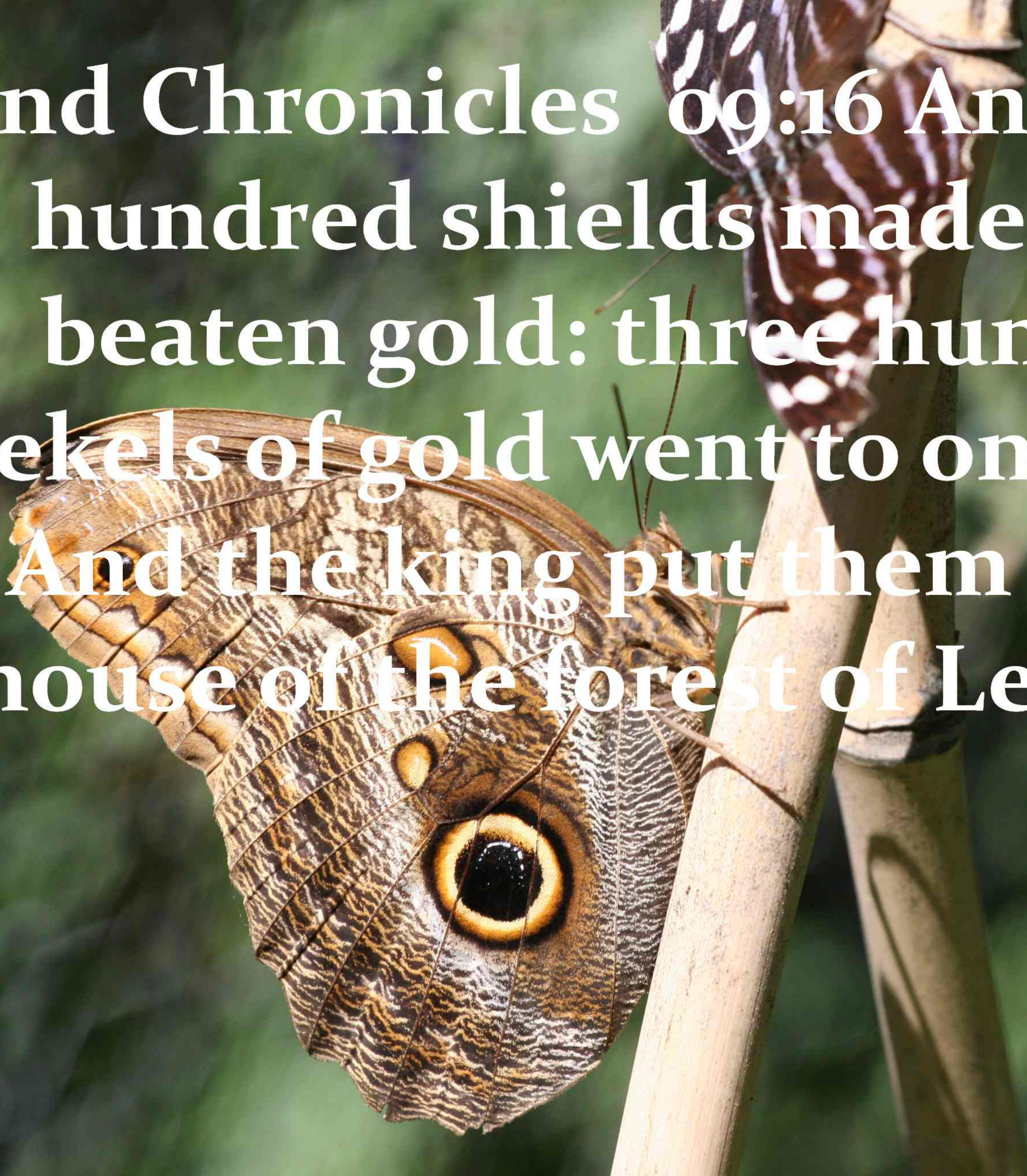


1st Chronicles 18:07 And David

house of the forest of Lebanon.






2nd Chronicles 11:12 And in every

Benjamin on his side.








2nd Chronicles 12:09 So Shishak

of the king's house.



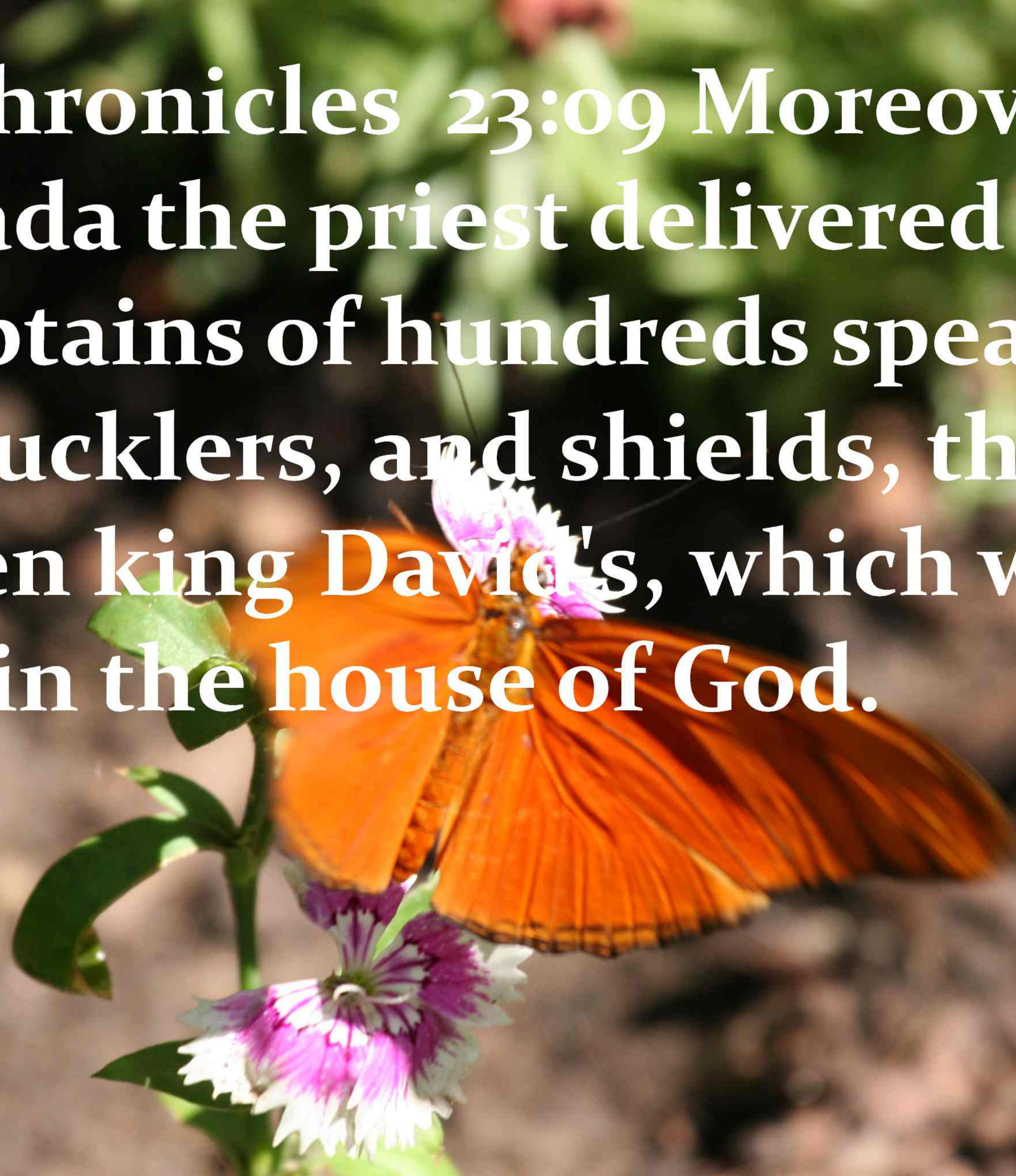




2nd Chronicles 14:08 And Asa had

mighty men of valour.

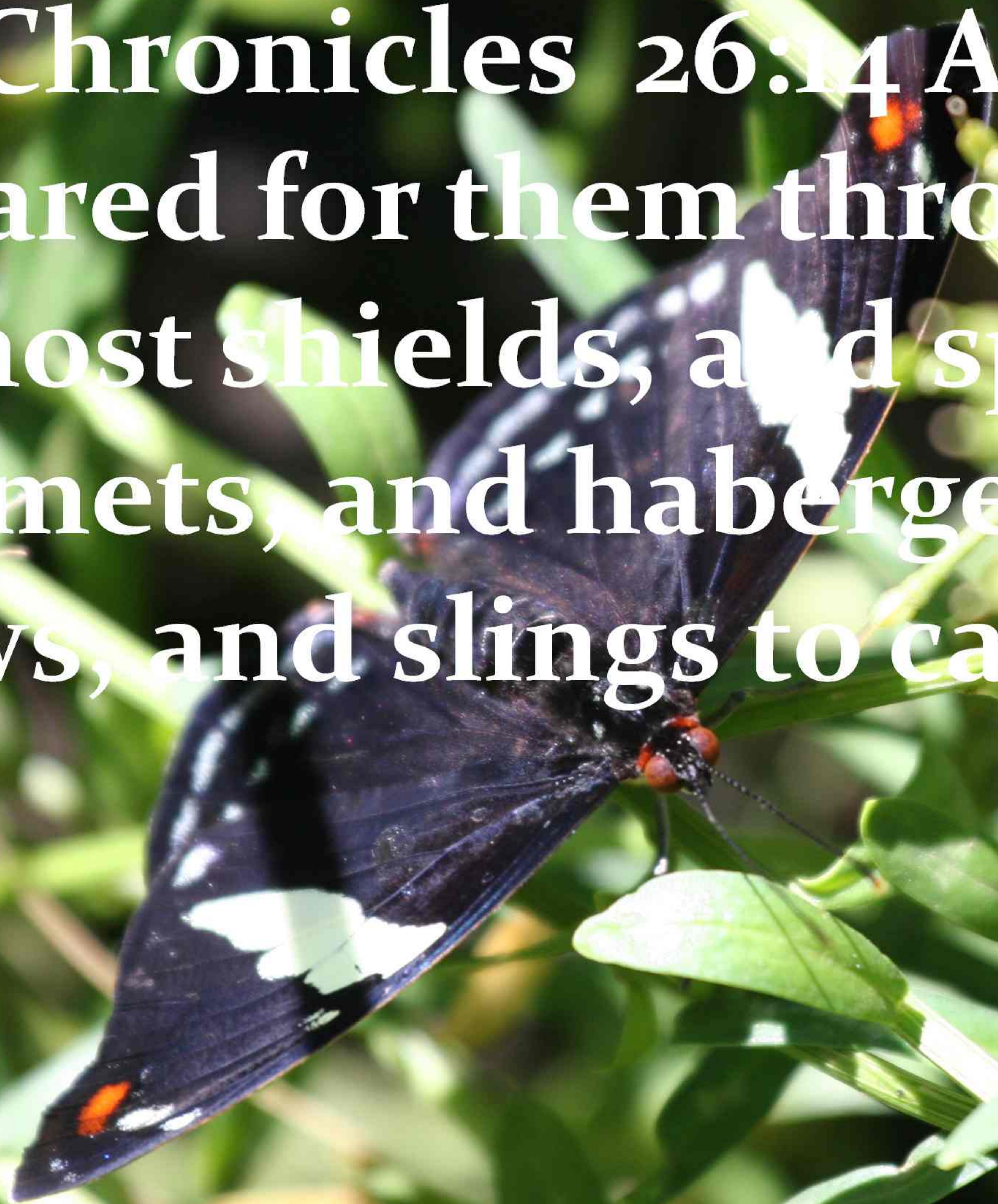


2nd Chronicles 23:09 Moreover

in the house of God.




2nd Chronicles 32:05 Also he




Song of Solomon 04:04 Thy neck is

nor cast a bank against it.






Jeremiah 51:11 Make bright the


Ezekiel 27:11 The men of Arvad
