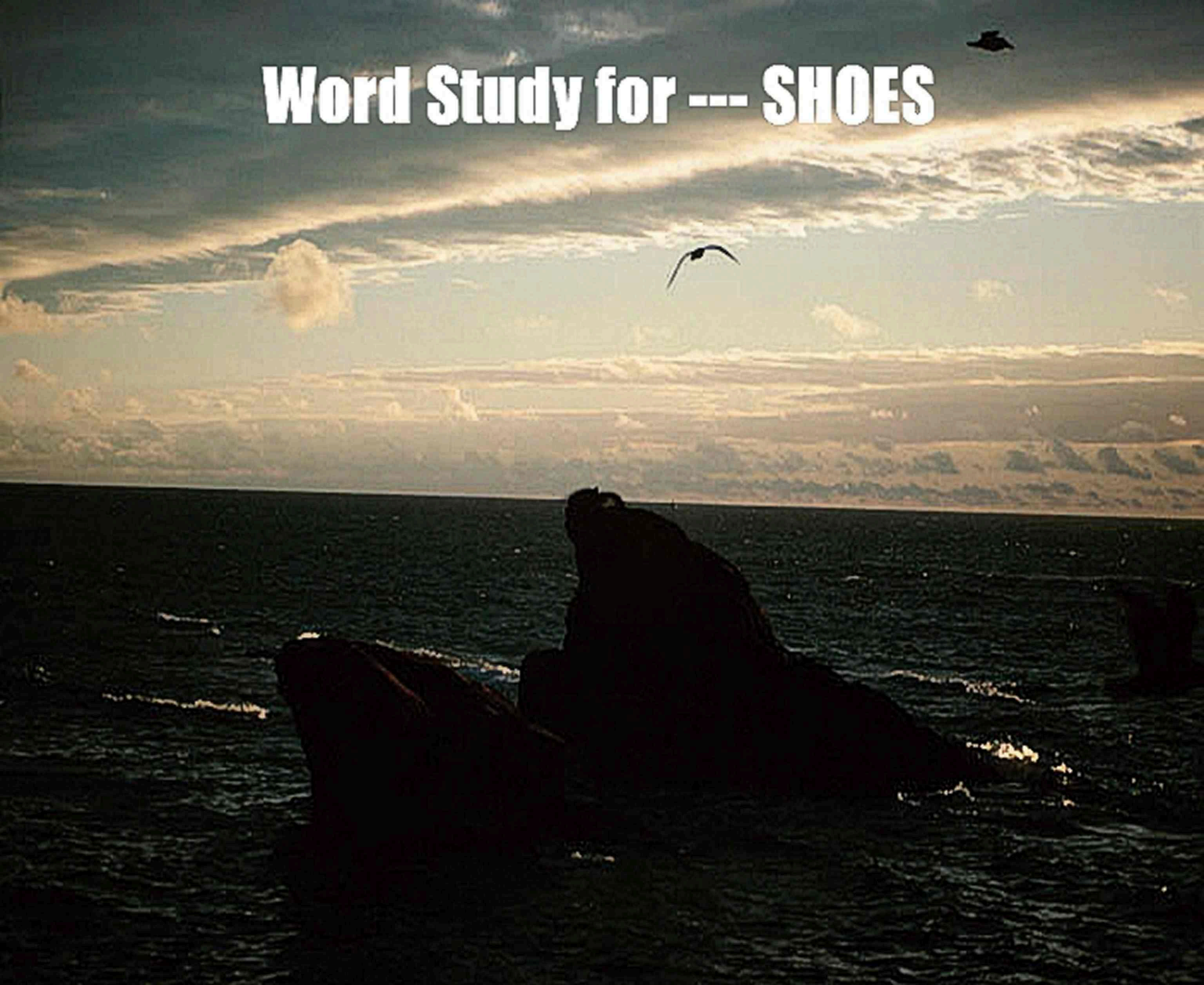
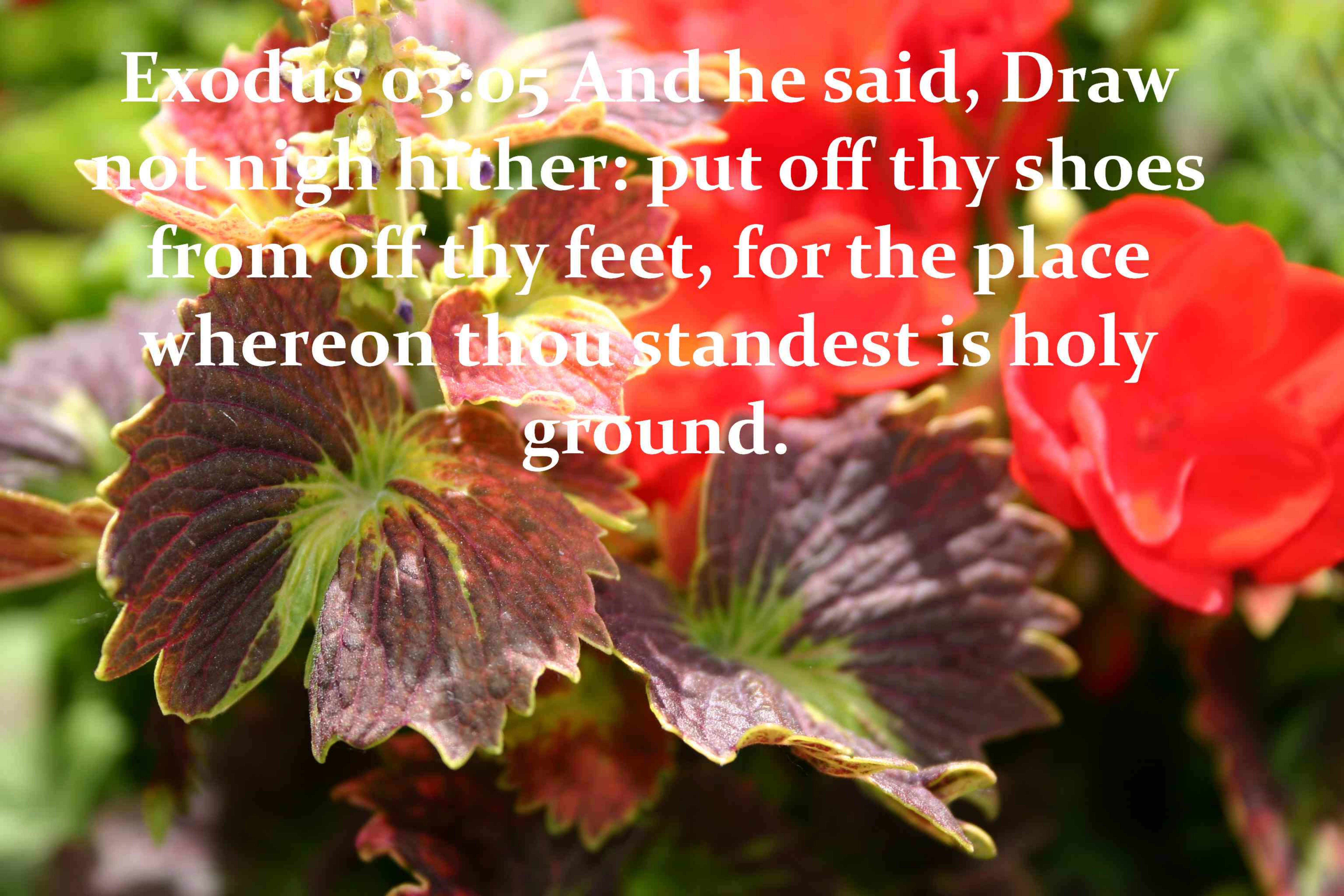

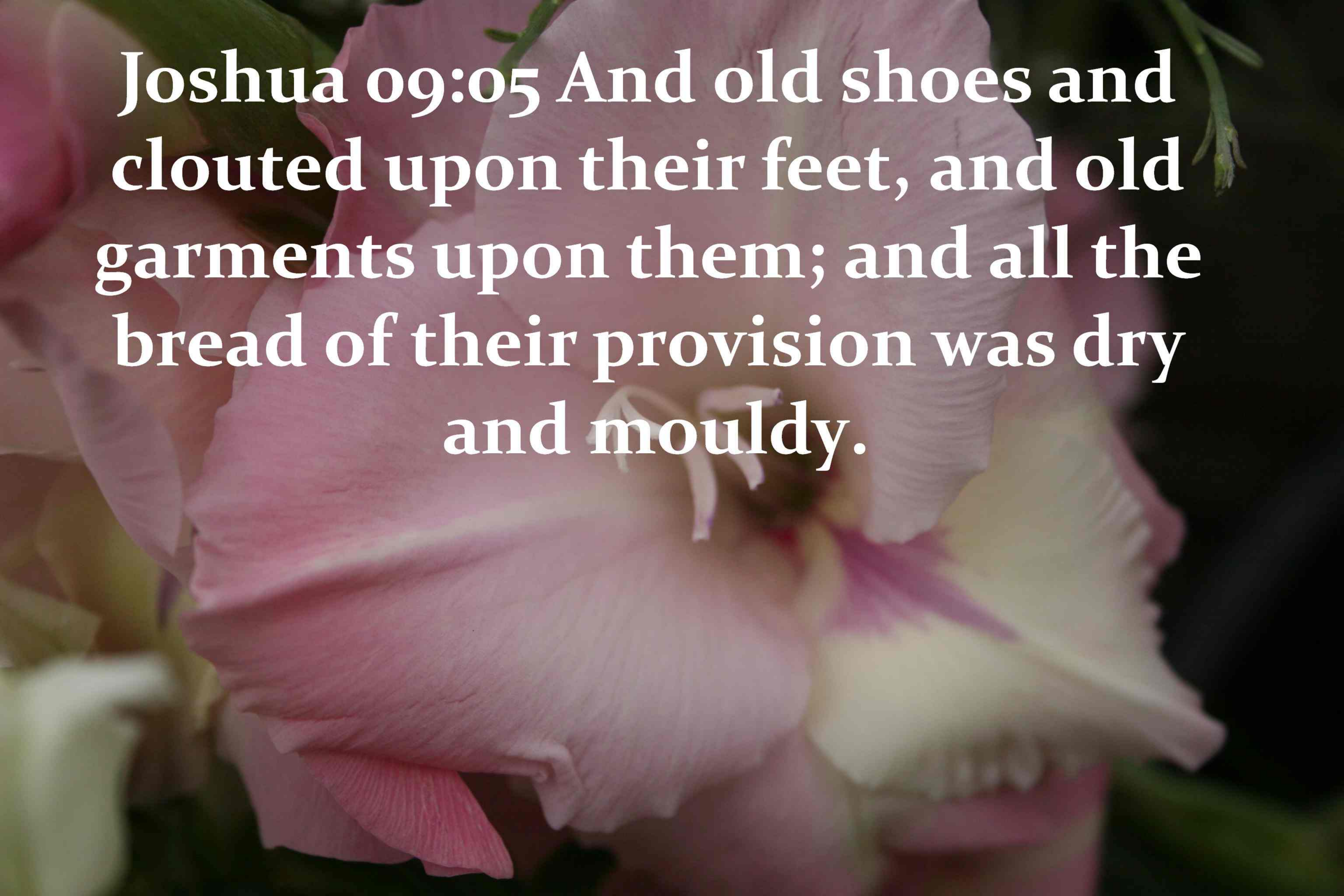
Exodus 03:05 And he said, Draw

ground.



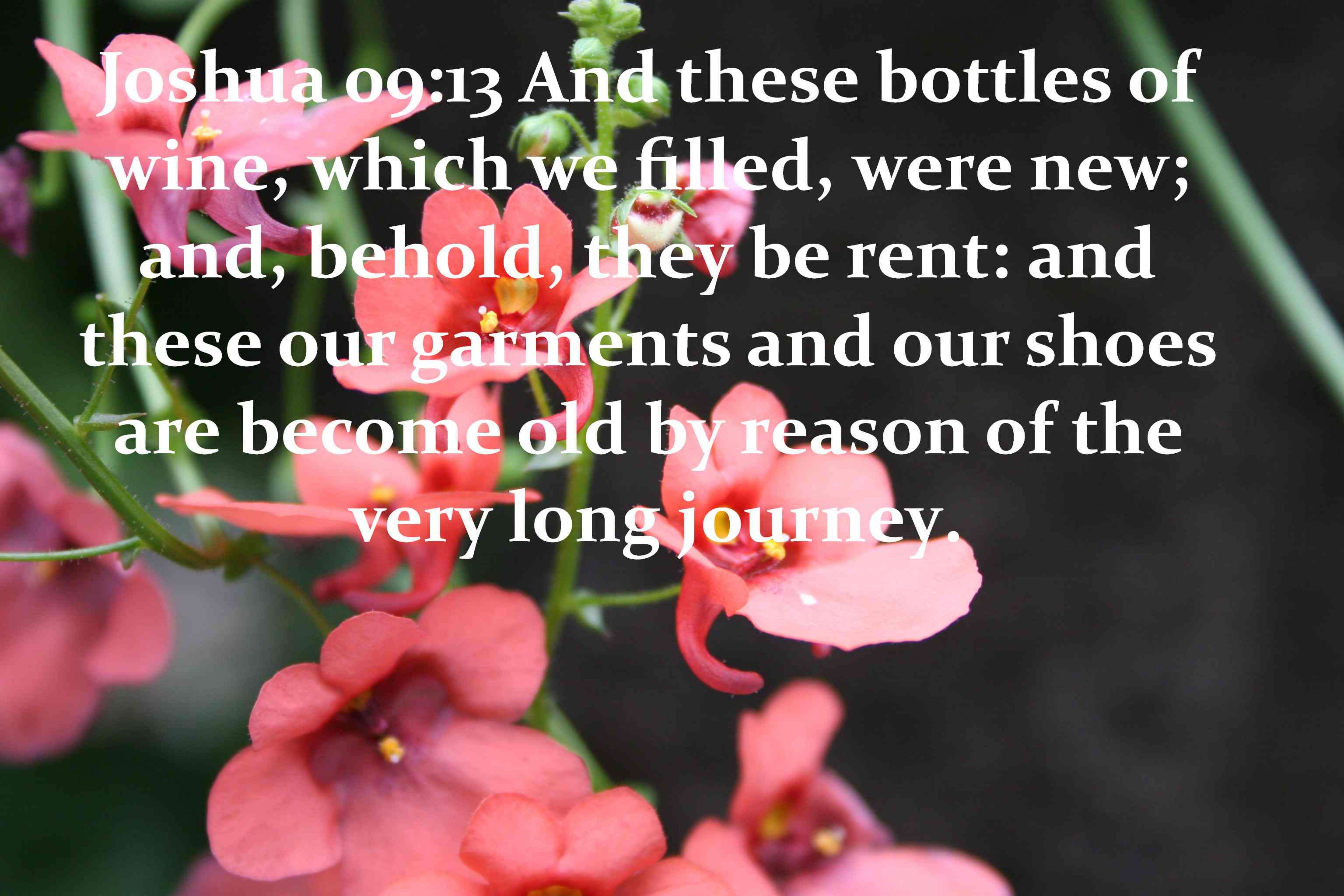
Exodus 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it;

so shall thy strength be .

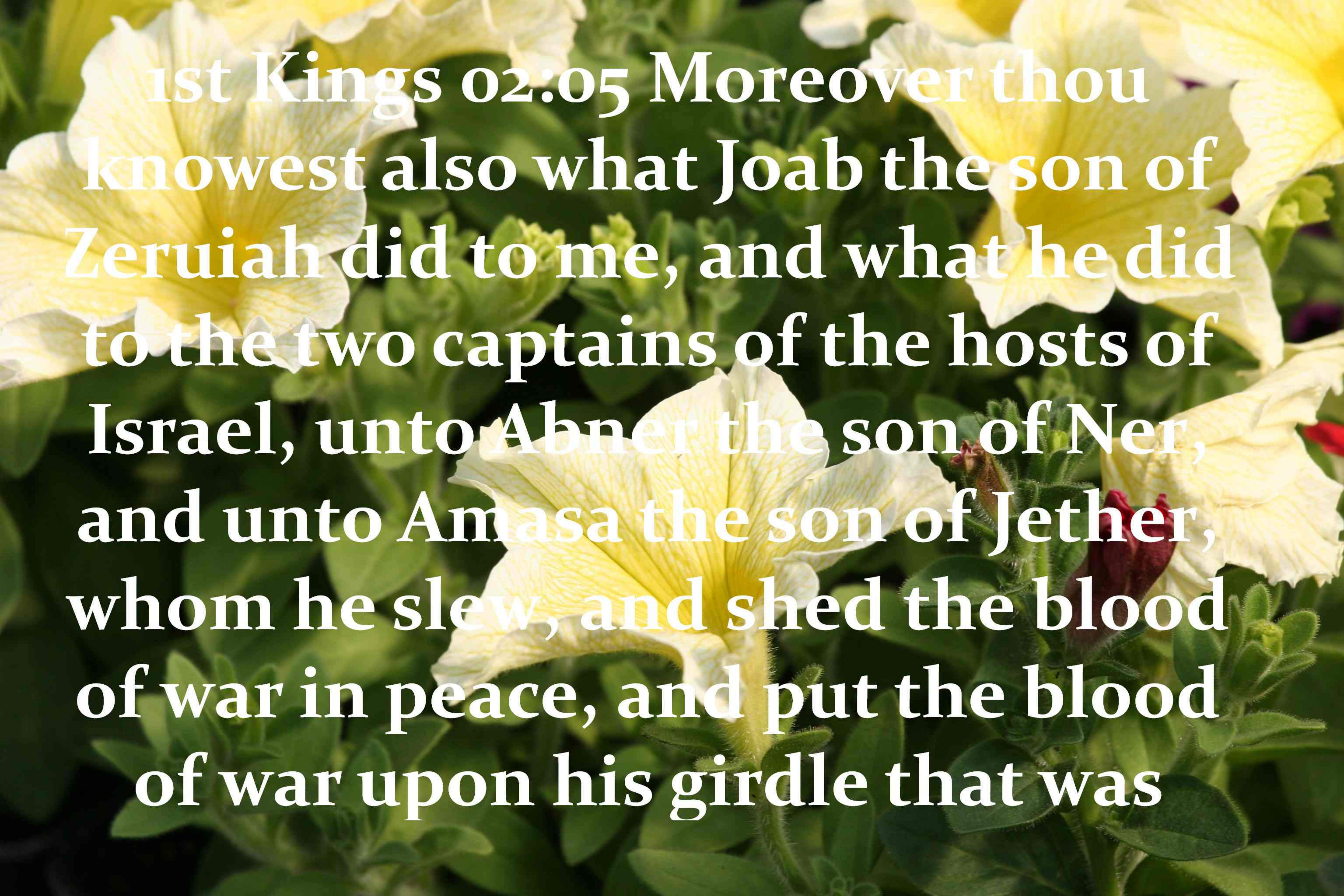

mourn one toward another.

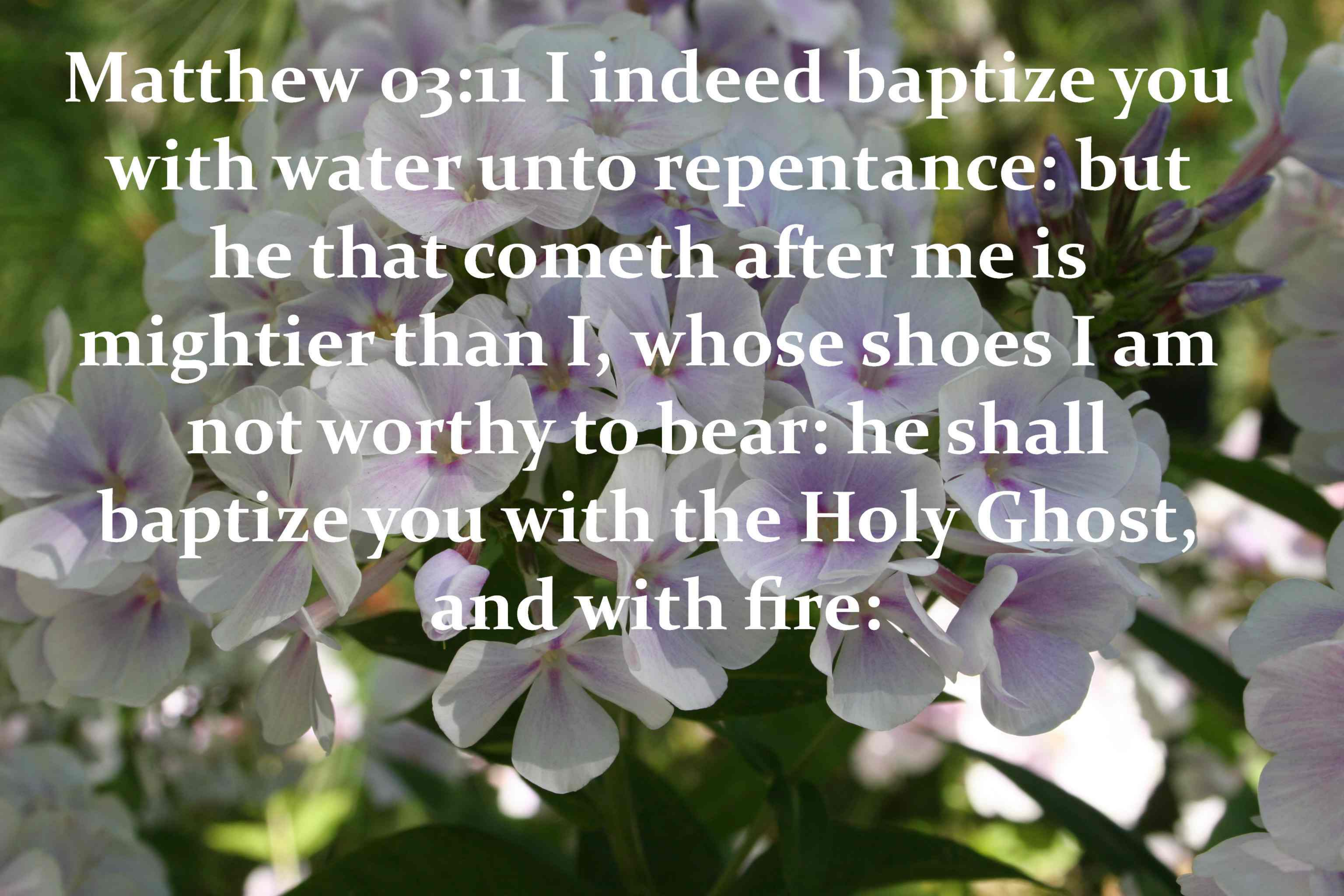
