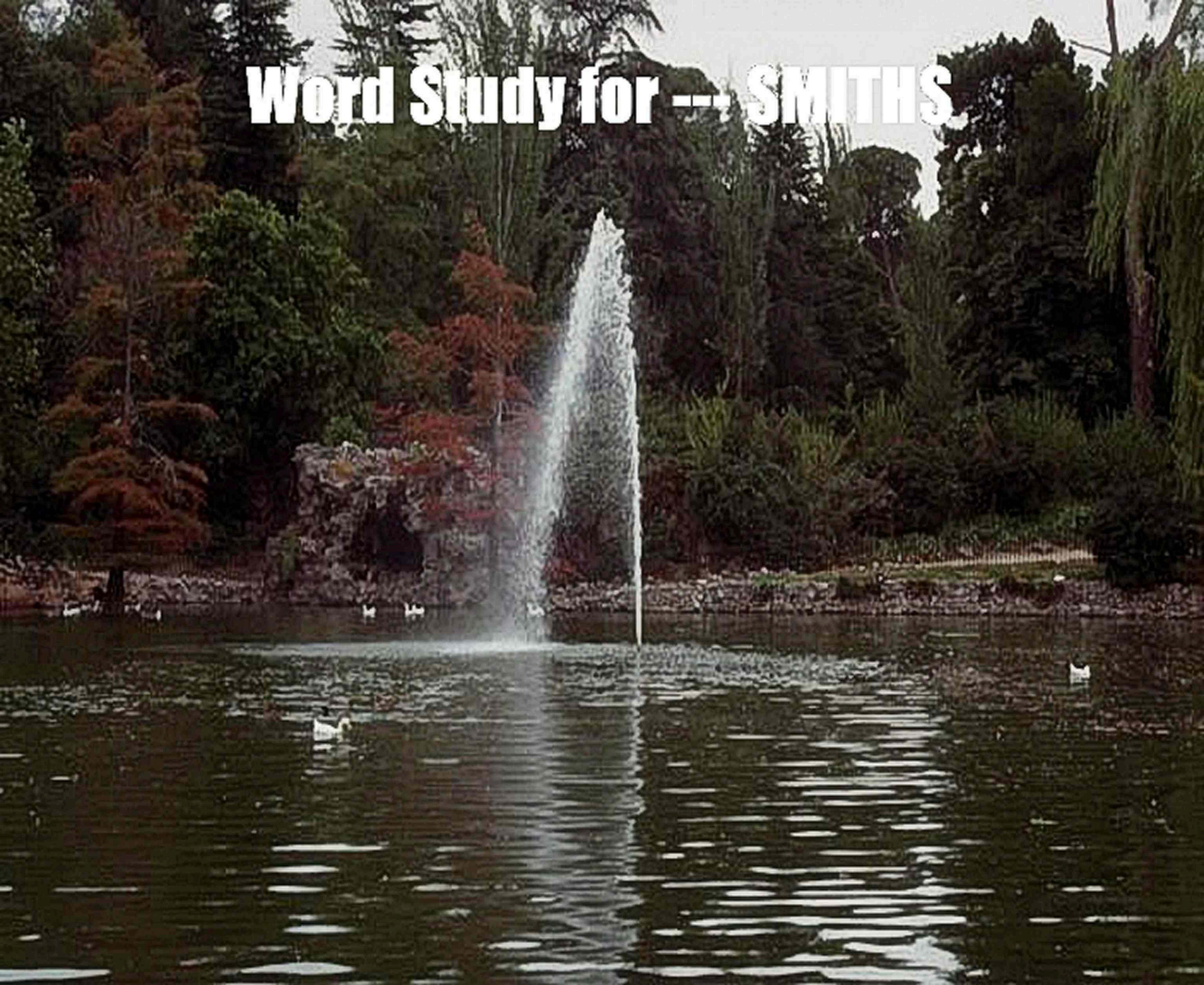



2nd Kings 24:14 And he carried

brought captive to Babylon.








Jeremiah 24:01 The LORD showed
