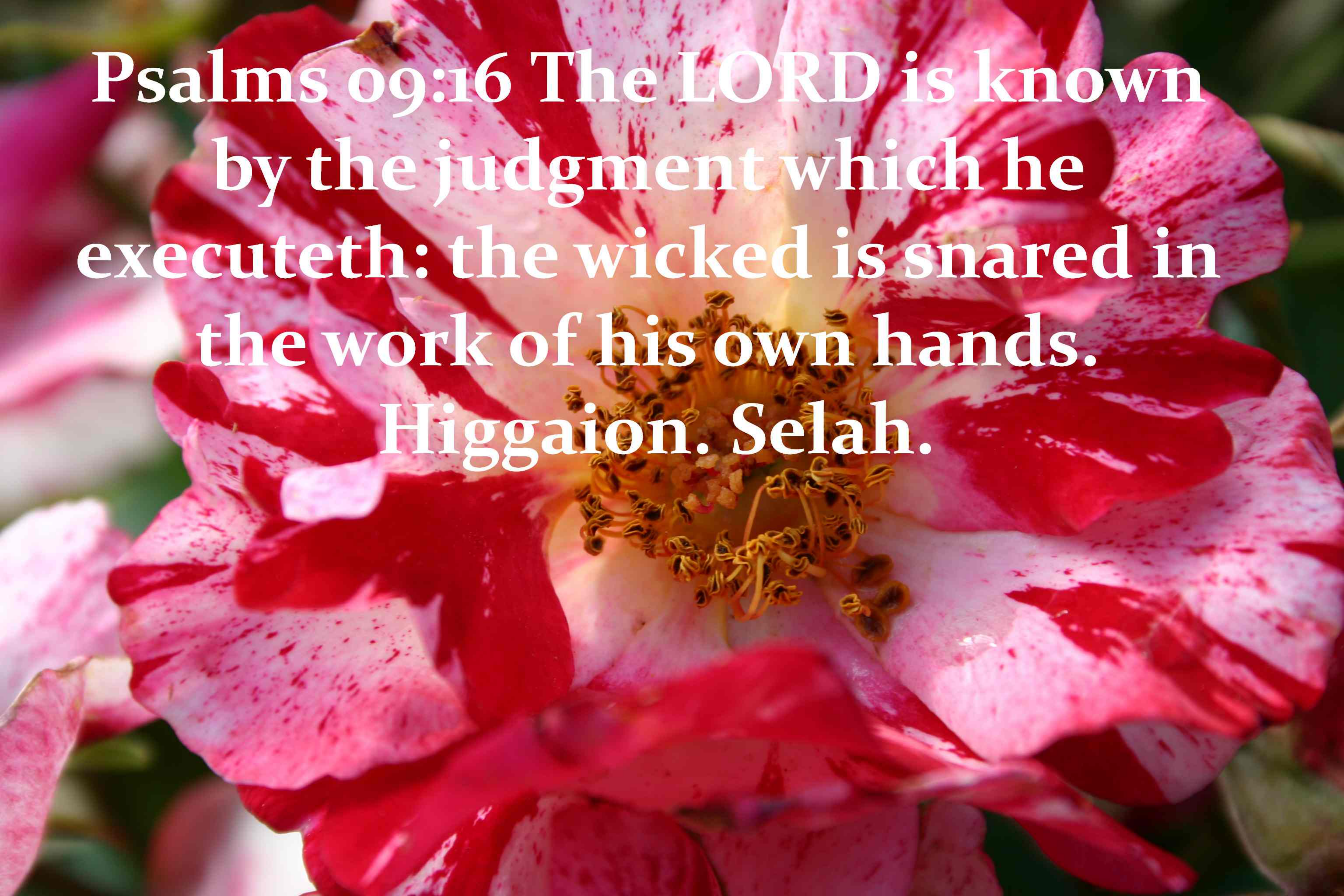

will I do likewise.

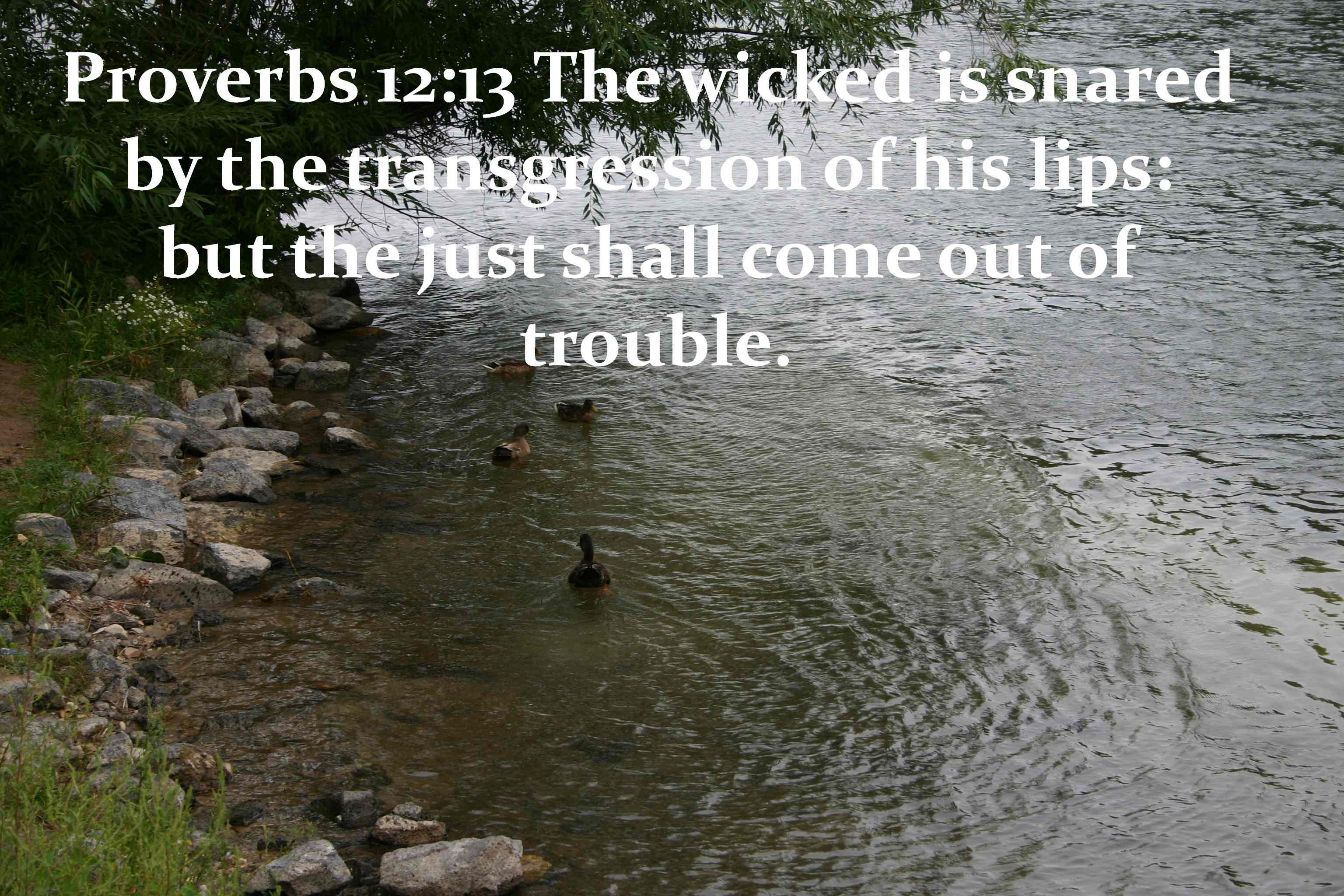


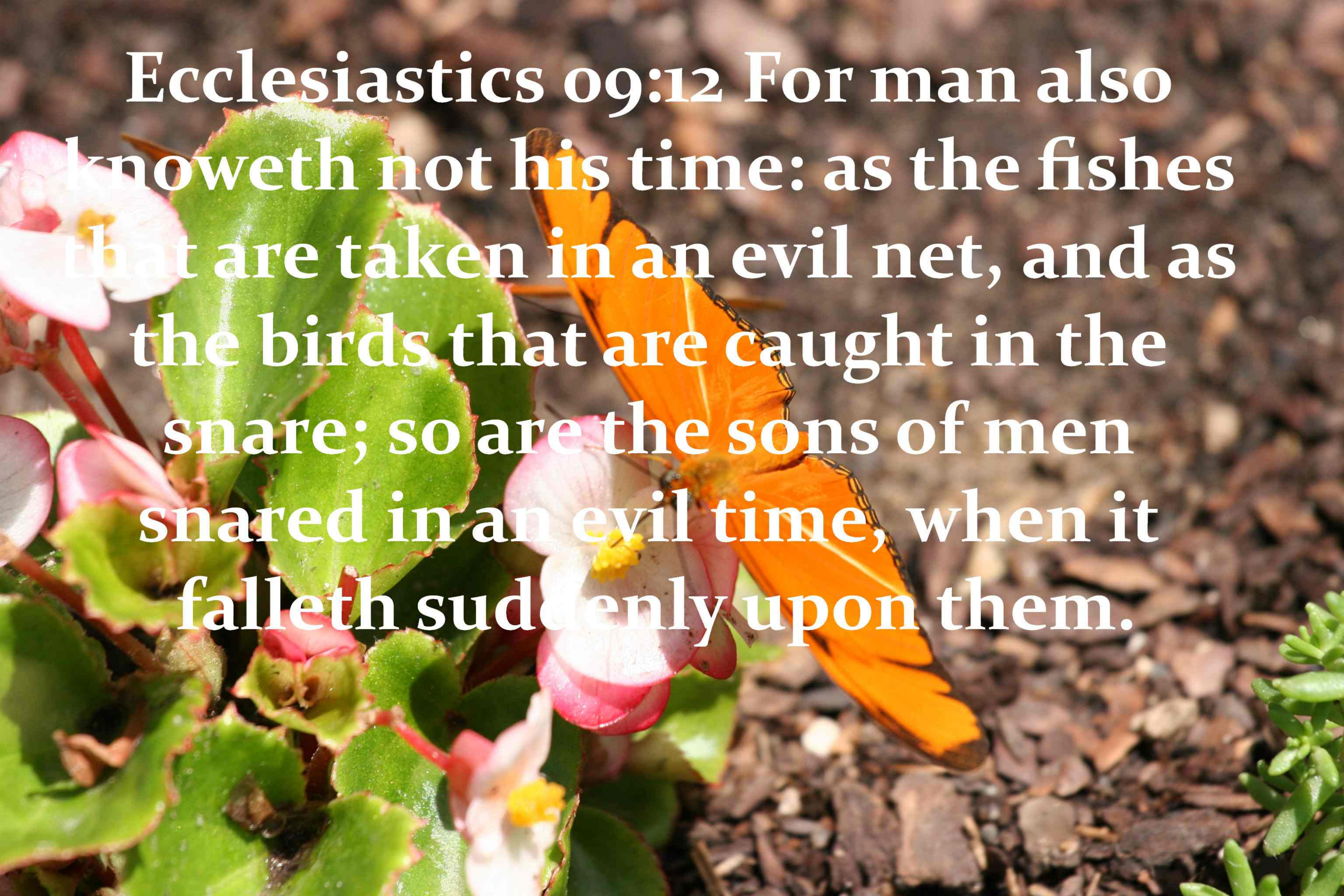
