




And the people were faint.

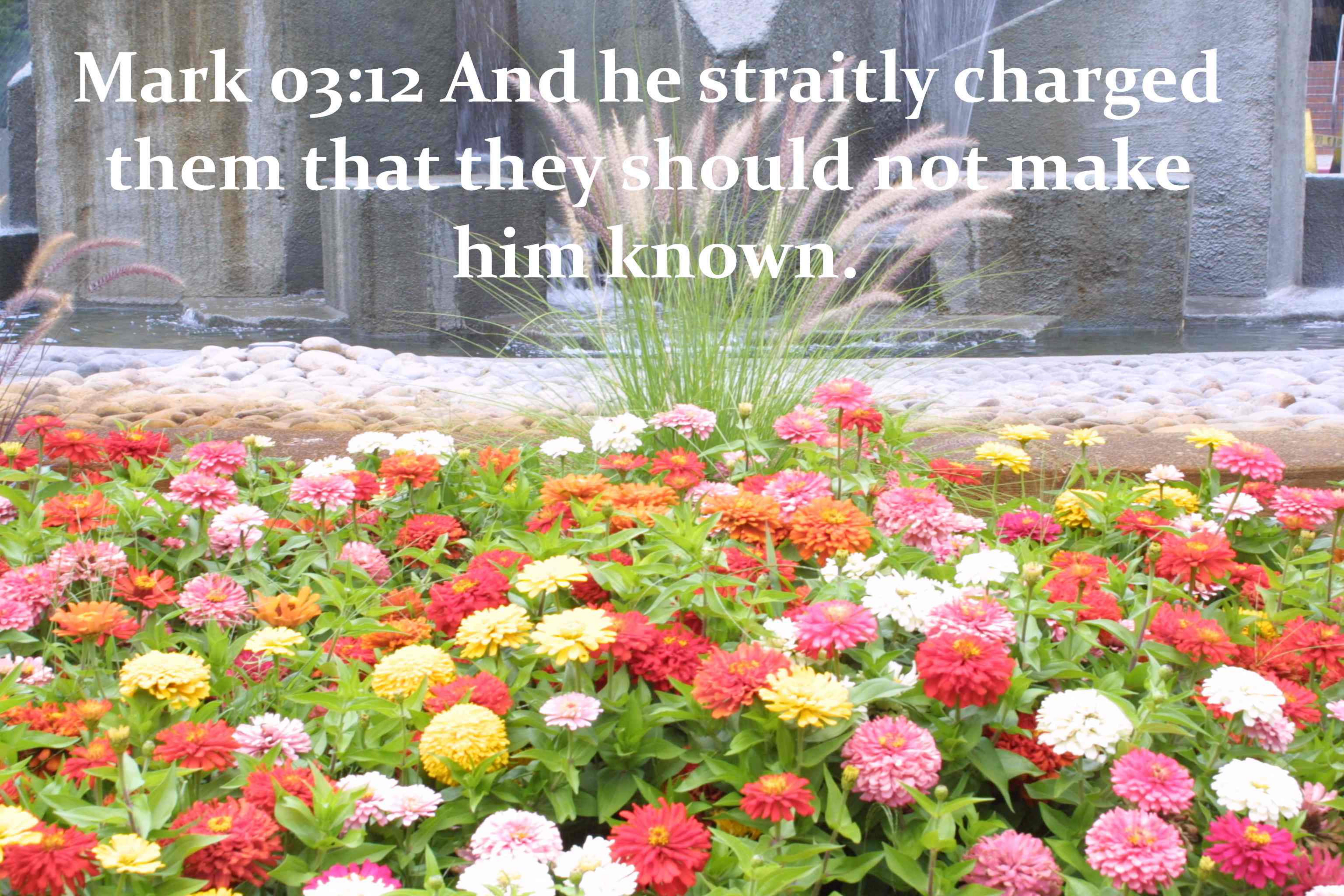


Matthew 09:30 And their eyes were

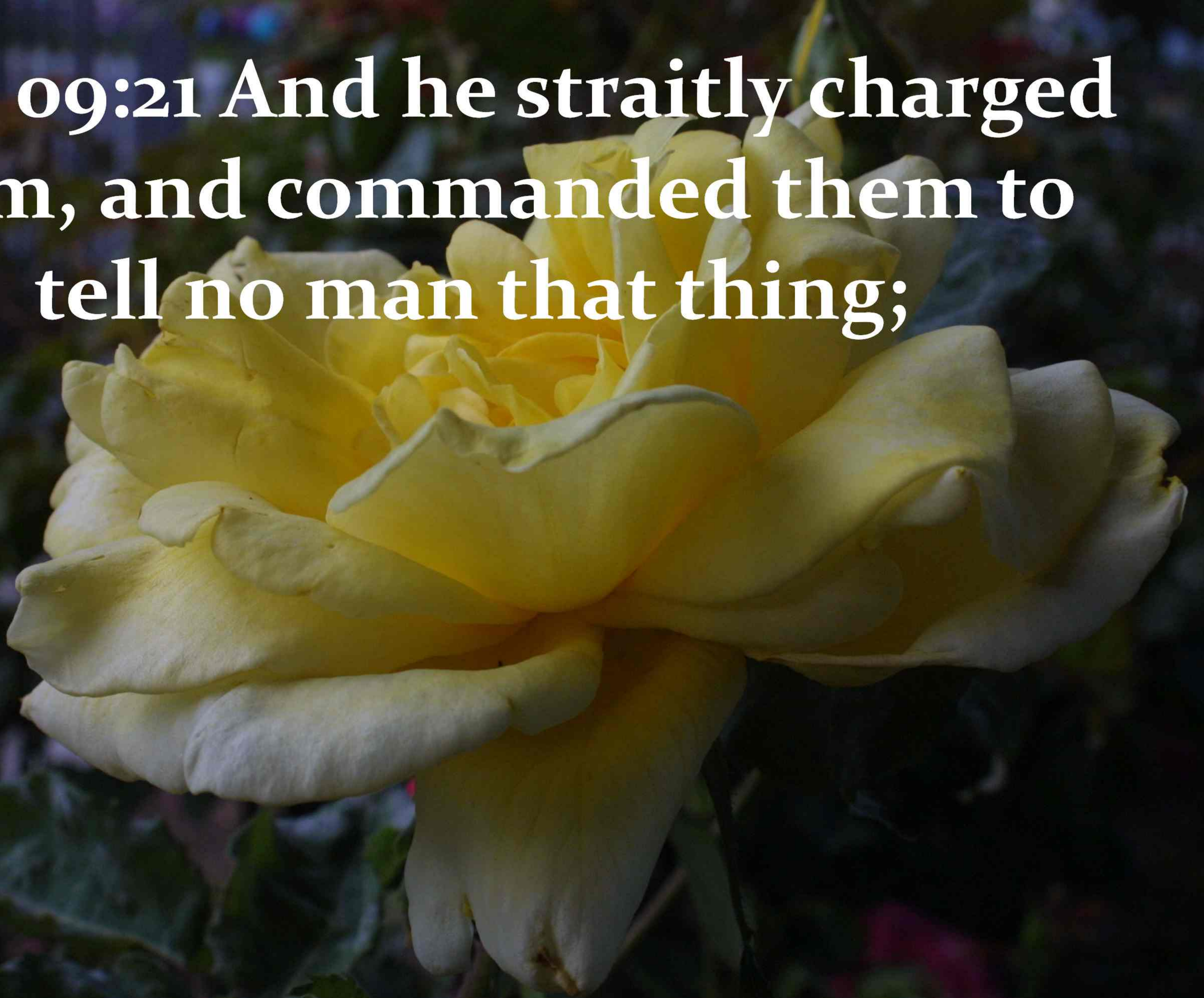




