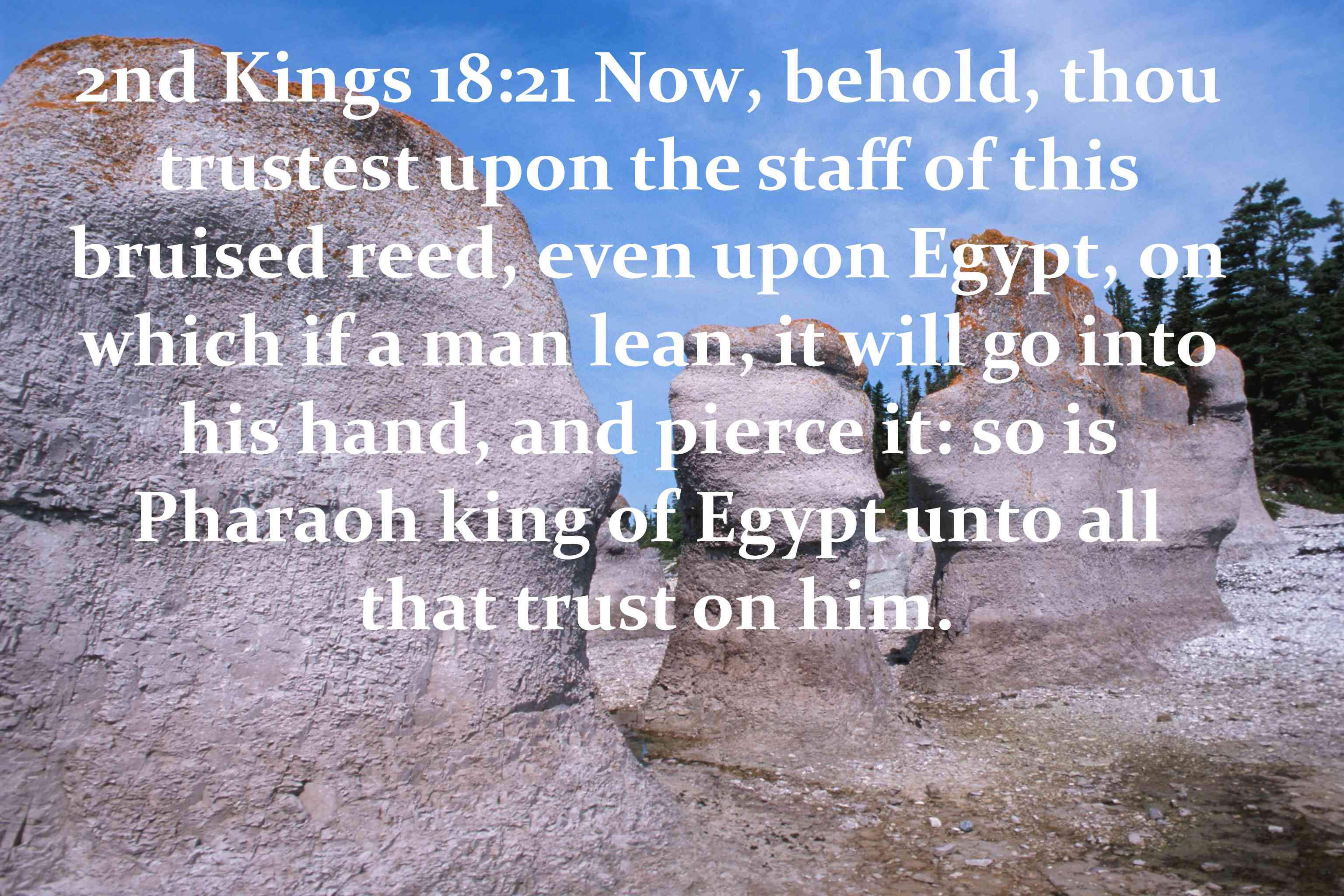

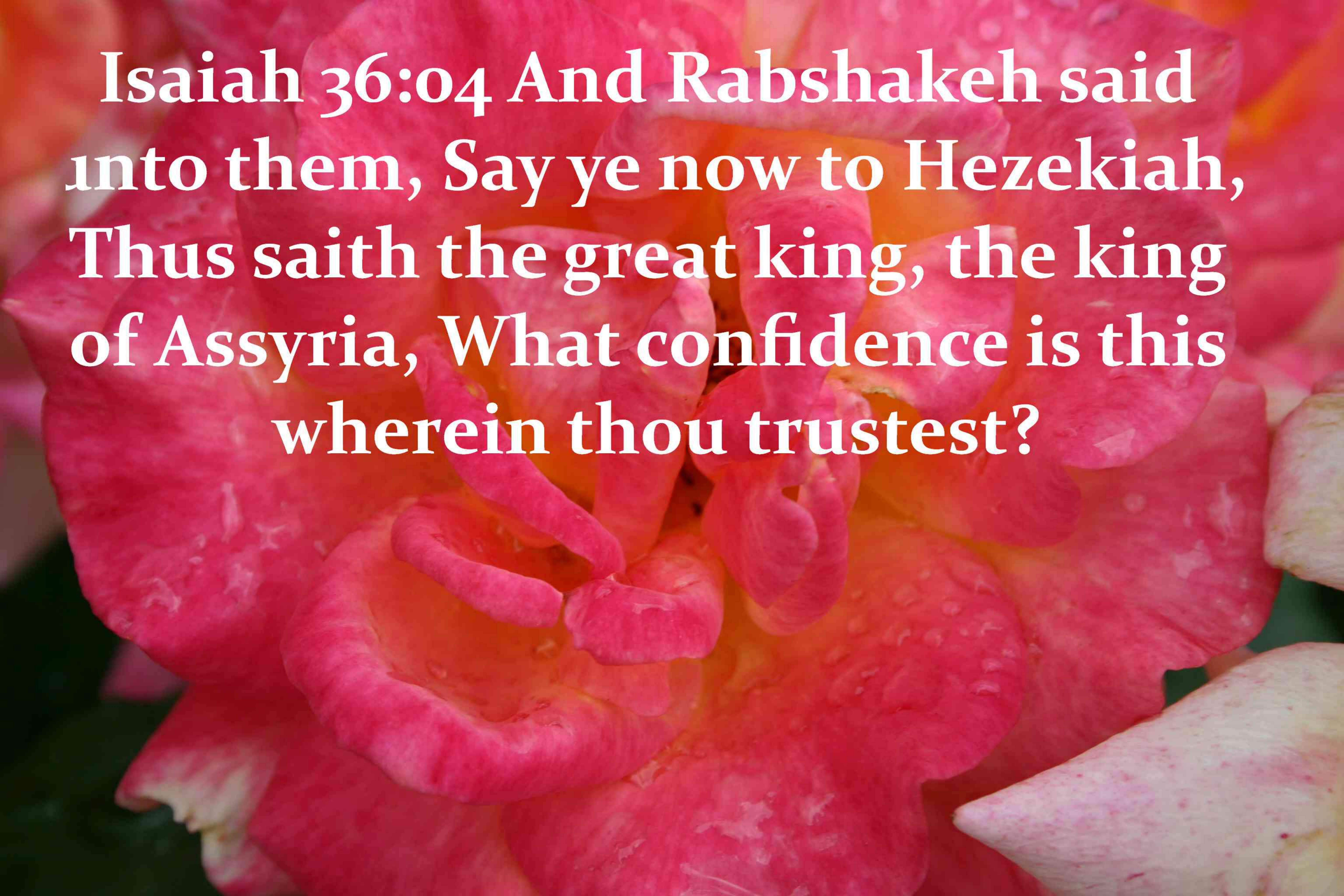
2nd Kings 18:19 And Rabshakeh

trustest?



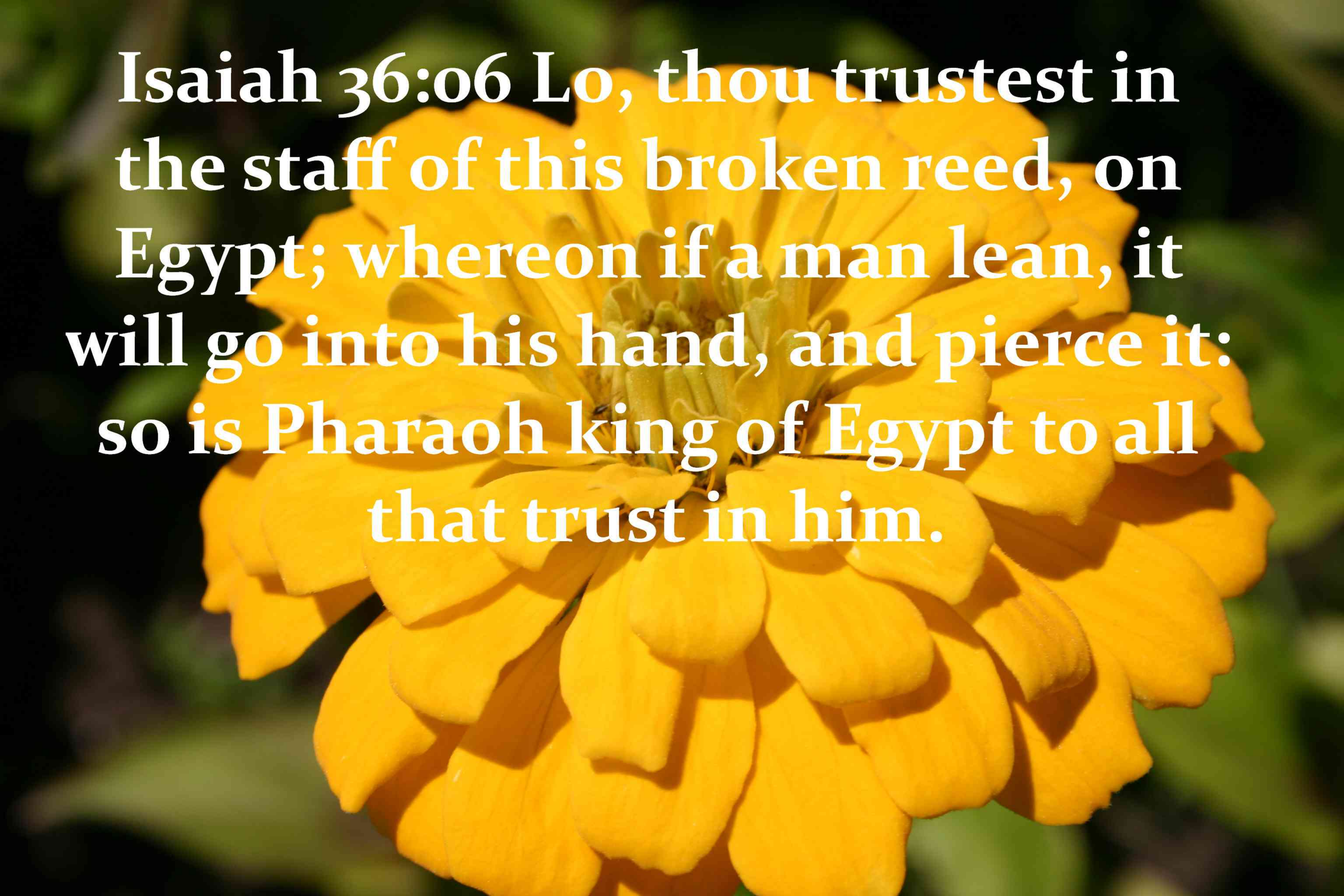
2nd Kings 18:21 Now, behold, thou

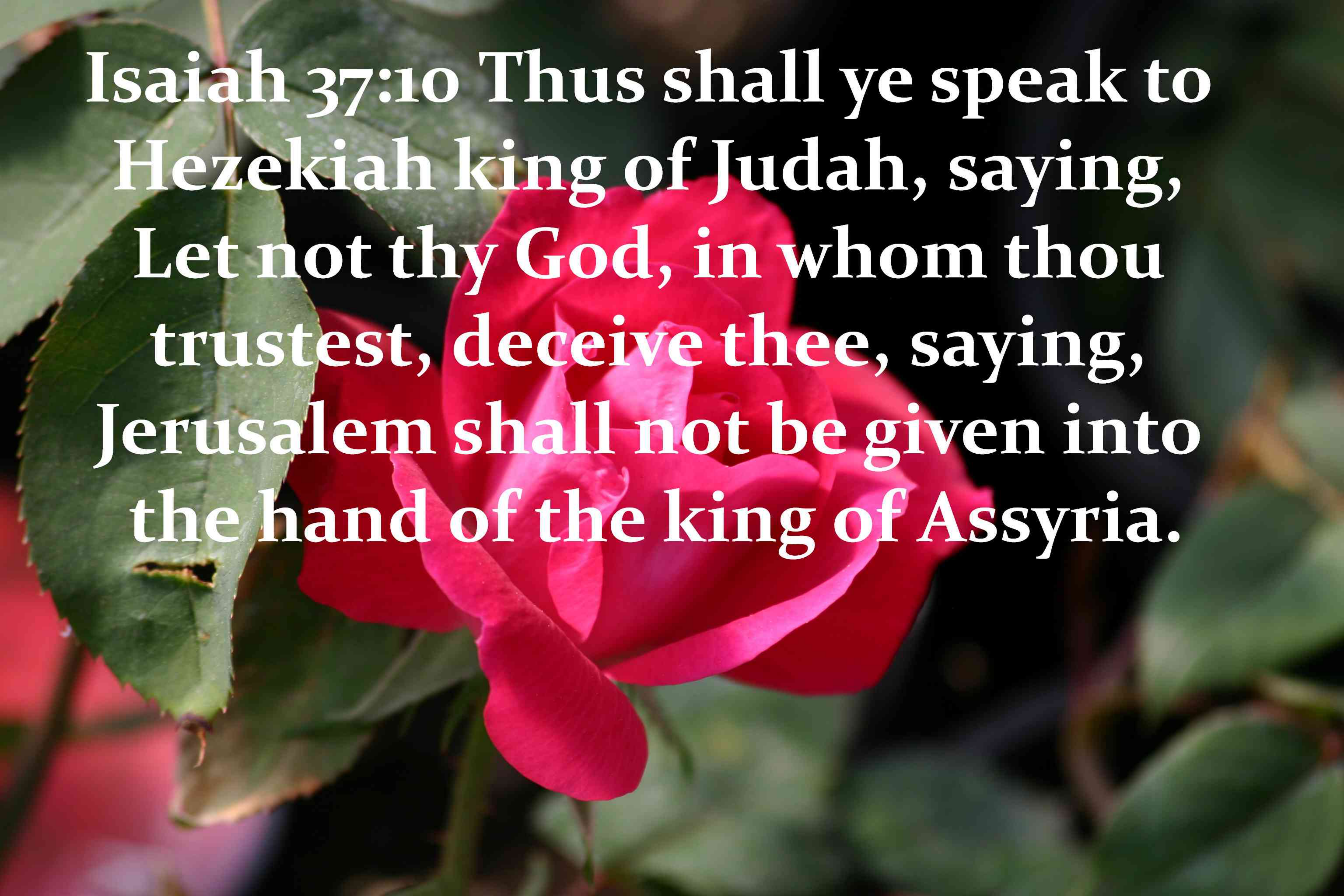
2nd Kings 19:10 Thus shall ye speak
