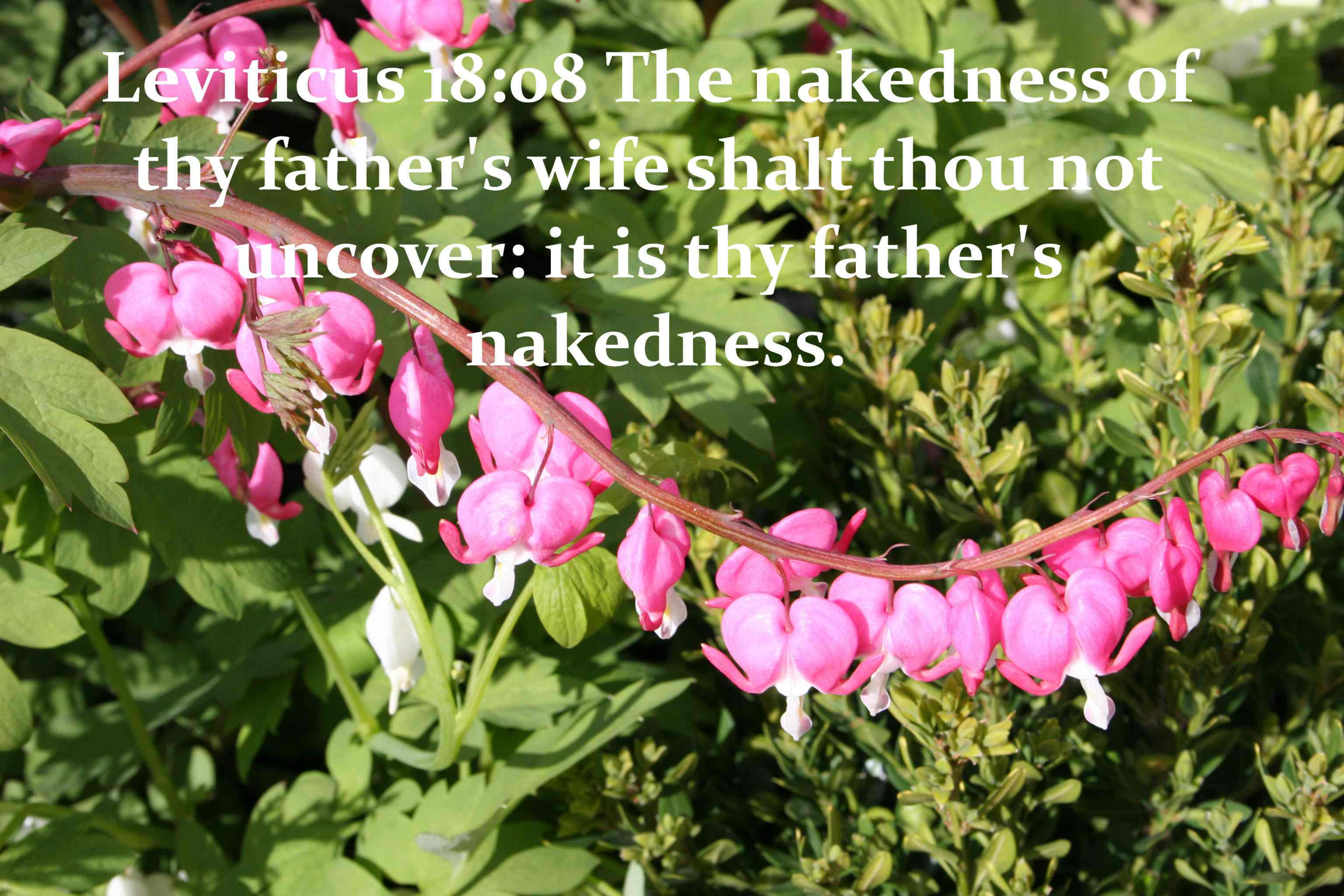

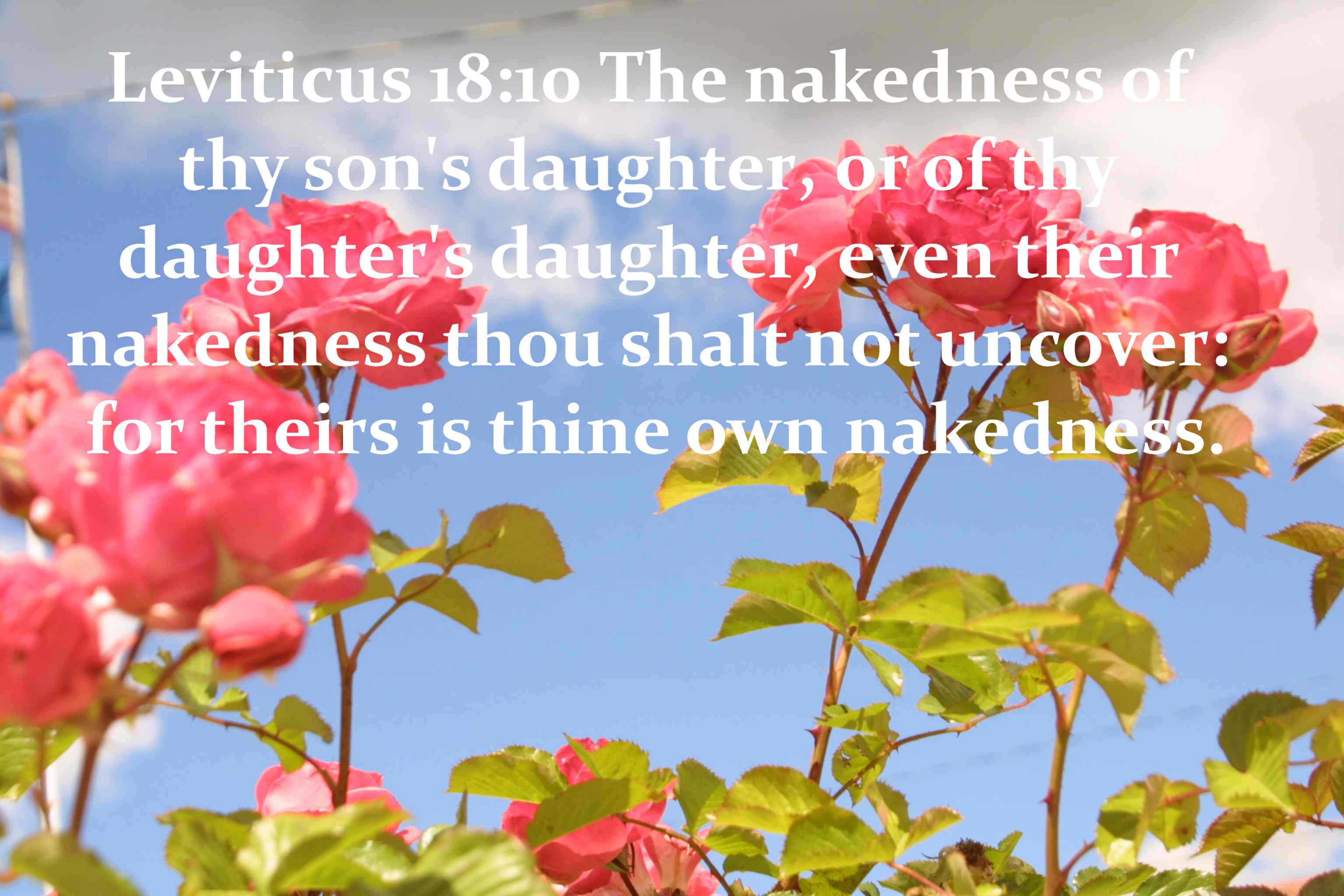




Leviticus 18:09 The nakedness of

thou shalt not uncover.









Leviticus 18:10 The nakedness of








Leviticus 18:18 Neither shalt thou

the other in her life time .






**Leviticus 18:19 Also thou shalt not

uncleanness.**




Leviticus 20:18 And if a man shall




Leviticus 21:10 And he that is the

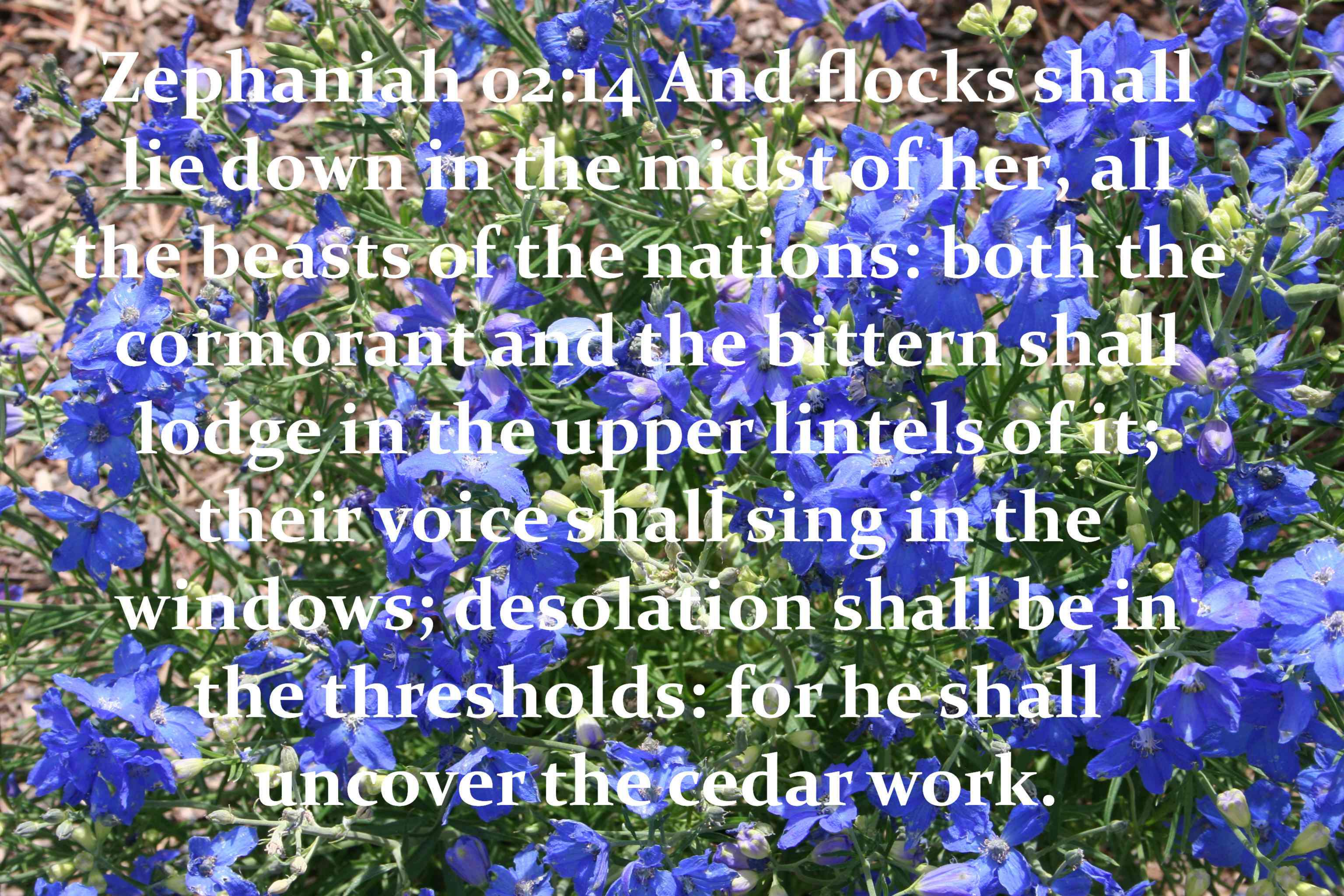
