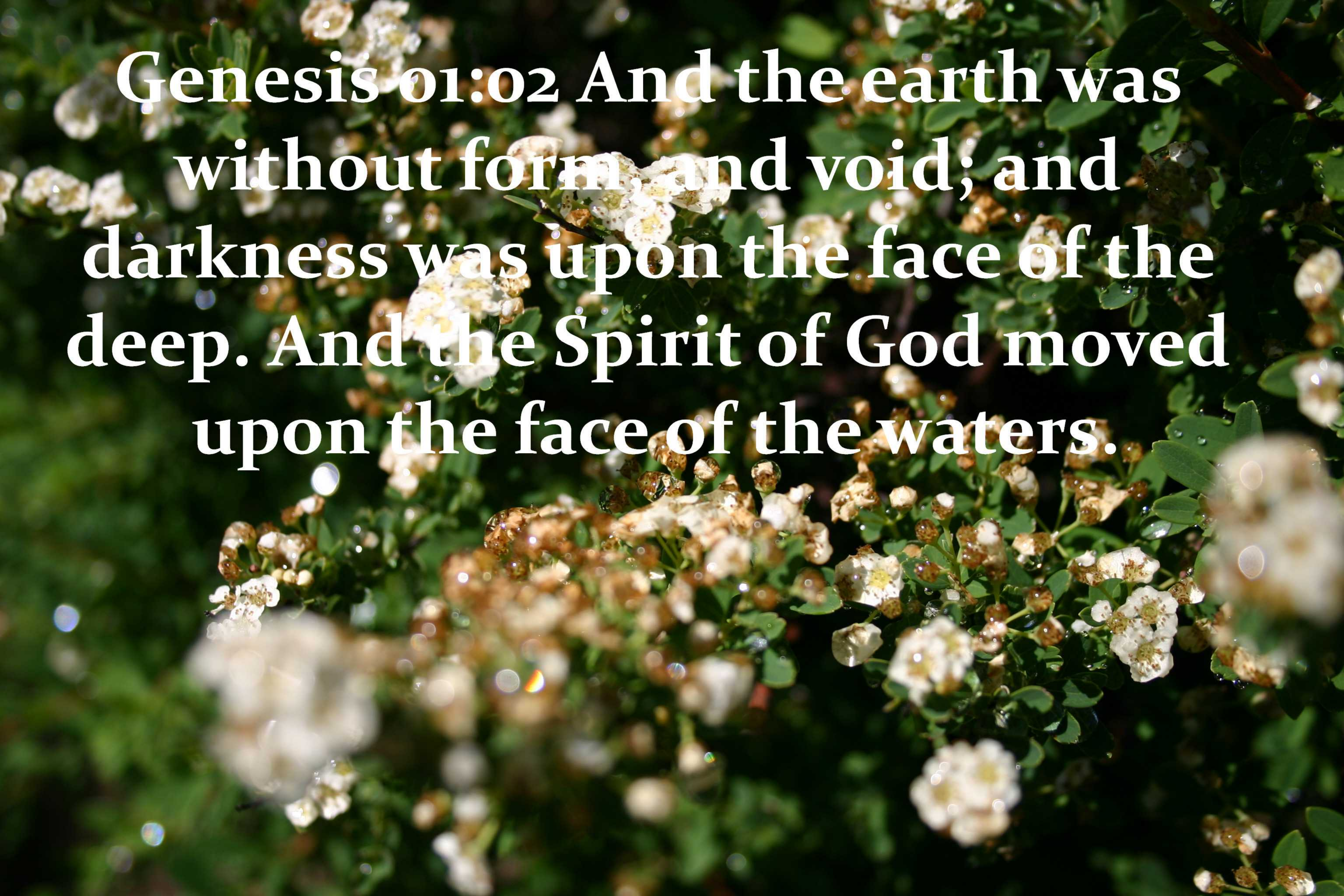
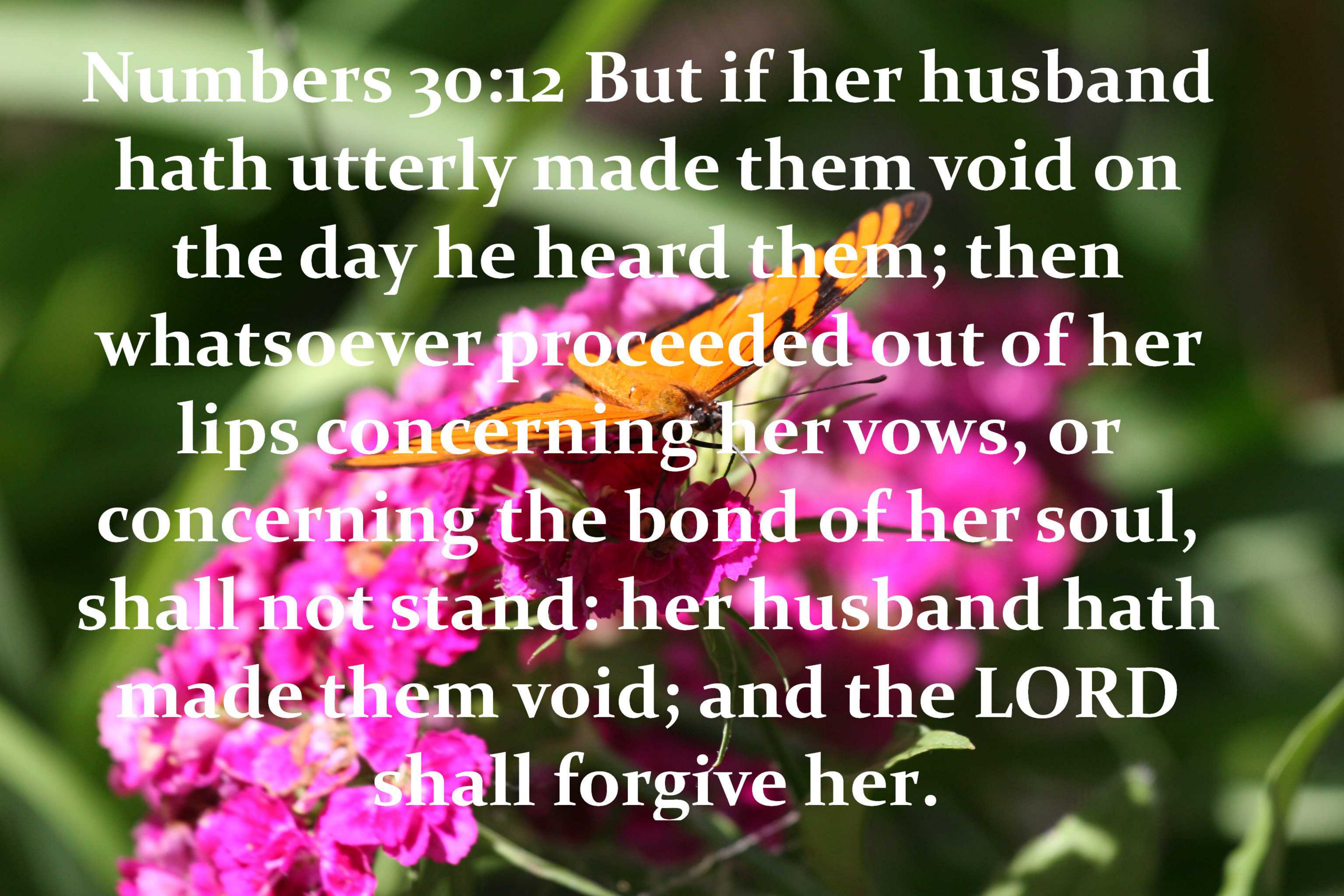

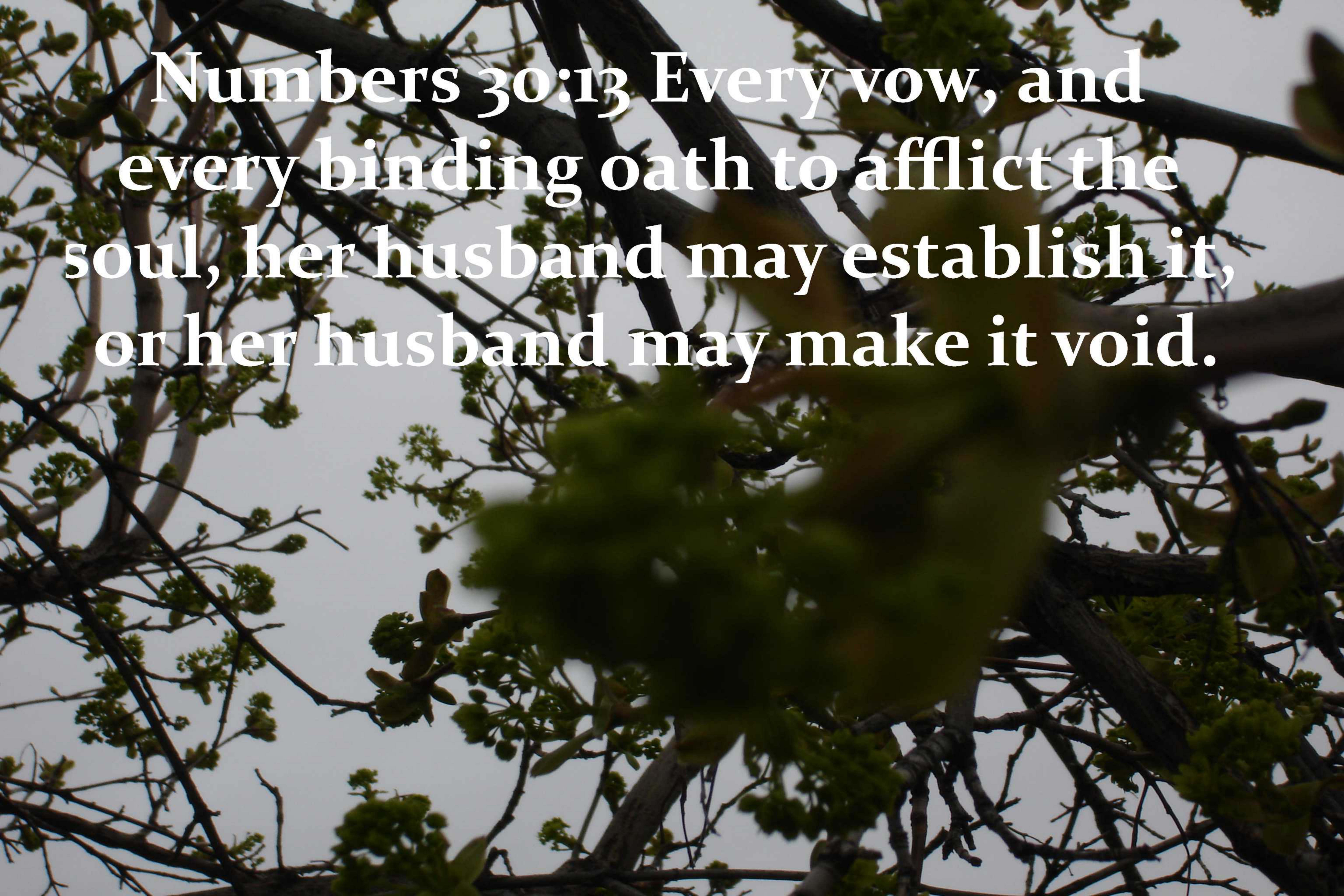




Genesis 01:02 And the earth was

upon the face of the waters.

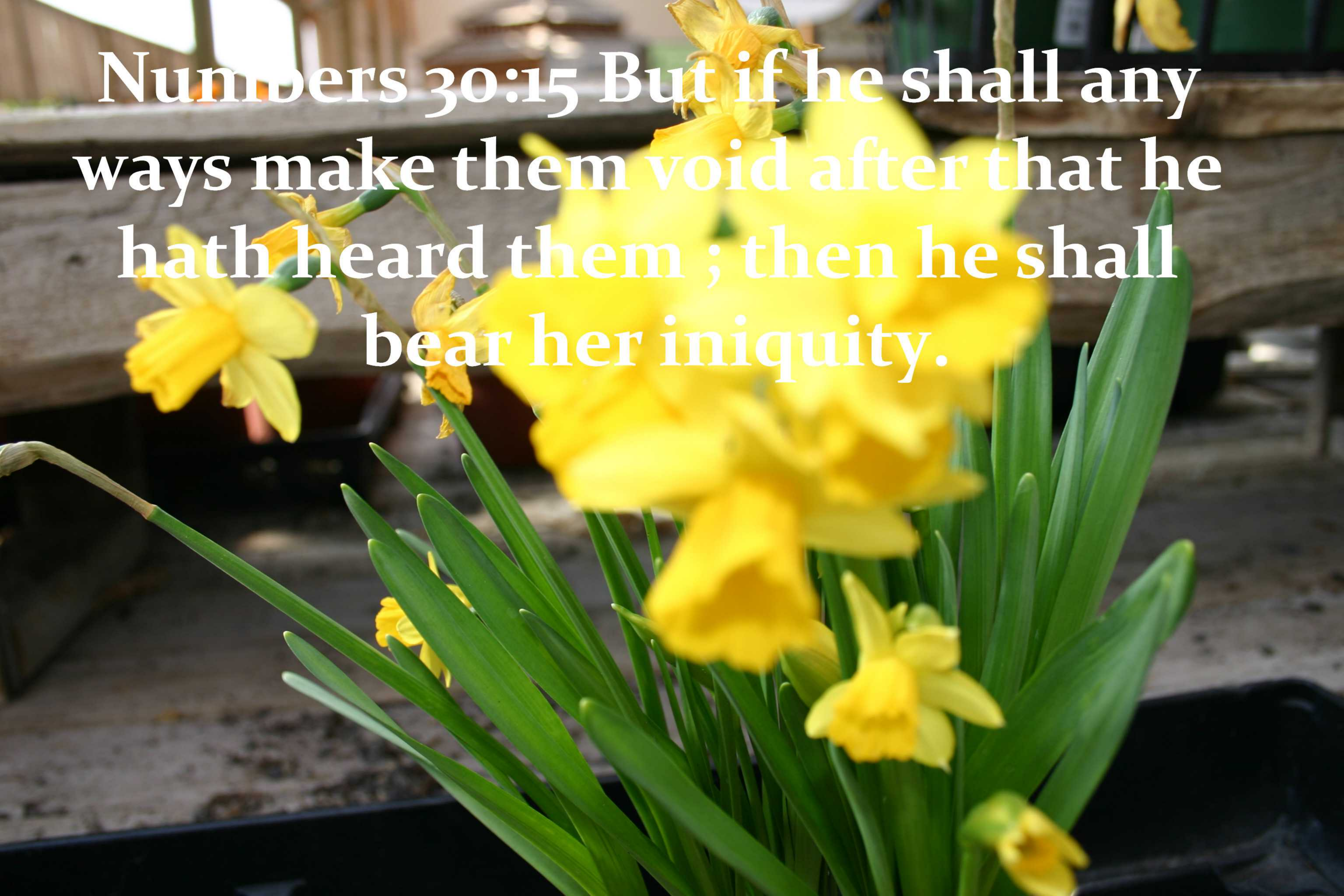

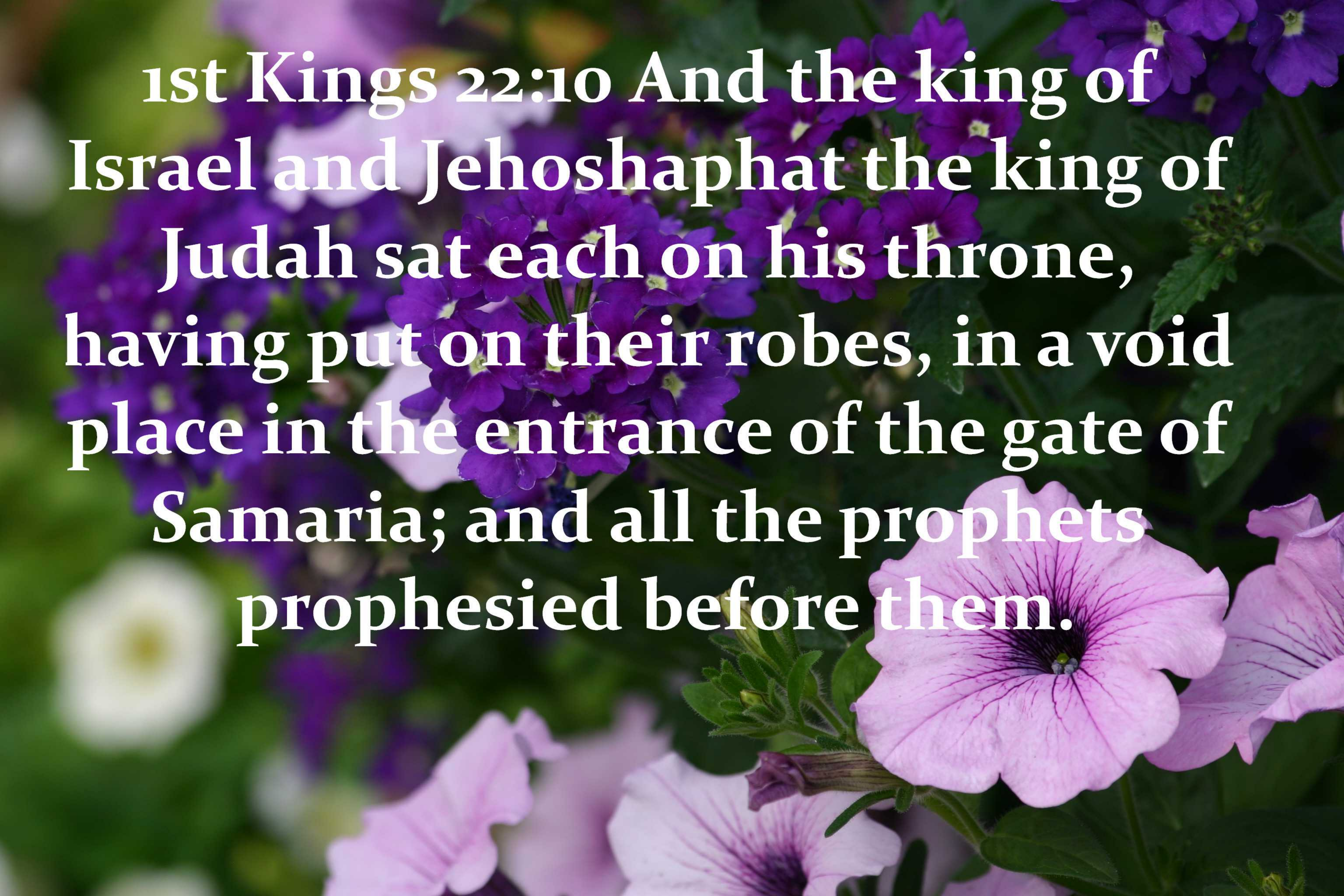


Numbers 30:13 Every vow, and every binding oath to afflict the soul, her husband may establish it, or her husband may make it void.

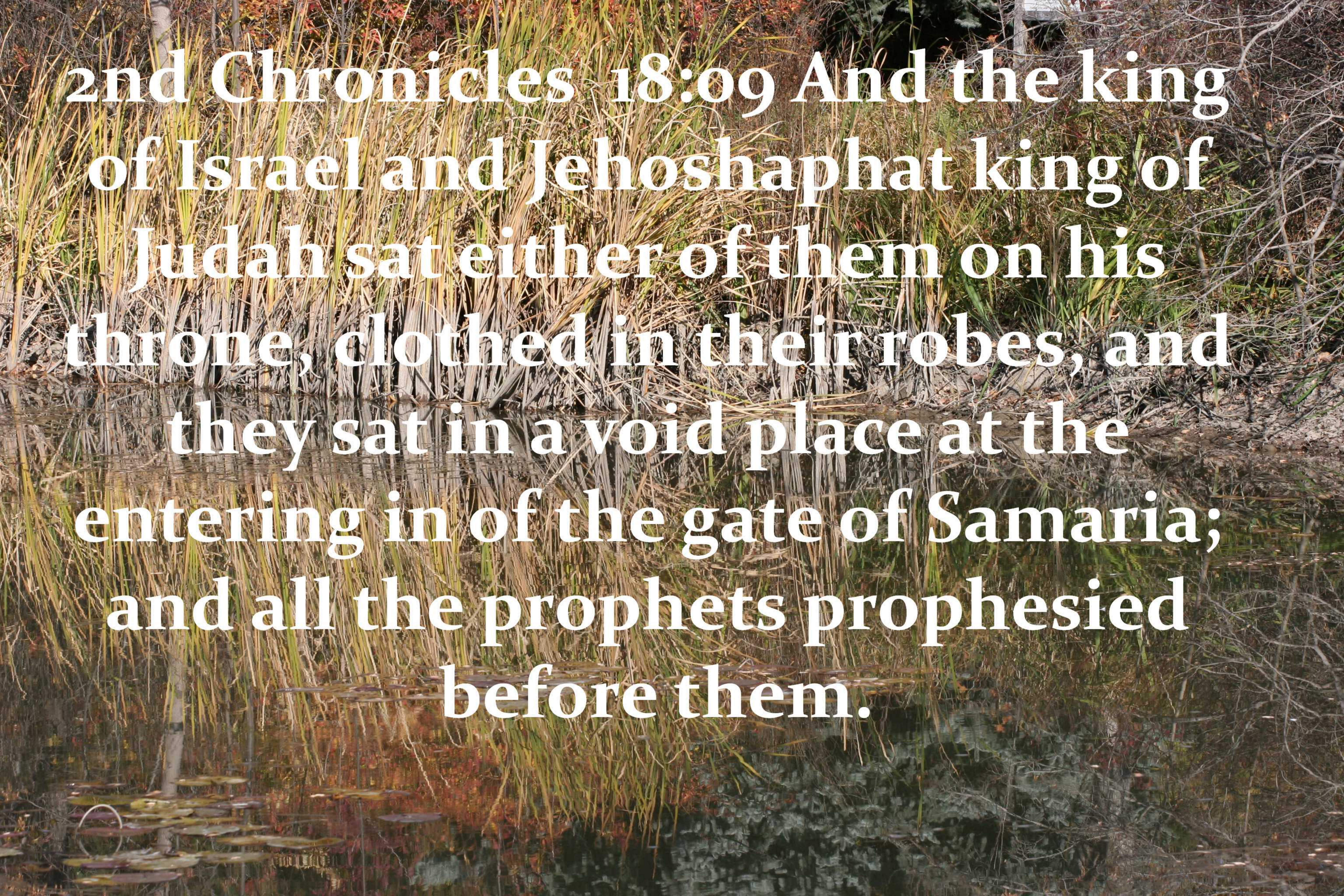
Numbers 30:15 But if he shall any

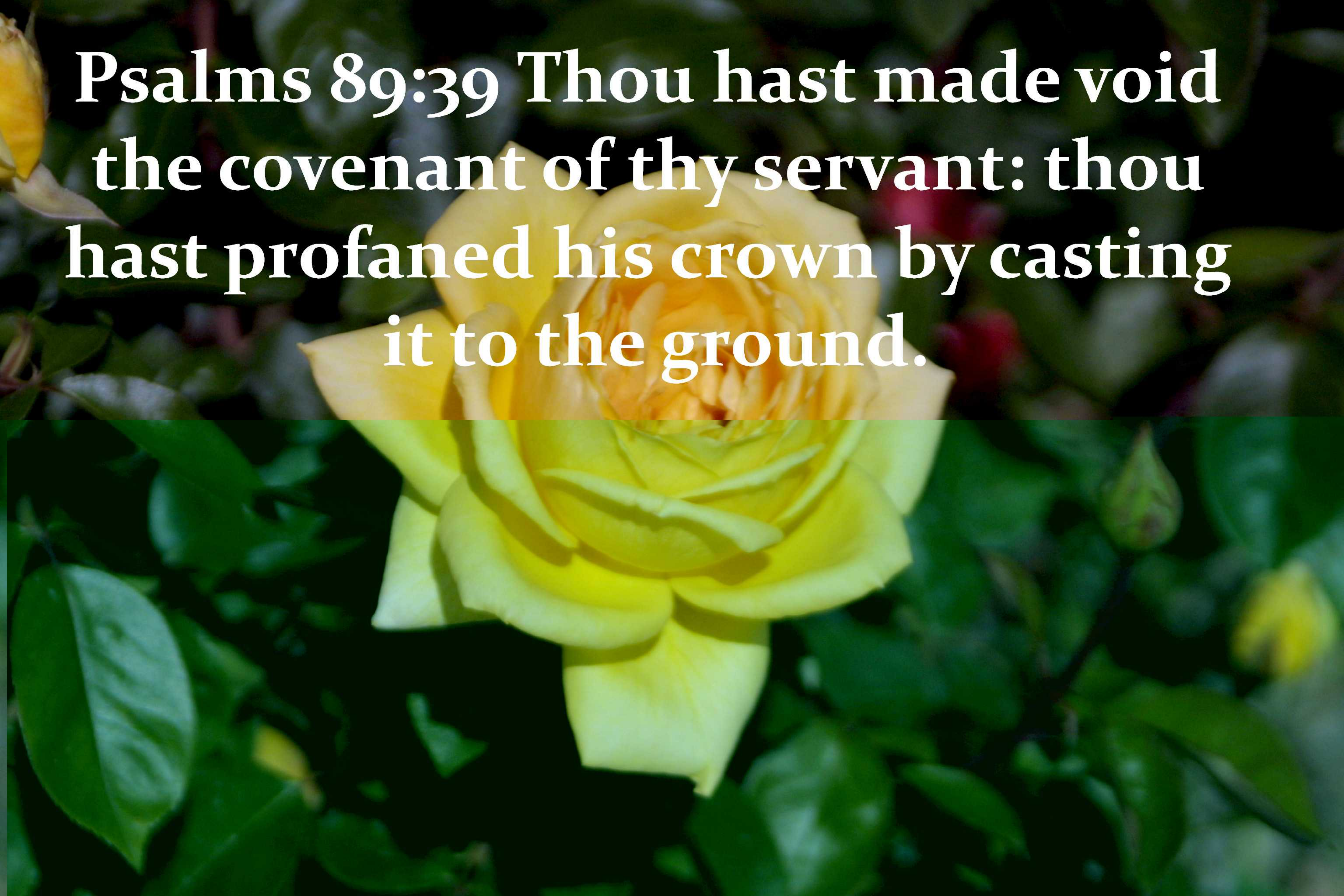

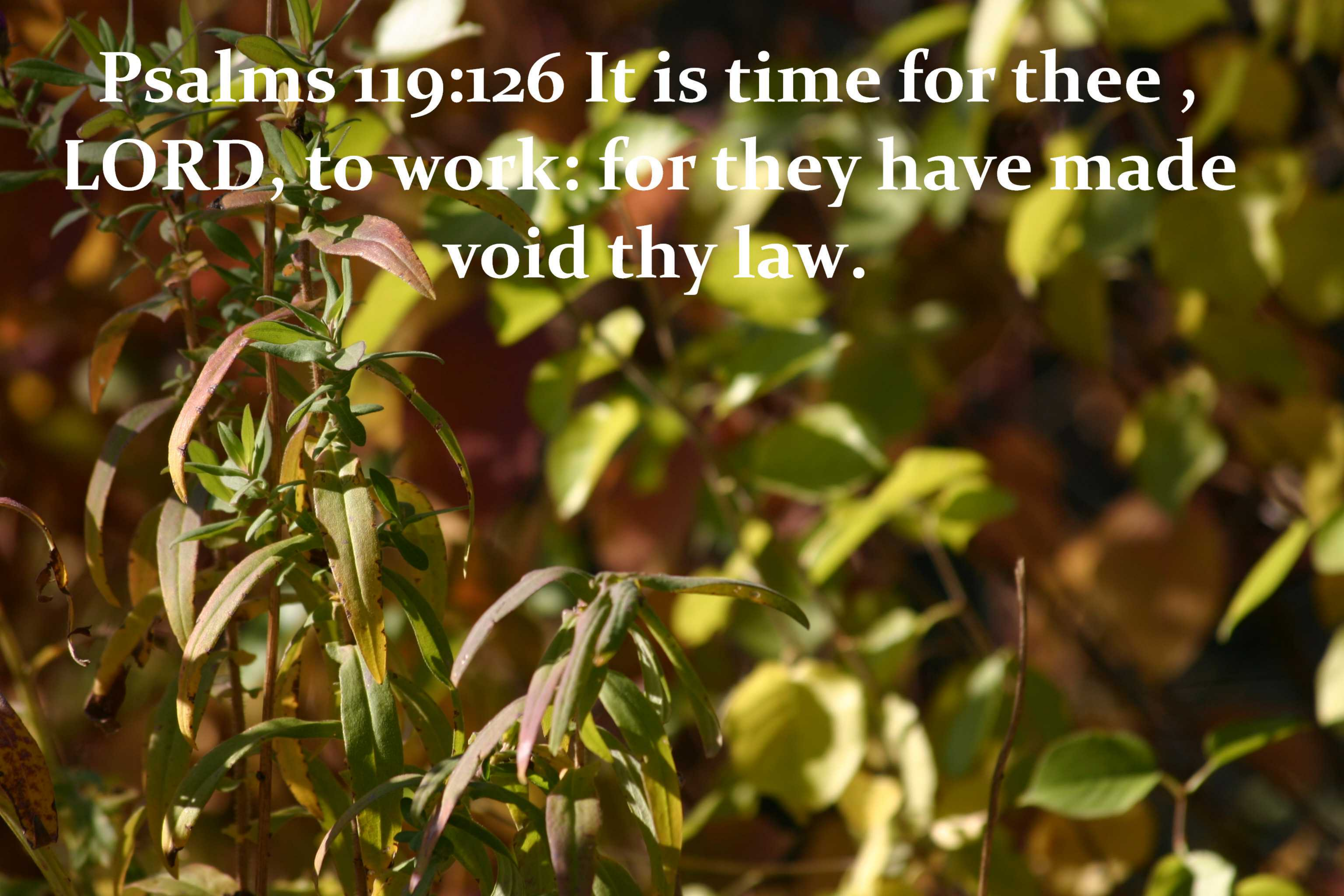

before them.

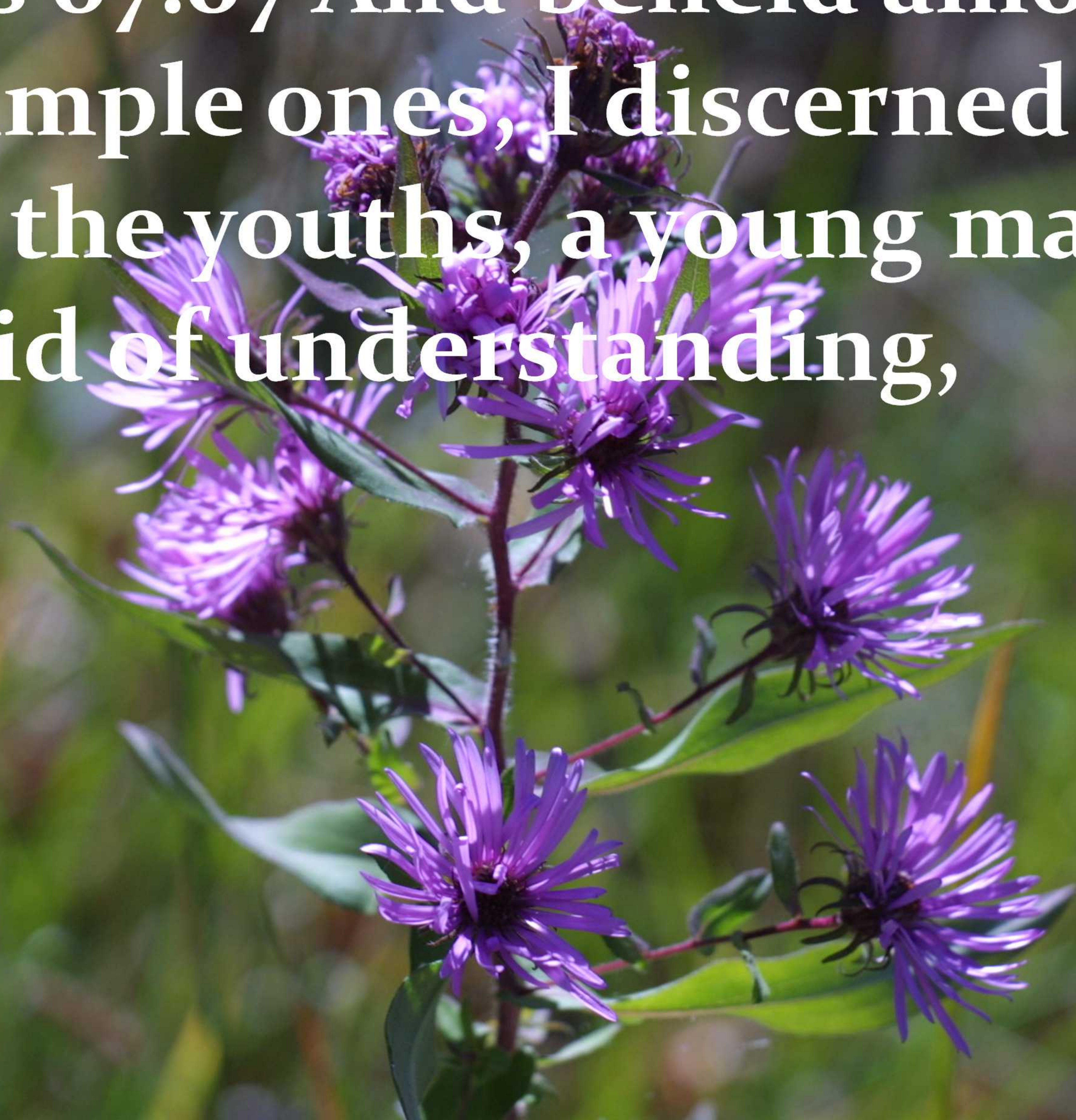


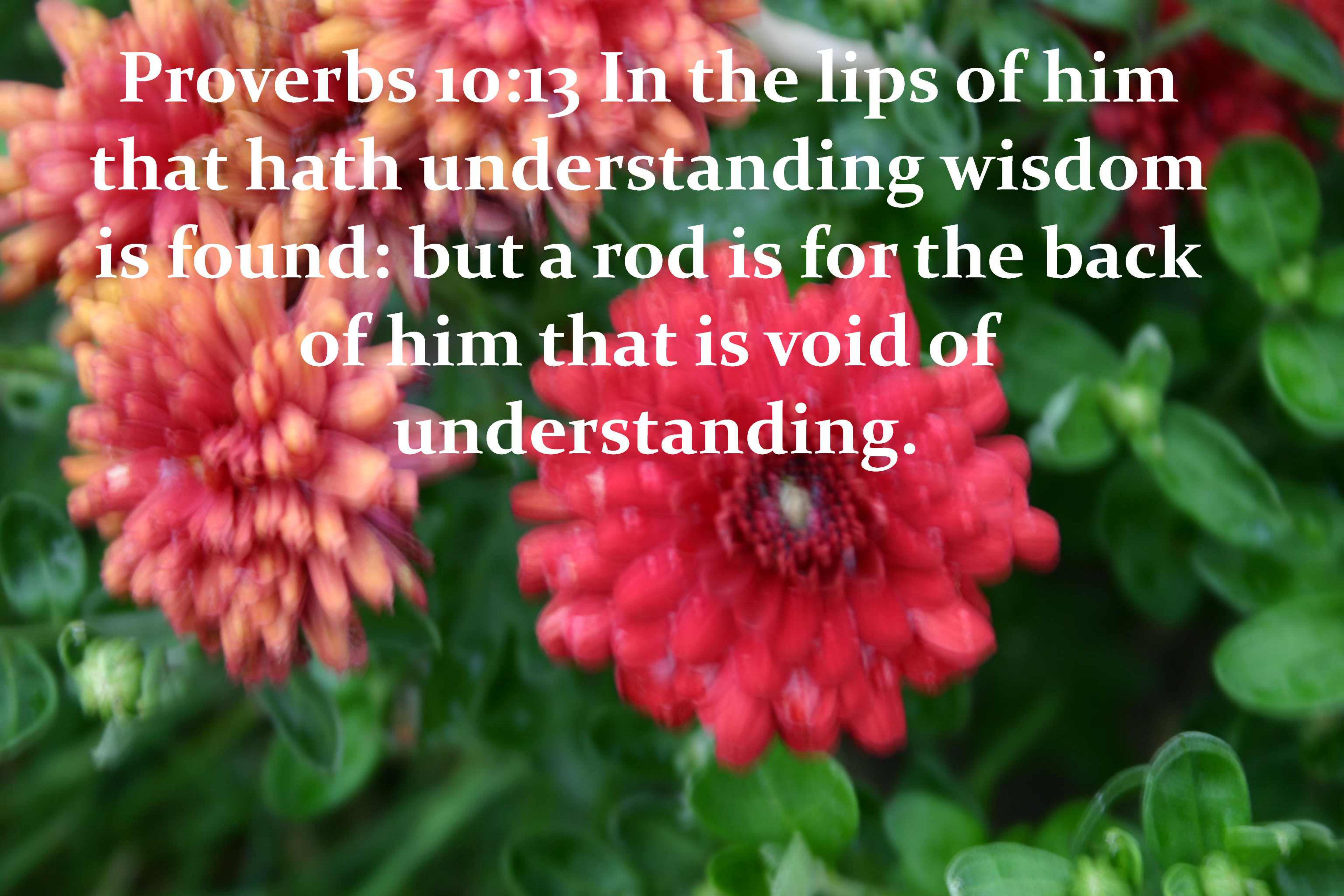

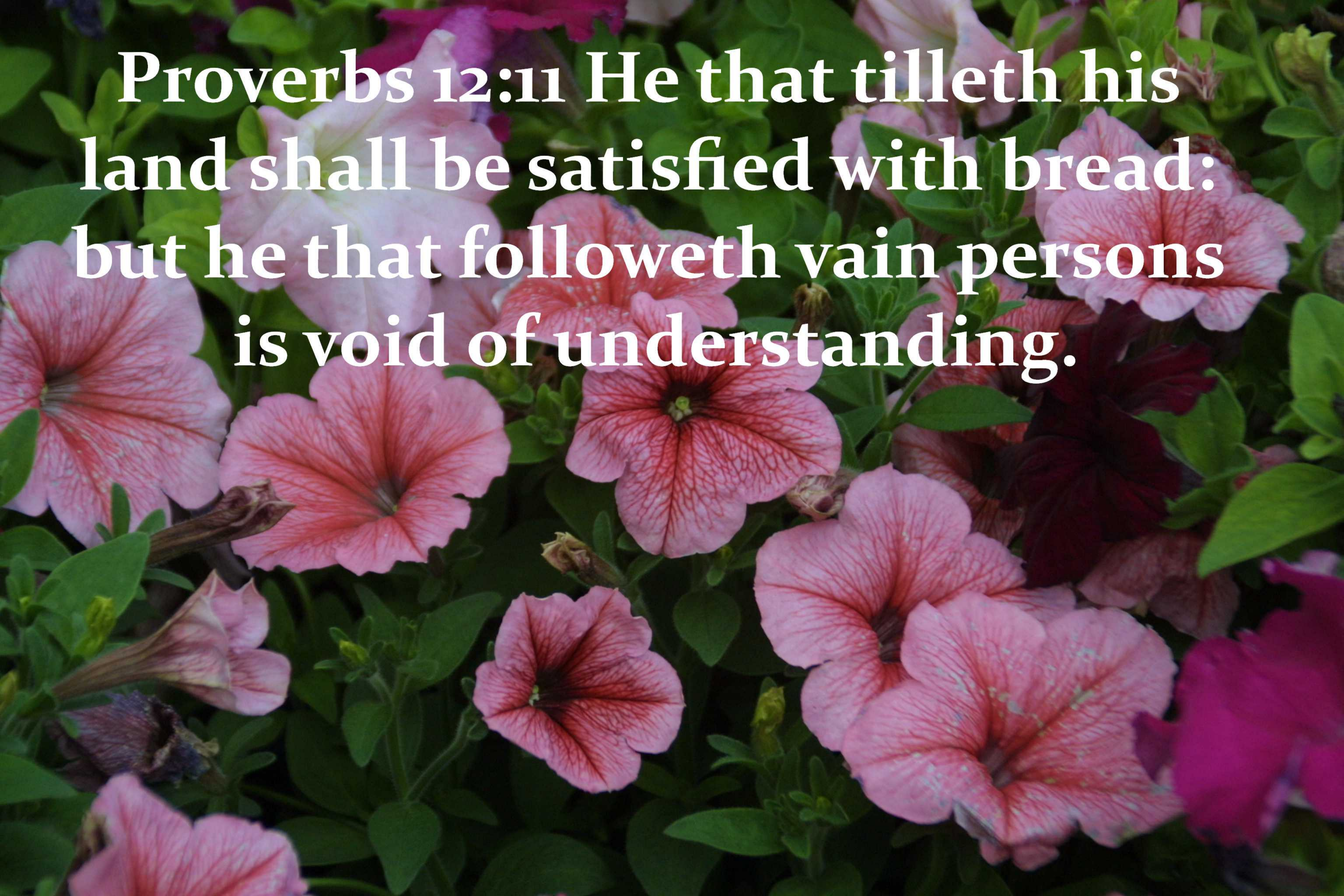
