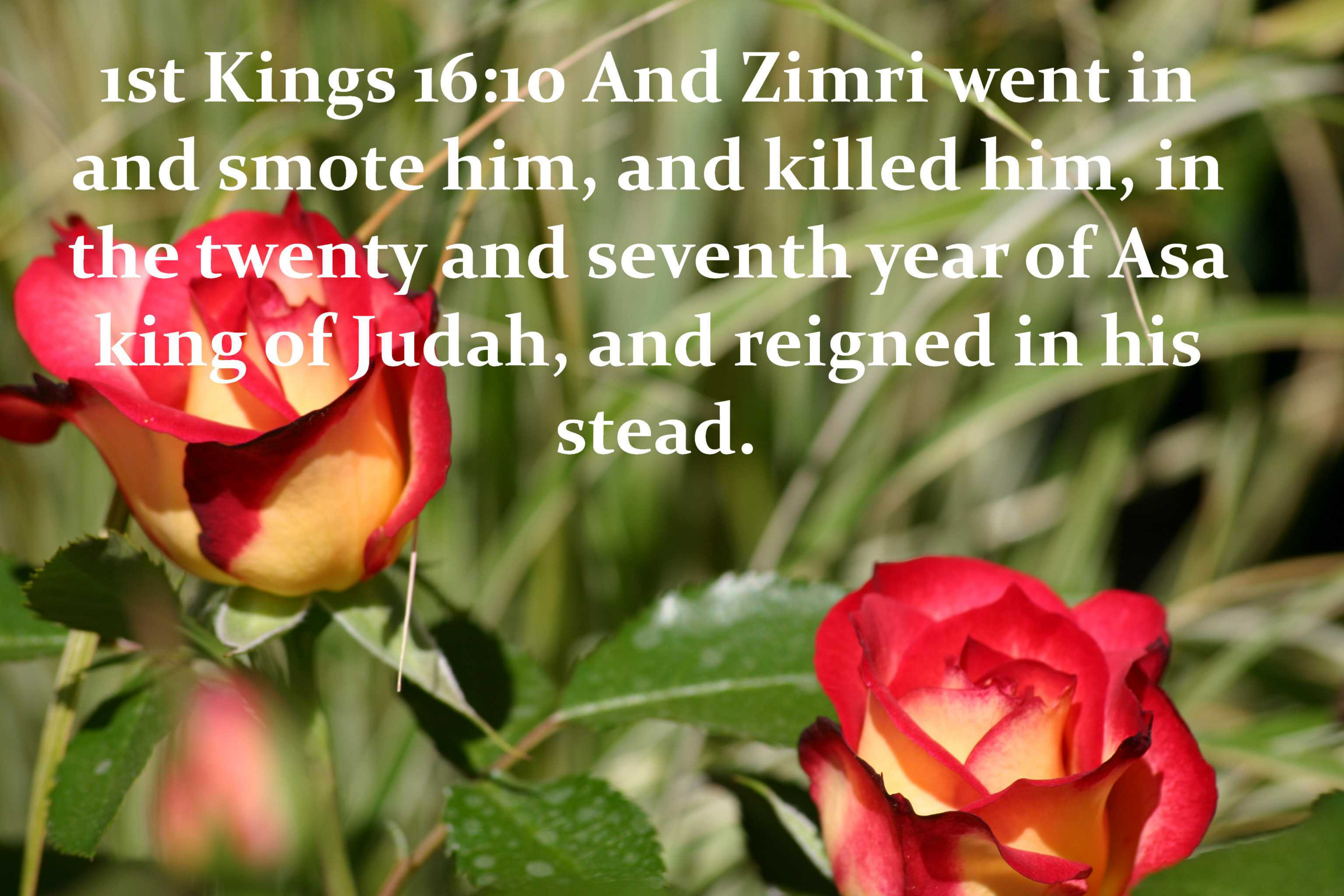

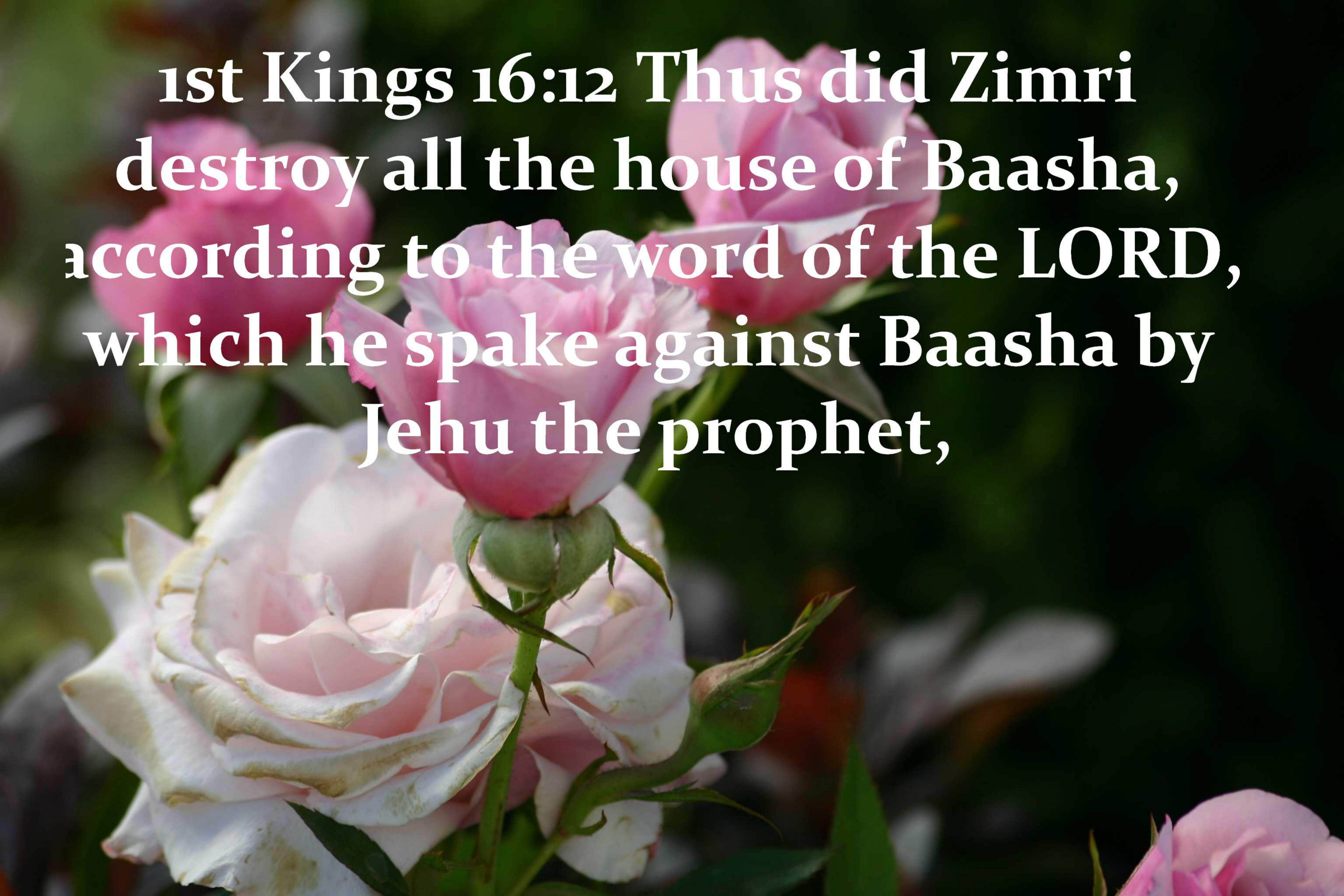
Numbers 25:14 Now the name of

house in Tirzah.

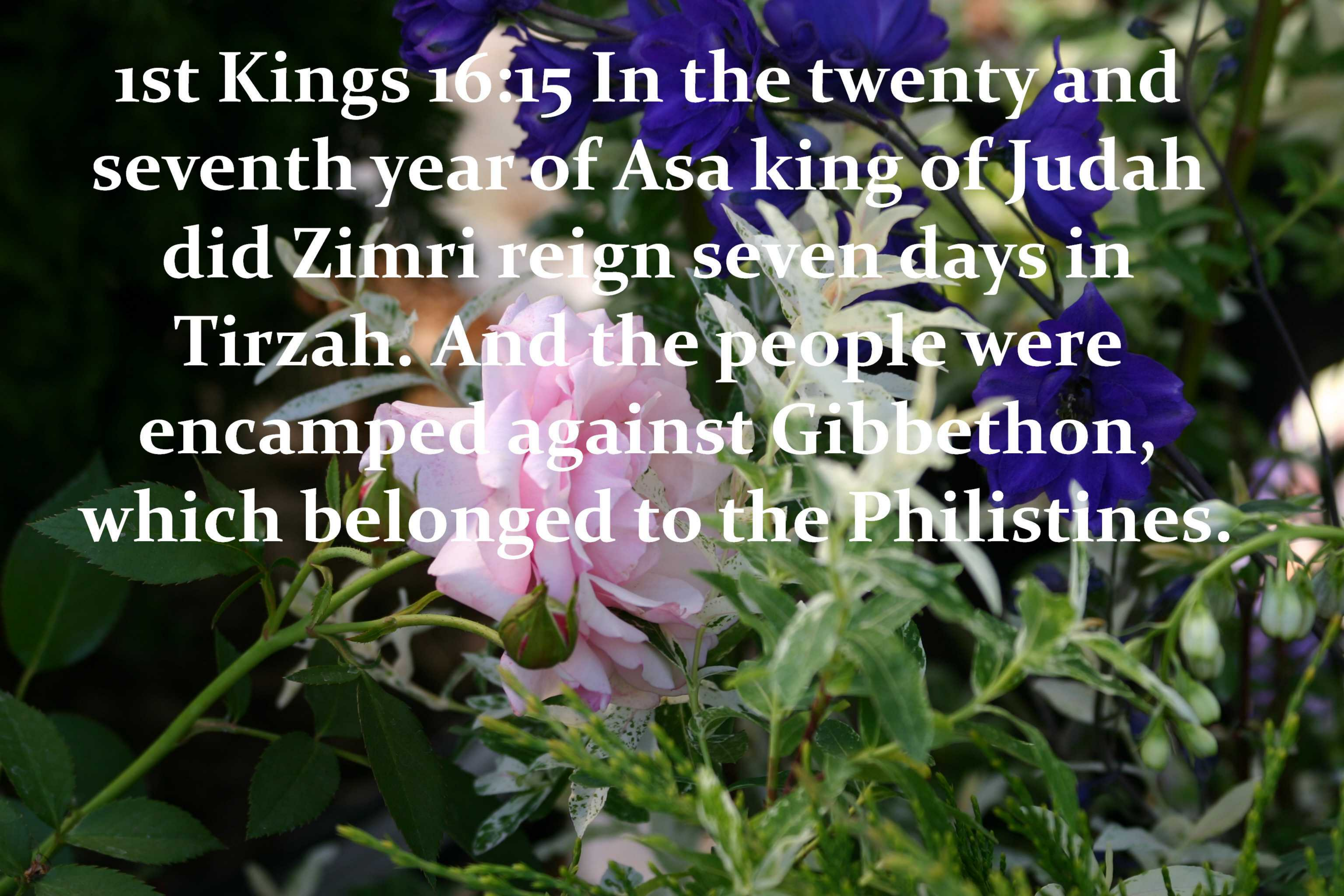

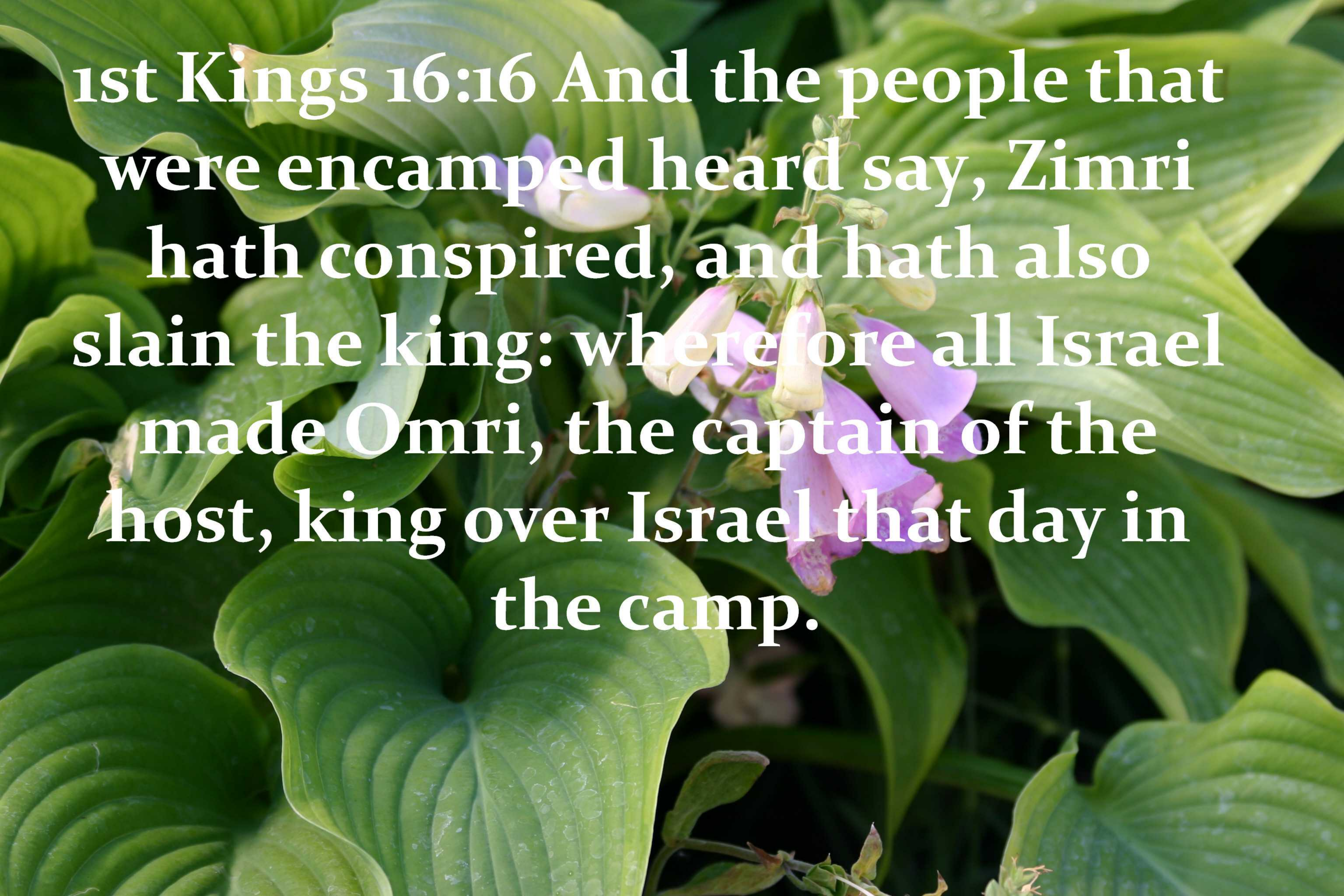
1st Kings 16:10 And Zimri went in

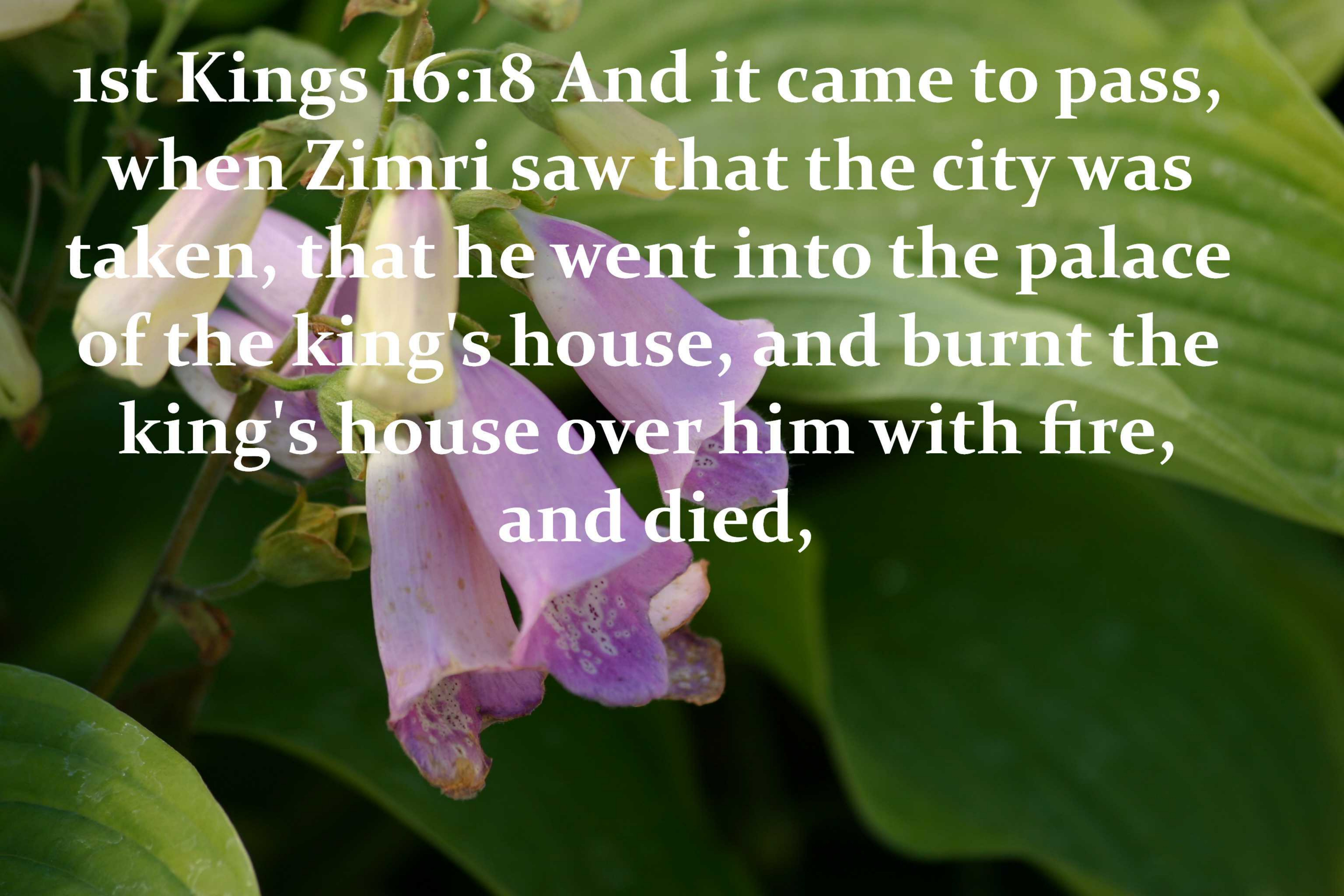
1st Kings 16:12 Thus did Zimri

Jehu the prophet,



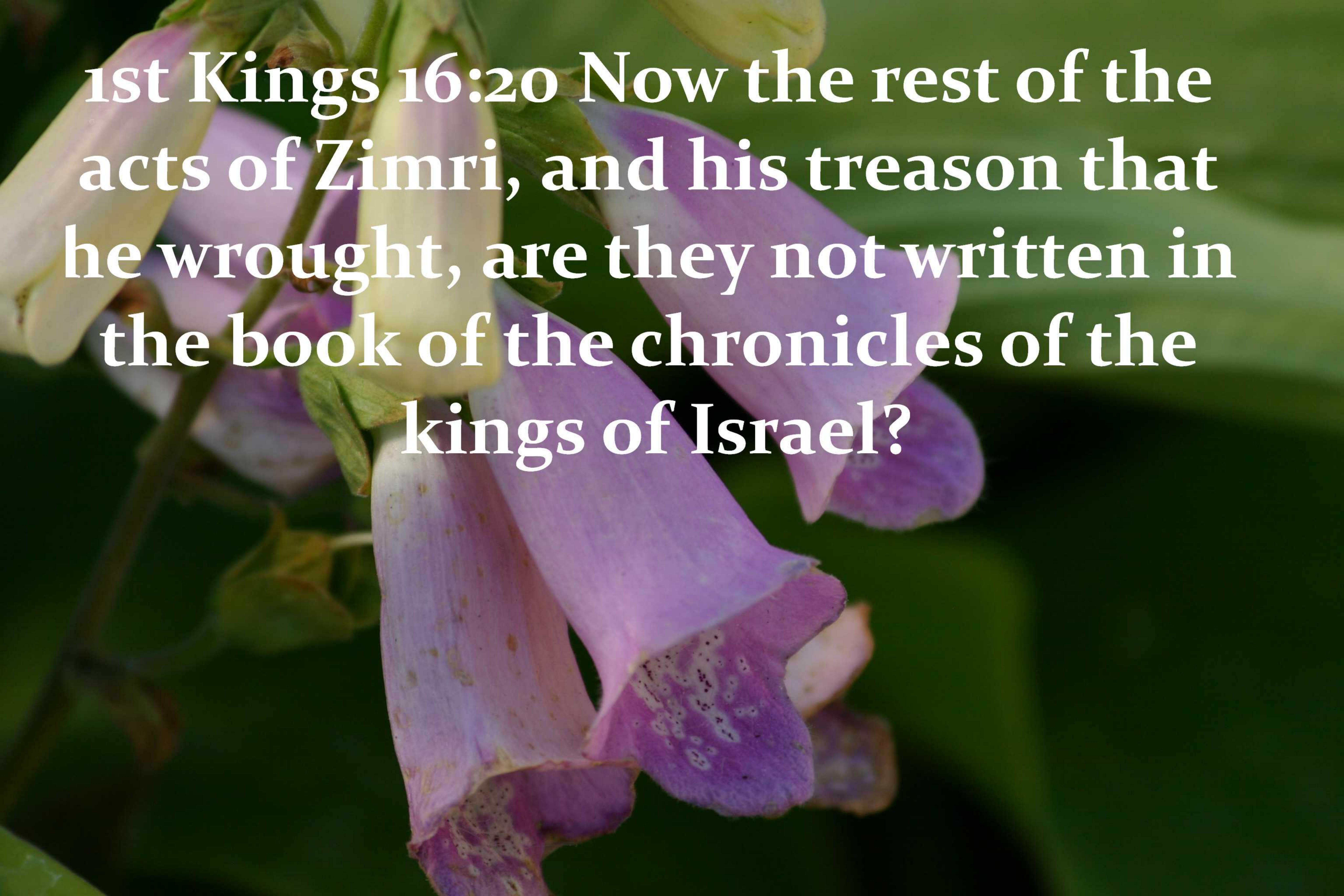

the camp.

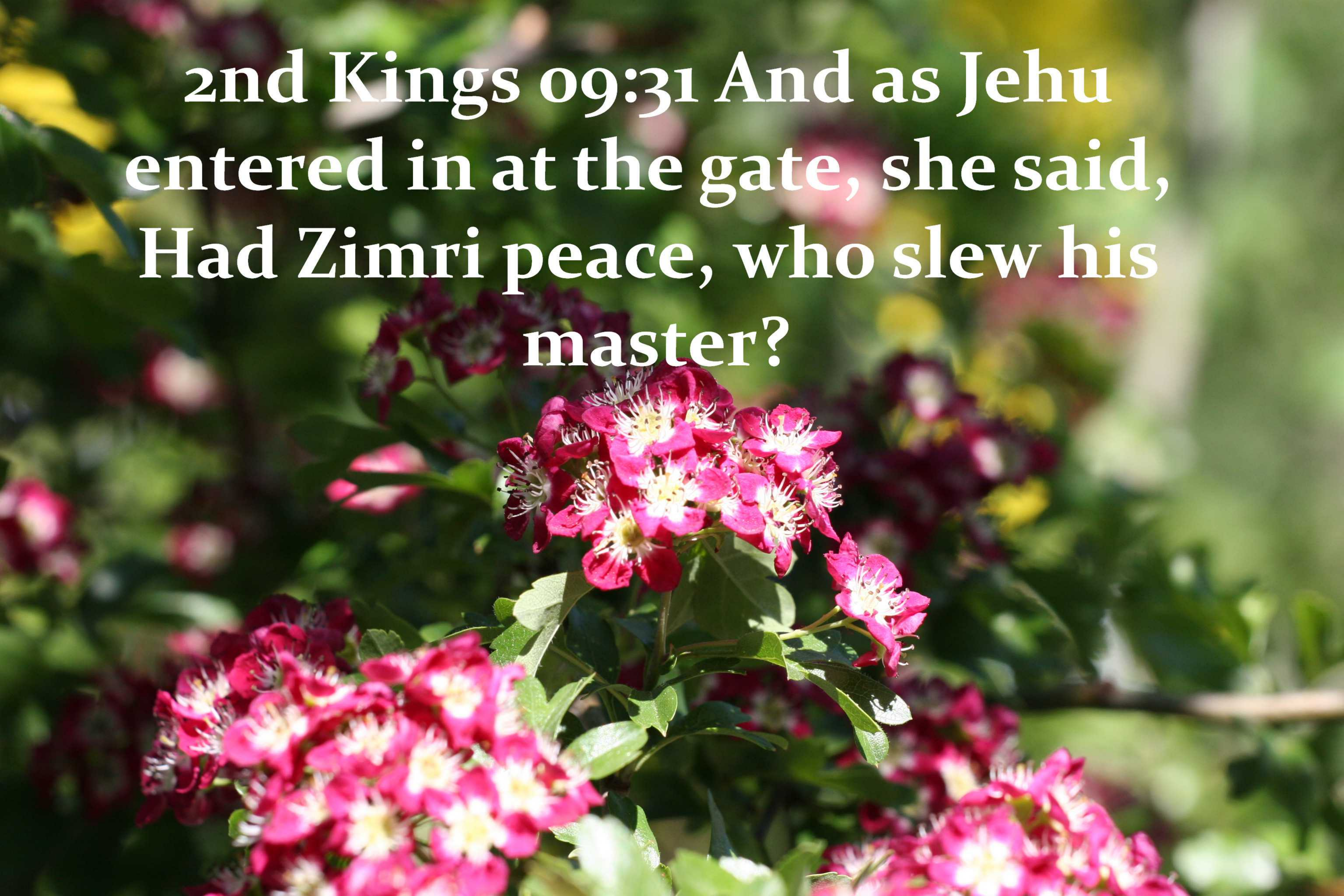
