

**Gen 14:05 And in the fourteenth year
came Chedorlaomer, and the kings
that [were] with him, and smote the
Rephaims in Ashteroth Karnaim, and
the Zuzims in Ham, and the Emims in
Shaveh Kiriathaim,**

**Exo 12:06 And ye shall keep it up until
the fourteenth day of the same month:
and the whole assembly of the

the evening.**


**Exo 12:18 In the first month , on the

**Lev 23:05 In the fourteenth day of the

passover.**

Num 09:03 In the fourteenth day of this month, at even, ye shall keep it in his appointed season: according to all the rites of it, and according to all the ceremonies thereof, shall ye keep it.

**Num 09:05 And they kept the passover
on the fourteenth day of the first
month at even in the wilderness of
Sinai: according to all that the LORD
commanded Moses, so did the
children of Israel.**

Num 09:11 The fourteenth day of the second month at even they shall keep it, [and] eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.

Jos 05:10 And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho.



fourteenth day of the month, ye shall
have the passover, a feast of seven
days; unleavened bread shall be eaten.**

Act 27:33 And while the day was coming on, Paul besought [them] all to take meat, saying, This day is the fourteenth day that ye have tarried and continued fasting, having taken nothing.
