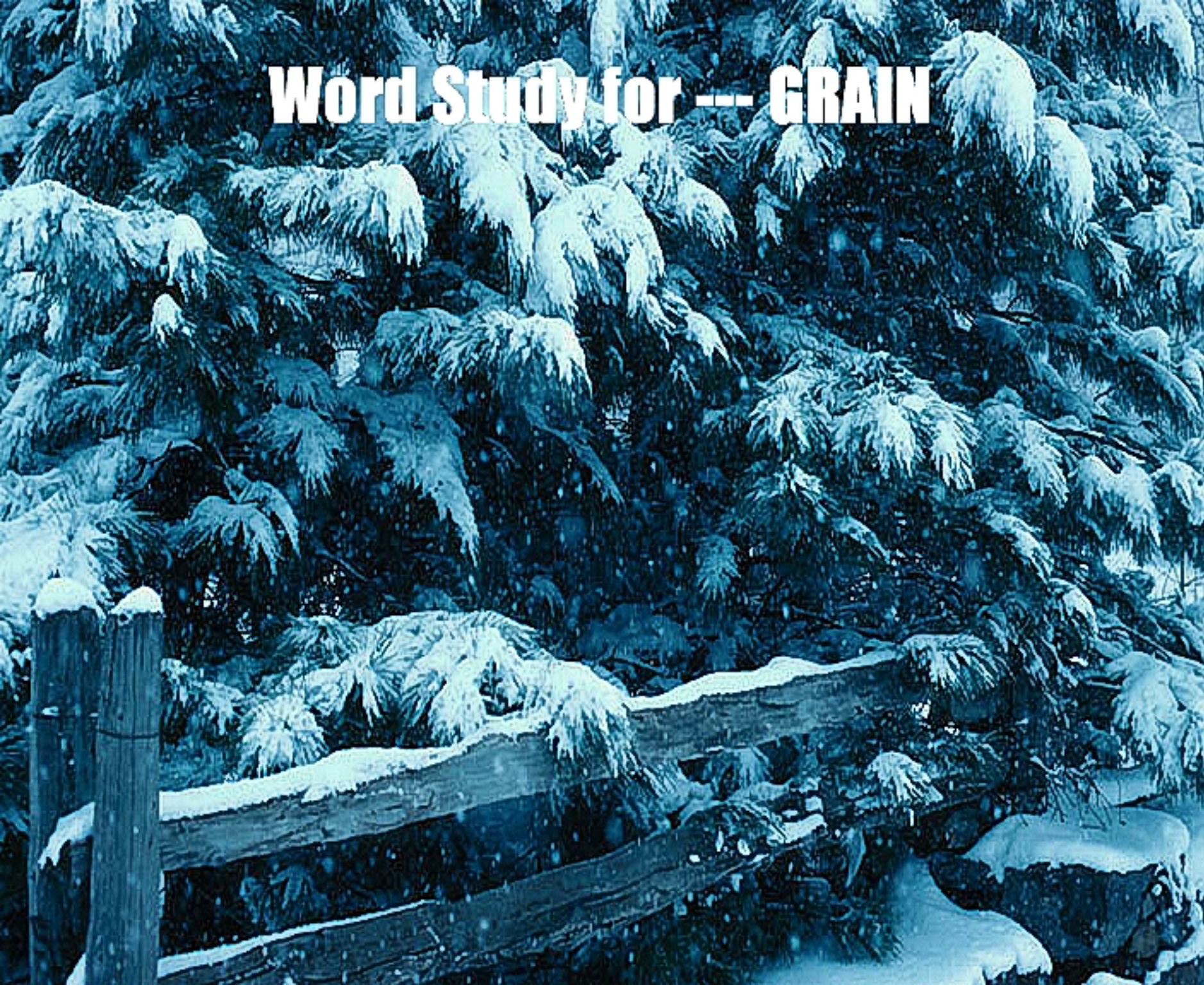


**Amo 09:09 For, lo, I will command, and
