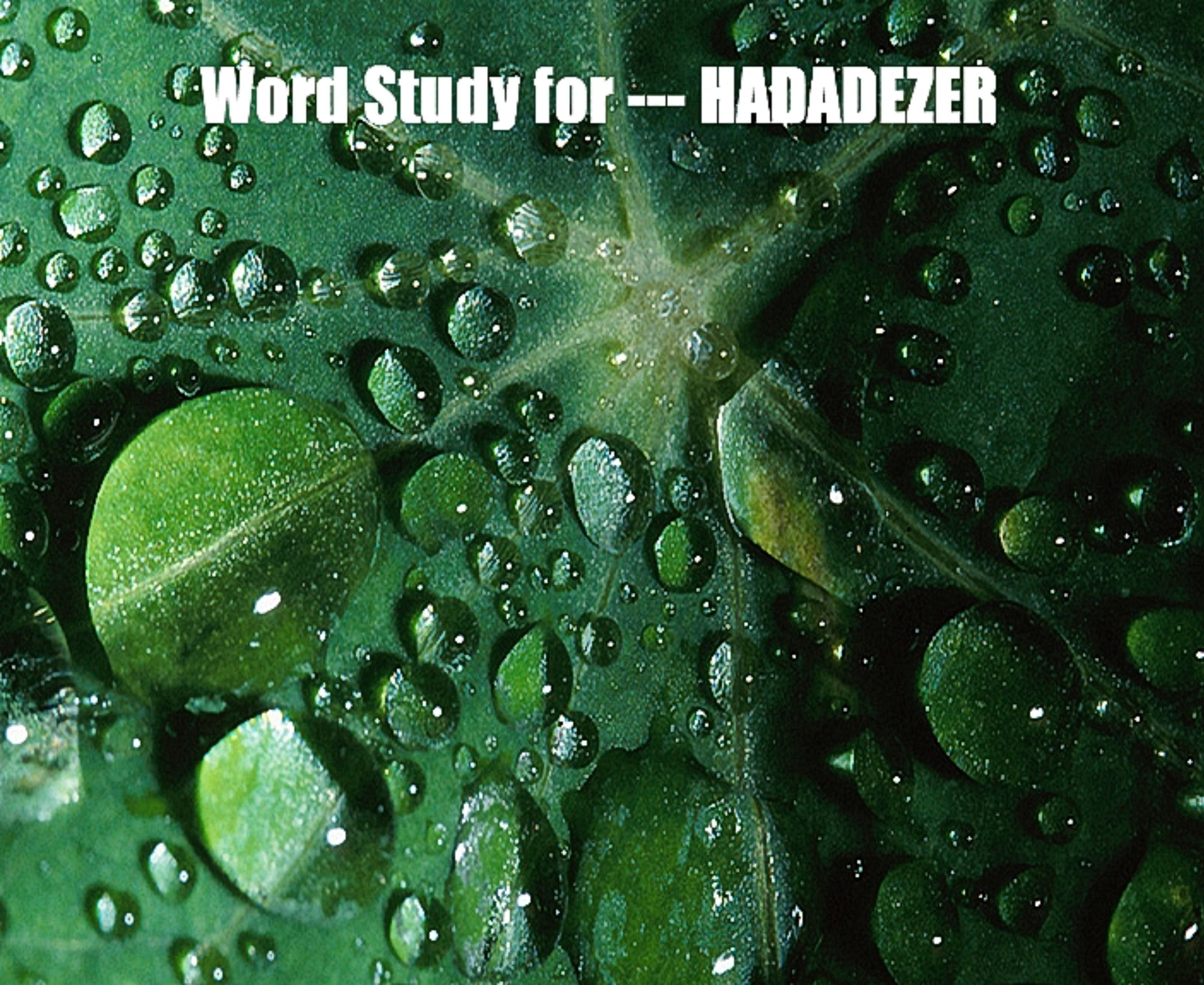



men.**






