

that] did Joshua burn.**

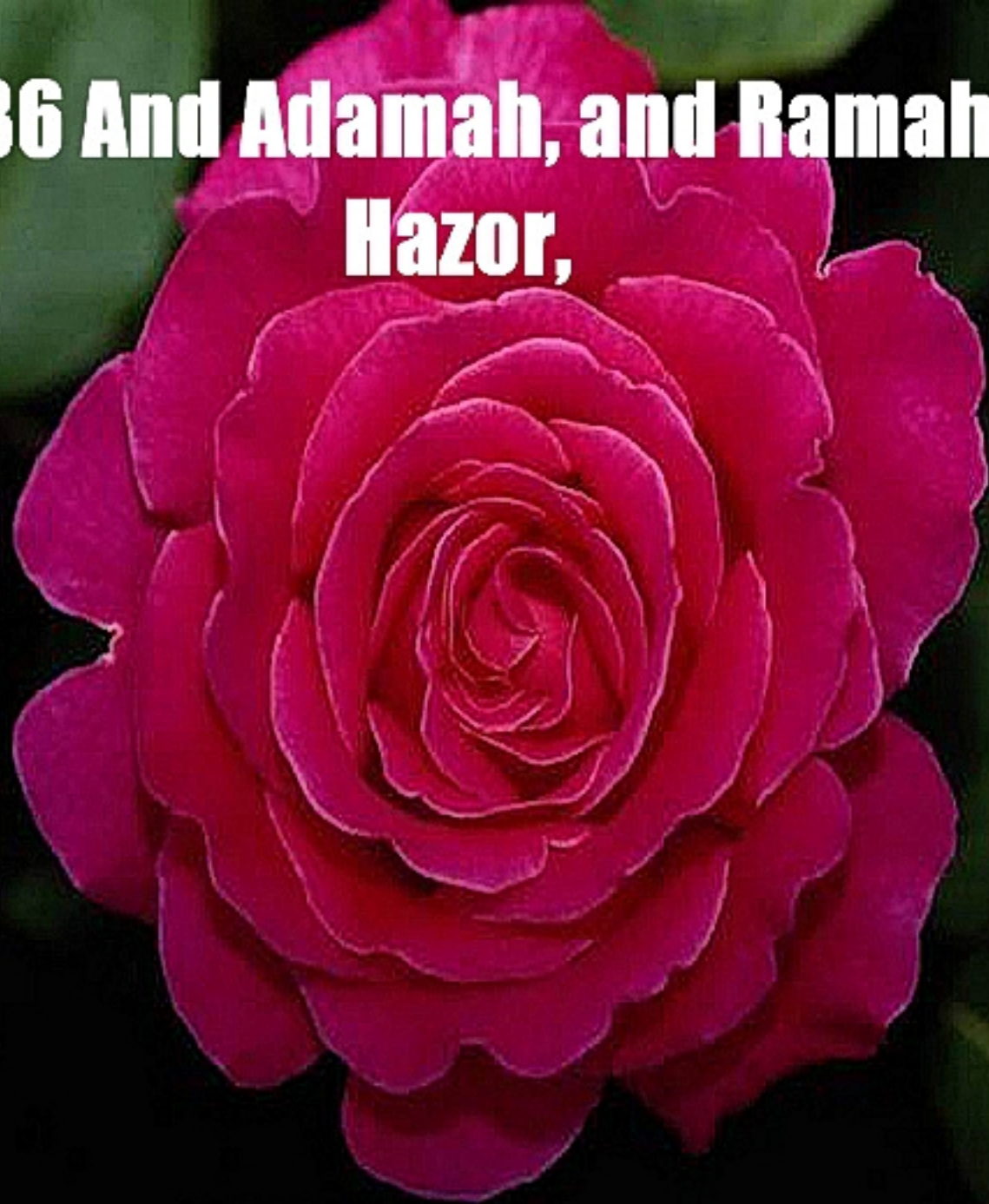


