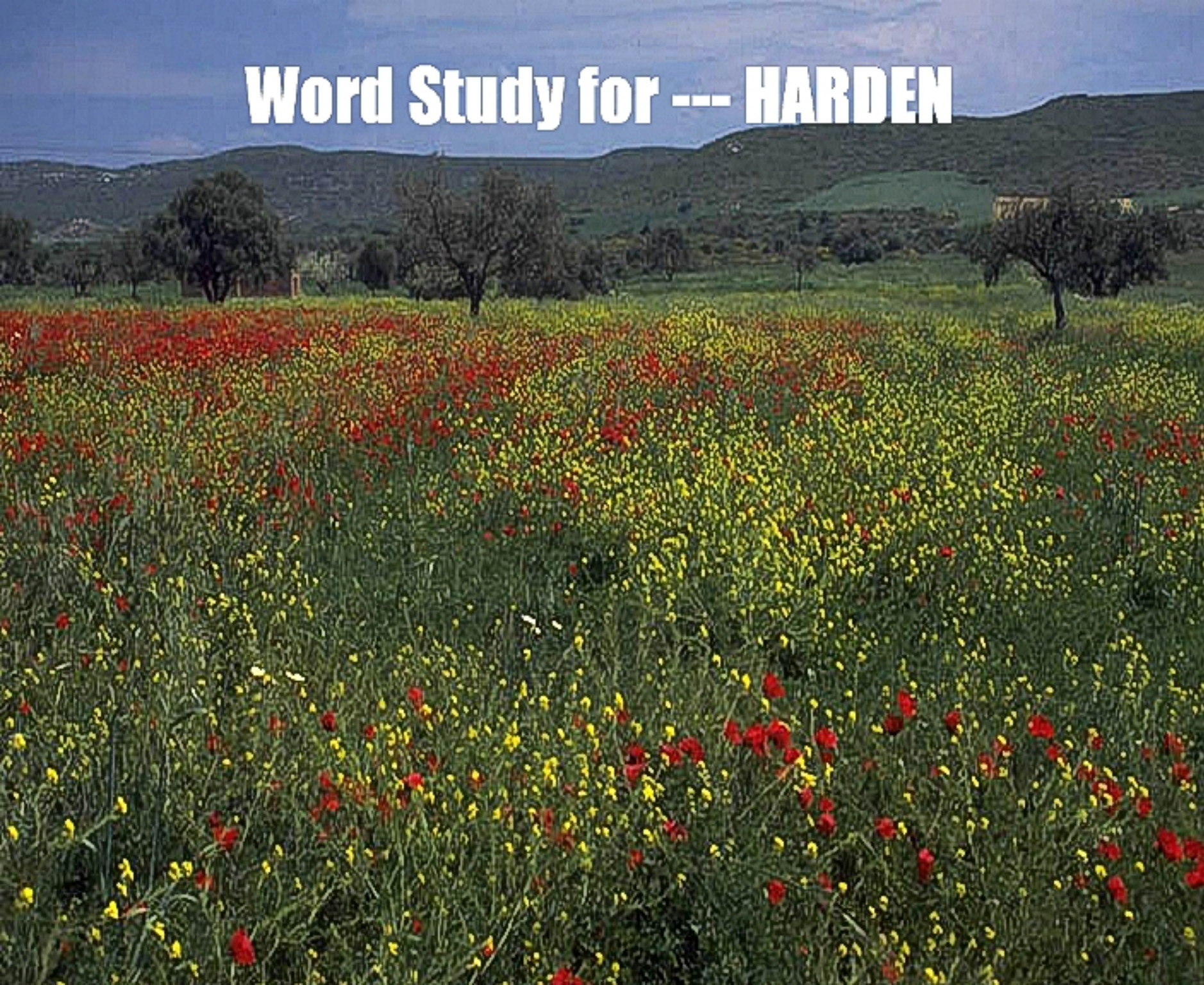





go.**






