


# Word Study for --- LABOURED




**Neh 04:21 So we laboured in the work:

the rising of the morning till the stars  
appeared.**




**Ecc 02:22 For what hath man of all his

**Ecc 05:16 And this also [is] a sore evil, [that] in all points as he came, so shall he go: and what profit hath he that hath laboured for the wind?**




**Isa 47:12 Stand now with thine

none shall save thee.**




**Isa 49:04 Then I said, I have laboured



their labours.**




**Rom 16:12 Salute Tryphena and
