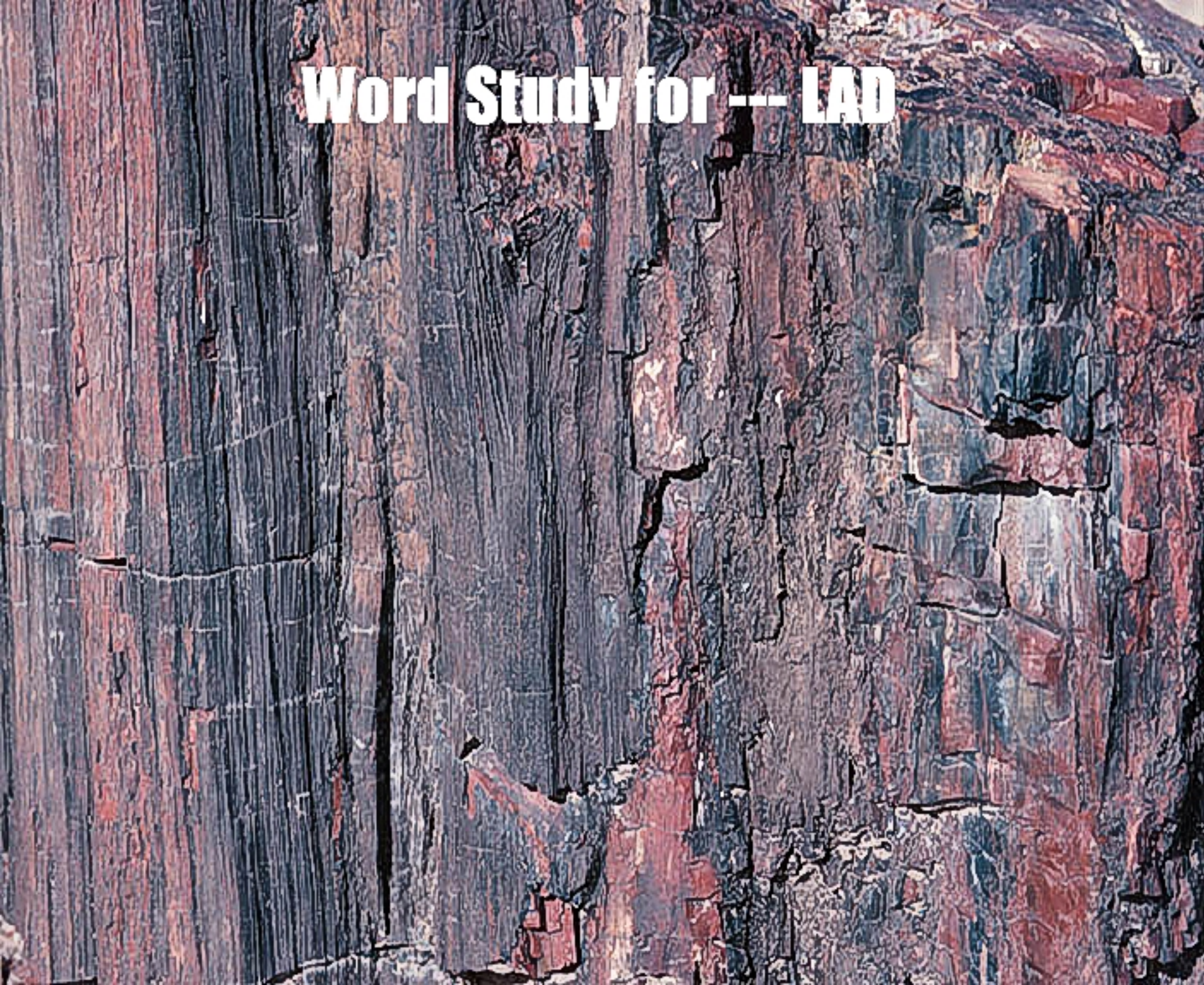

in Isaac shall thy seed be called.**



Gen 21:19 And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the lad drink.




**Gen 21:20 And God was with the lad; and

and became an archer.**




Gen 22:05 And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you.





up in the lad's life;**




**Gen 44:31 It shall come to pass, when

grave.**




**Gen 44:32 For thy servant became

upon them.**





and came to his master.**


**1Sa 20:39 But the lad knew not any
