

**Lev 21:18 For whatsoever man [he be]
that hath a blemish, he shall not
approach: a blind man, or a lame, or he
that hath a flat nose, or any thing
superfluous,**





the house.**



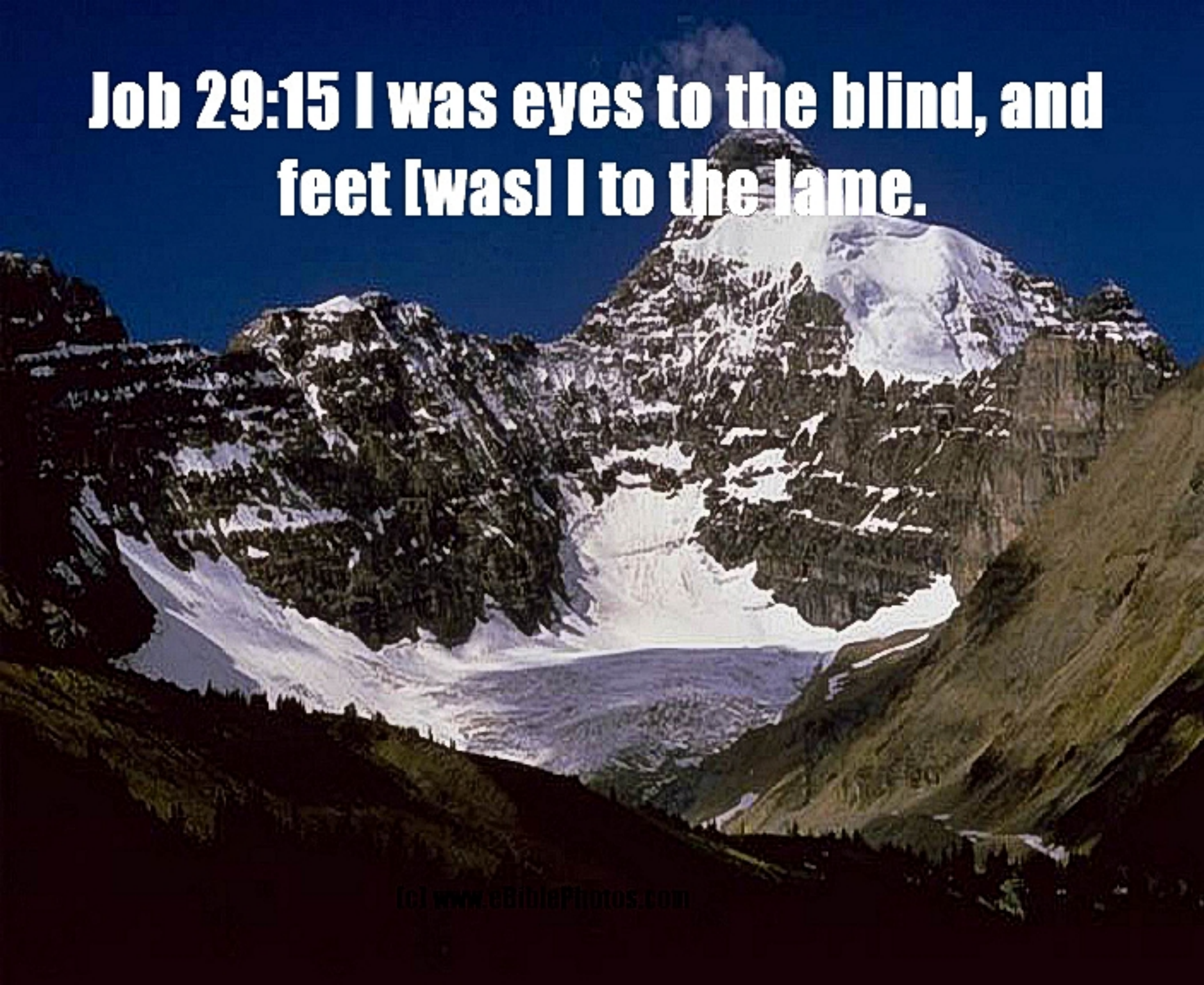

both his feet.**




**Job 29:15 I was eyes to the blind, and
feet [was] I to the lame.**




Pro 26:07 The legs of the lame are not equal: so [is] a parable in the mouth of fools.

divided; the lame take the prey.**




**Isa 35:06 Then shall the lame man leap

break out, and streams in the desert.**







gospel preached to them.**


