**Lev 21:18 For whatsoever man [he be]
that hath a blemish, he shall not
approach: a blind man, or a lame, or he
that hath a flat nose, or any thing
superfluous,**

**Deu 15:21 And if there be [any] blemish
therein, [as if it be] lame, or blind, [or
havel any ill blemish, thou shalt not
sacrifice it unto the LORD thy God.**

**2Sa 04:04 And Jonathan, Saul's son, had
a son that was lame of his feet. He was
five years old when the tidings came of
Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and
his nurse took him up, and fled: and it

cannot come in hither.**


**2Sa 05:08 And David said on that day,

lame on [his] feet.**


**2Sa 09:13 So Mephibosheth dwelt in
