



year.**


**Isa 03:26 And her gates shall lament

languish.**




**Isa 32:12 They shall lament for the


Jer 04:08 For this gird you with sackcloth, lament and howl: for the fierce anger of the LORD is not turned back from us.






**Jer 34:05 [But] thou shalt die in peace:
