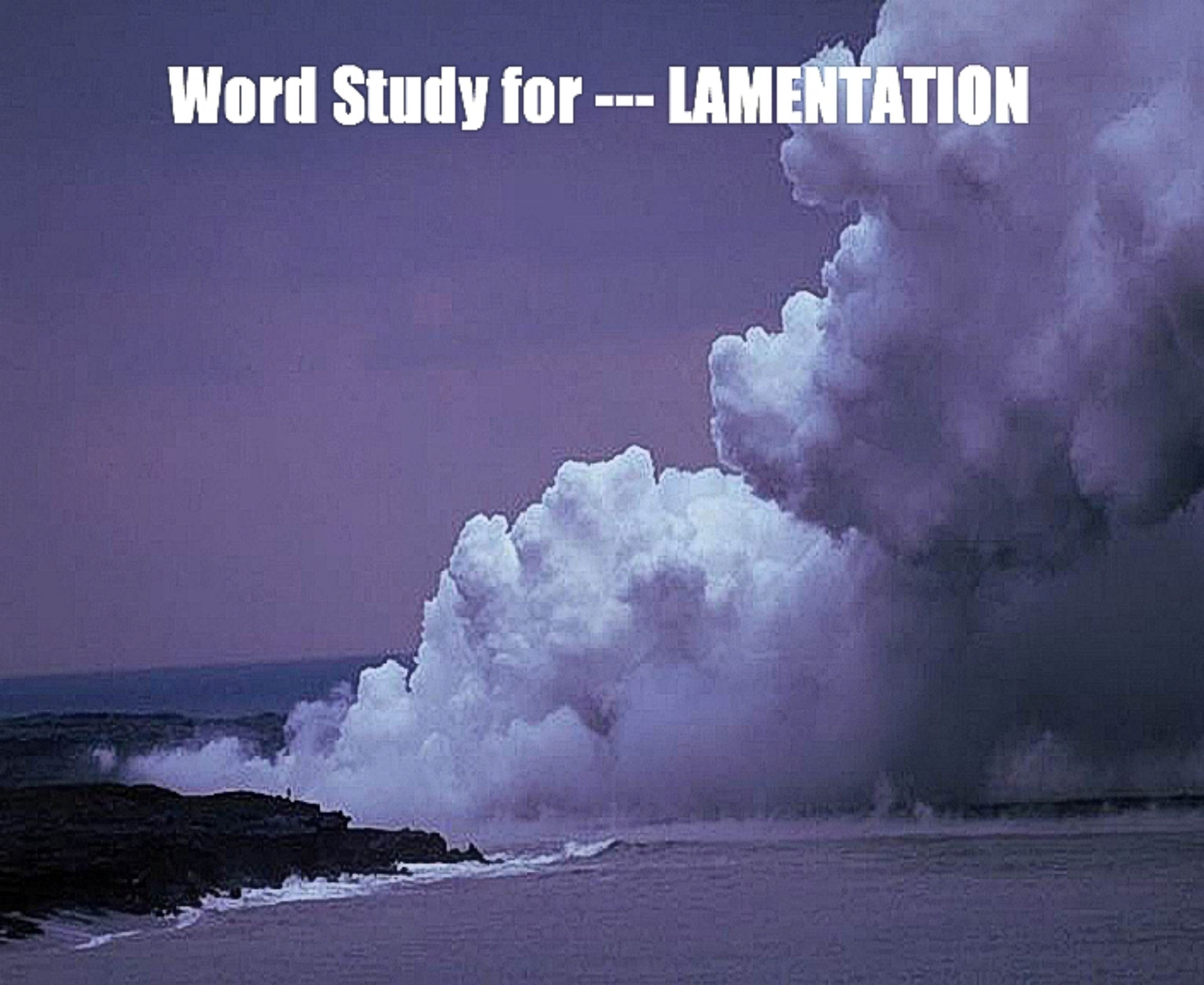



suddenly come upon us.**


**Jer 07:29 Cut off thine hair, (O



lamentation for the princes of Israel,**




**Eze 19:14 And fire is gone out of a rod




