

Gen 17:17 Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall [a child] be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

**Gen 18:12 Therefore Sarah laughed
within herself, saying, After I am waxed
old shall I have pleasure, my lord being
