



Word Study for --- LEPEL

Lev 13:45 And the leper in whom the plague [is], his clothes shall be rent, and his head bare, and he shall put a cote [ing] upon his upper lip, and shall cry, Unclean, unclean.

Lev 14:02 This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought unto the priest:

**Lev 14:03 And the priest shall go forth
out of the camp; and the priest shall
look, and, behold, if the plague of
leprosy be healed in the leper;**



**Lev 22:04 What man soever of the seed
of Aaron [is] a leper, or hath a running
issue; he shall not eat of the holy
things, until he be clean. And whose
toucheth any thing [that is] unclean [
by] the dead, or a man whose seed
goeth from him;**

Num 05:02 Command the children of Israel, that they put out of the camp every leper, and everyone that hath an issue, and whosoever is defiled by the dead:

**2Sa 03:29 Let it rest on the head of
Joab, and on all his father's house; and
let there not fail from the house of
Joab one that hath an issue, or that is
a leper, or that leaneth on a staff, or
that falleth on the sword, or that
lacketh bread.**

2KI 05:01 Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, but he was a leper.


2Ki 05:11 But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the LORD his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper.

**2Ki 05:27 The leprosy therefore of
Naaman shall cleave unto thee, and
unto thy seed for ever. And he went out
from his presence a leper [as white]
as snow.**

**2Ki 15:05 And the LORD smote the king,
so that he was a leper unto the day of
his death, and dwelt in a several
house. And Jotham the king's son [was]
over the house, judging the people of
the land.**

2Ch 26:21 And Uzziah the king was a leper unto the day of his death; and dwelt in a several house, I being a leper; for he was cut off from the house of the LORD: and Jotham his son I was over the king's house, judging the people of the land.

2Ch 26:23 So Uzziah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the field of the burial which [belonged] to the kings; for they said, He [is] a leper: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.



Mat 08:02 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

**Mat 26:06 Now when Jesus was in
Bethany, in the house of Simon the
leper,**

Mar 01:40 And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

Mar 14:03 And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured [it] on his head.
