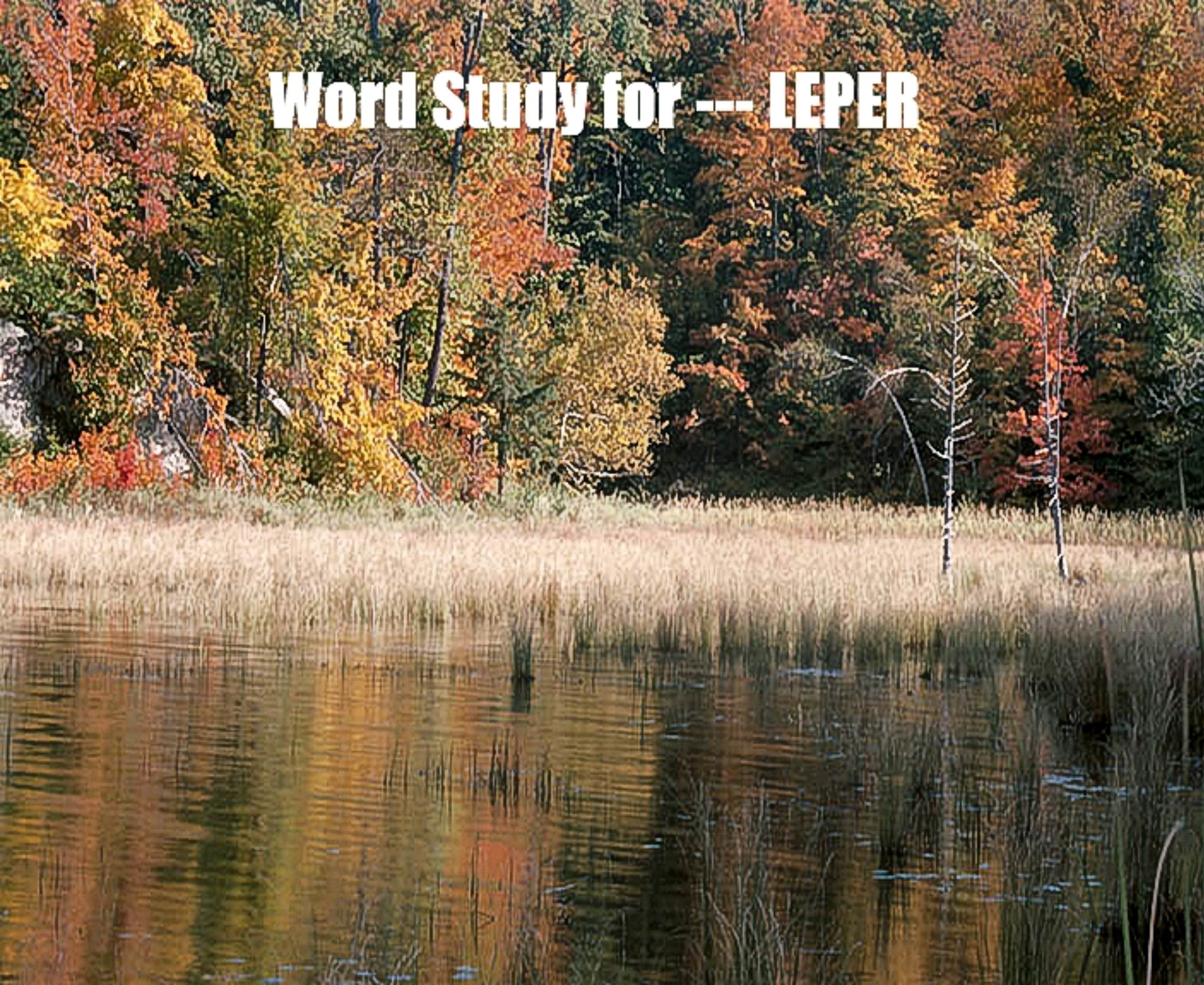









**Lev 14:02 This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought unto the priest:**




**Lev 14:03 And the priest shall go forth

leprosy be healed in the leper;**






