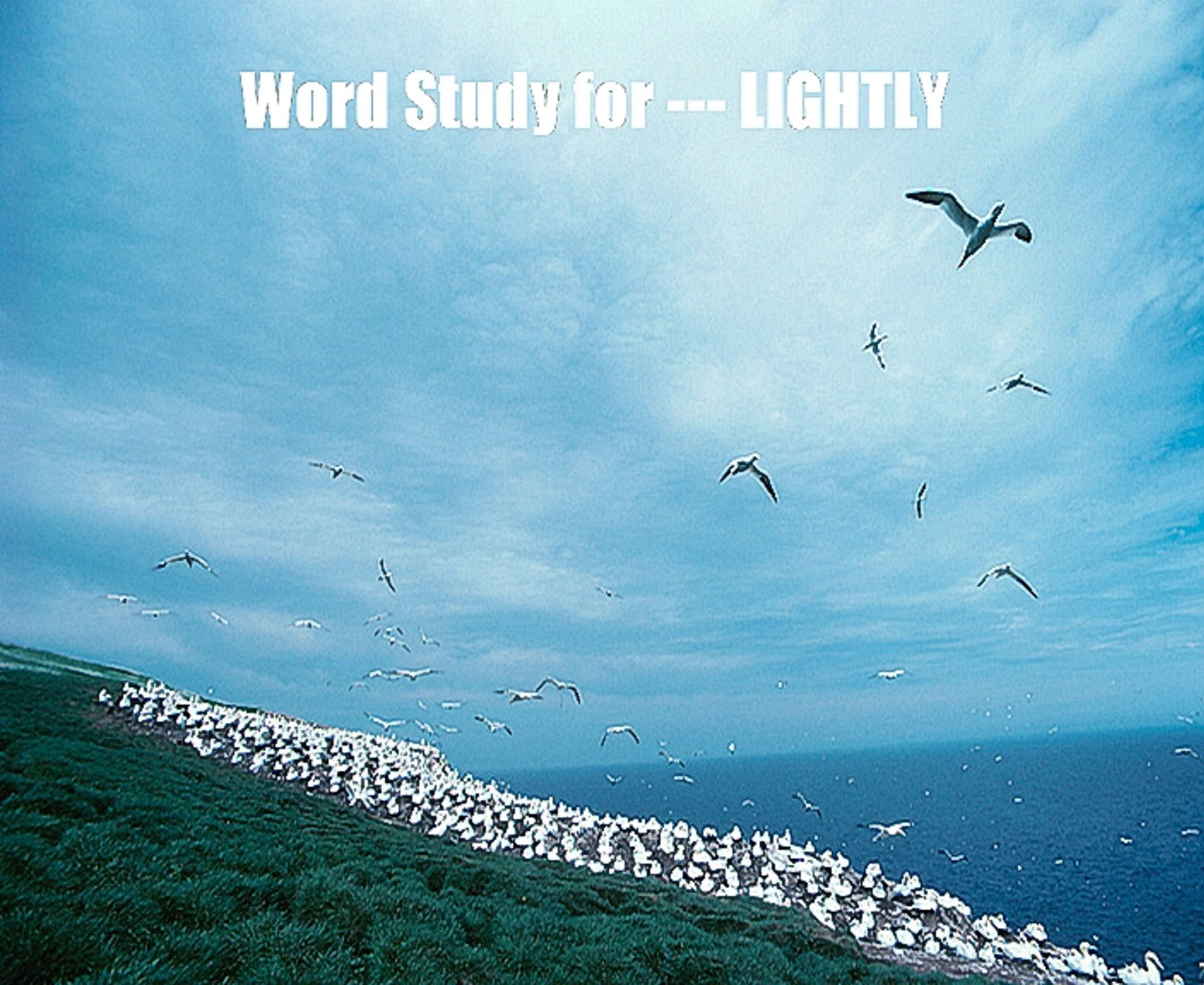





Rock of his salvation.**




