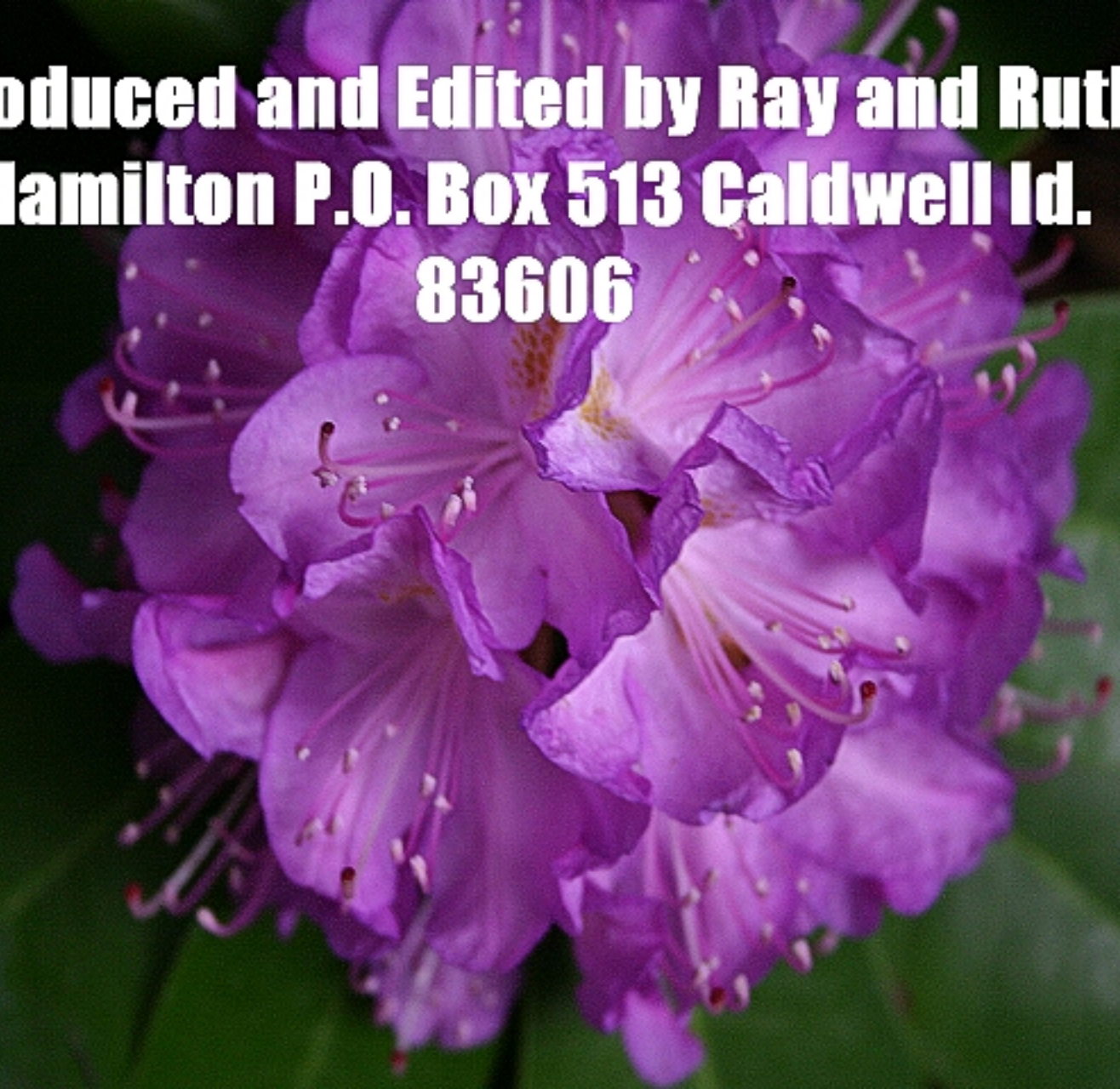

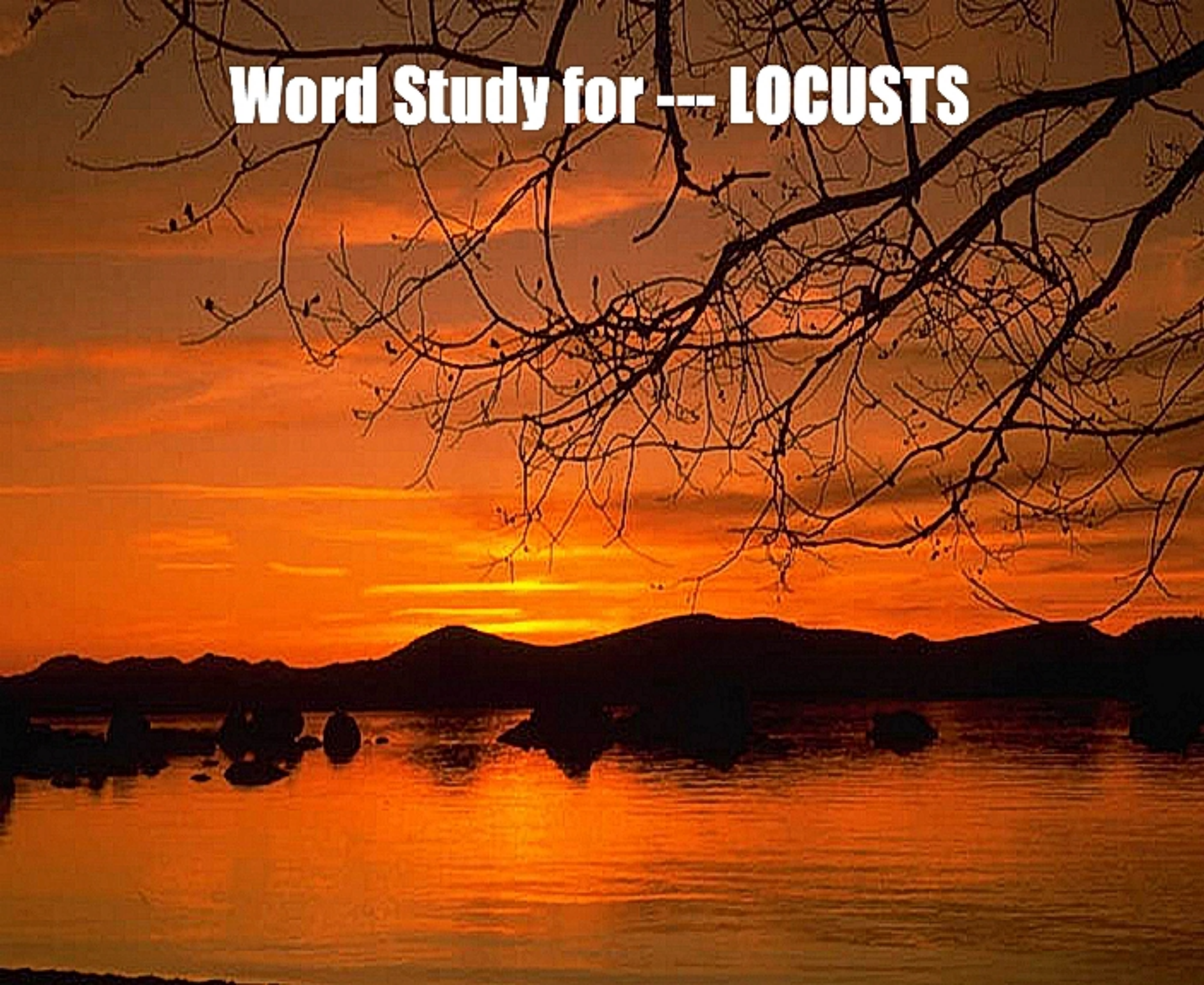

bring the locusts into thy coast:**




Exo 10:12 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the land of Egypt for the locusts, that they may come up upon the land of Egypt, and eat every herb of the land, leavened all that the hail hath left.

Exo 10:13 And Moses stretched forth his rod over the land of Egypt, and the LORD brought an east wind upon the land all that day, and all that night; and when it was morning, the east wind brought the locusts.

**Exo 10:14 And the locusts went up over
all the land of Egypt, and rested in all
the coasts of Egypt: very grievous were

Exo 10:19 And the LORD turned a mighty strong west wind, which took away the locusts, and cast them into the Red sea; there remained not one locust in all the coasts of Egypt.


**2Ch 07:13 If I shut up heaven that there

go they forth all of them by bands;**




Isa 33:04 And your spoil shall be gathered (like) the gathering of the caterpillar; as the running to and fro of locusts shall he run upon them.






Mat 03:04 And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.
