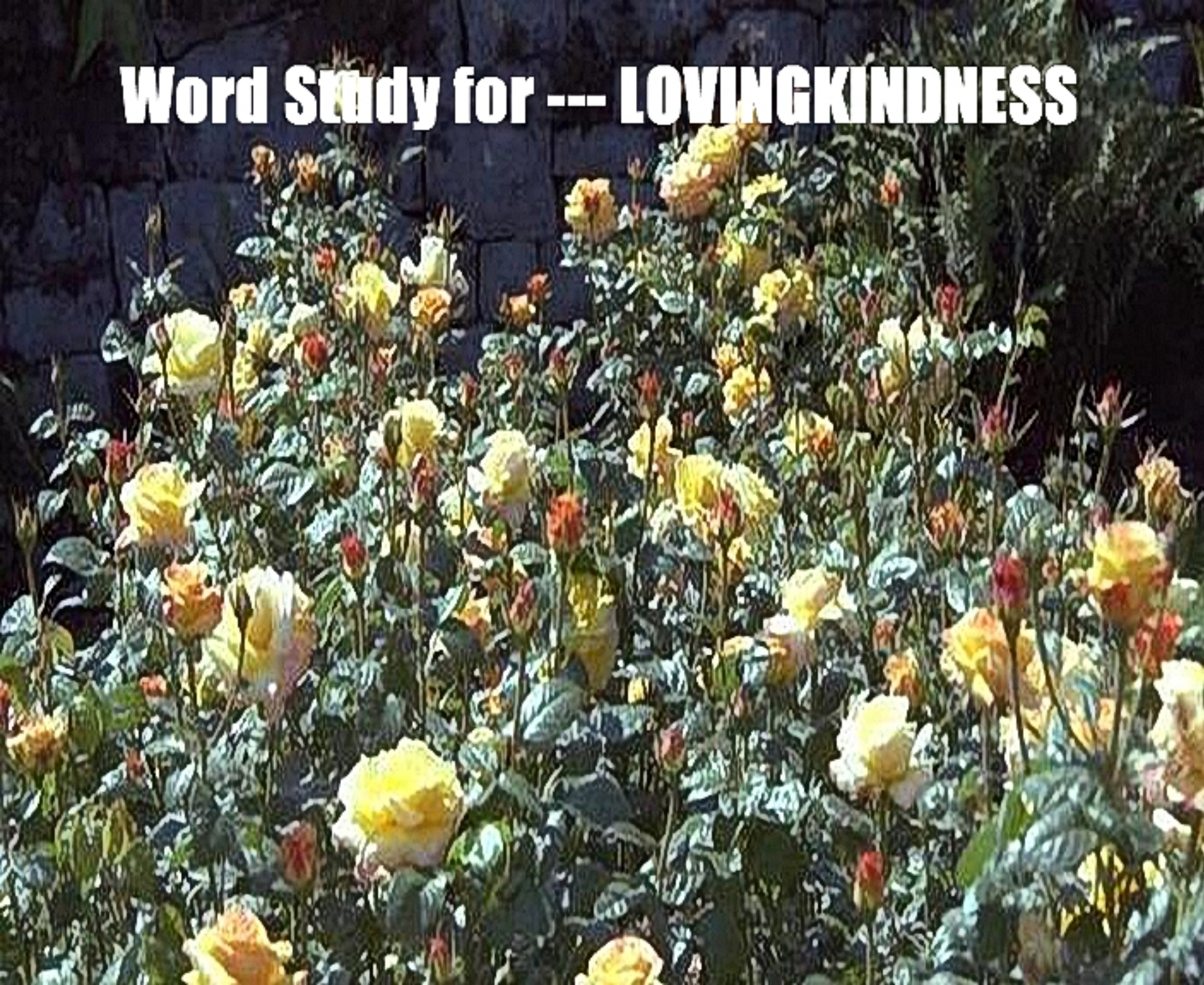

in thy truth.**




**Psa 36:07 How excellent is thy
