









**Gen 06:16 A window shalt thou make to
the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish
it above; and the door of the ark shalt
thou set in the side thereof; [with]
lower, second, and third [stories] shalt
thou make it.**




Lev 13:20 And if, when the priest seeth it, behold, it be in sight lower than the skin, and the hair thereof be turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it is a plague of leprosy broken out of the boil.

Lev 13:21 But if the priest look on it, and, behold, if there be no white hairs therein, and if it be not lower than the skin, but be somewhat dark; then the priest shall shut him up seven days:

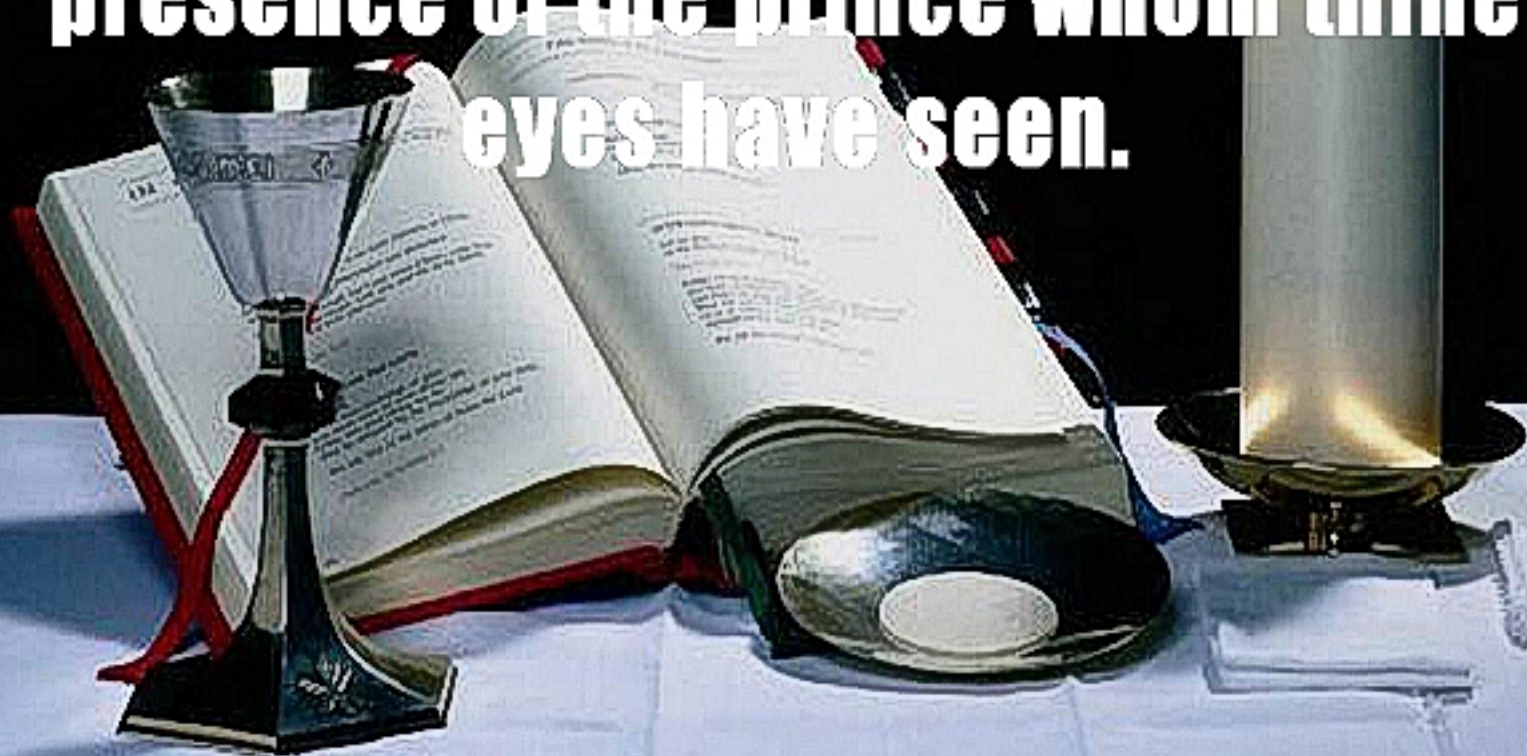
Neh 04:13 Therefore set I in the lower places behind the wall, [and] on the higher places, I even set the people after their families with their swords, their spears, and their bows.




