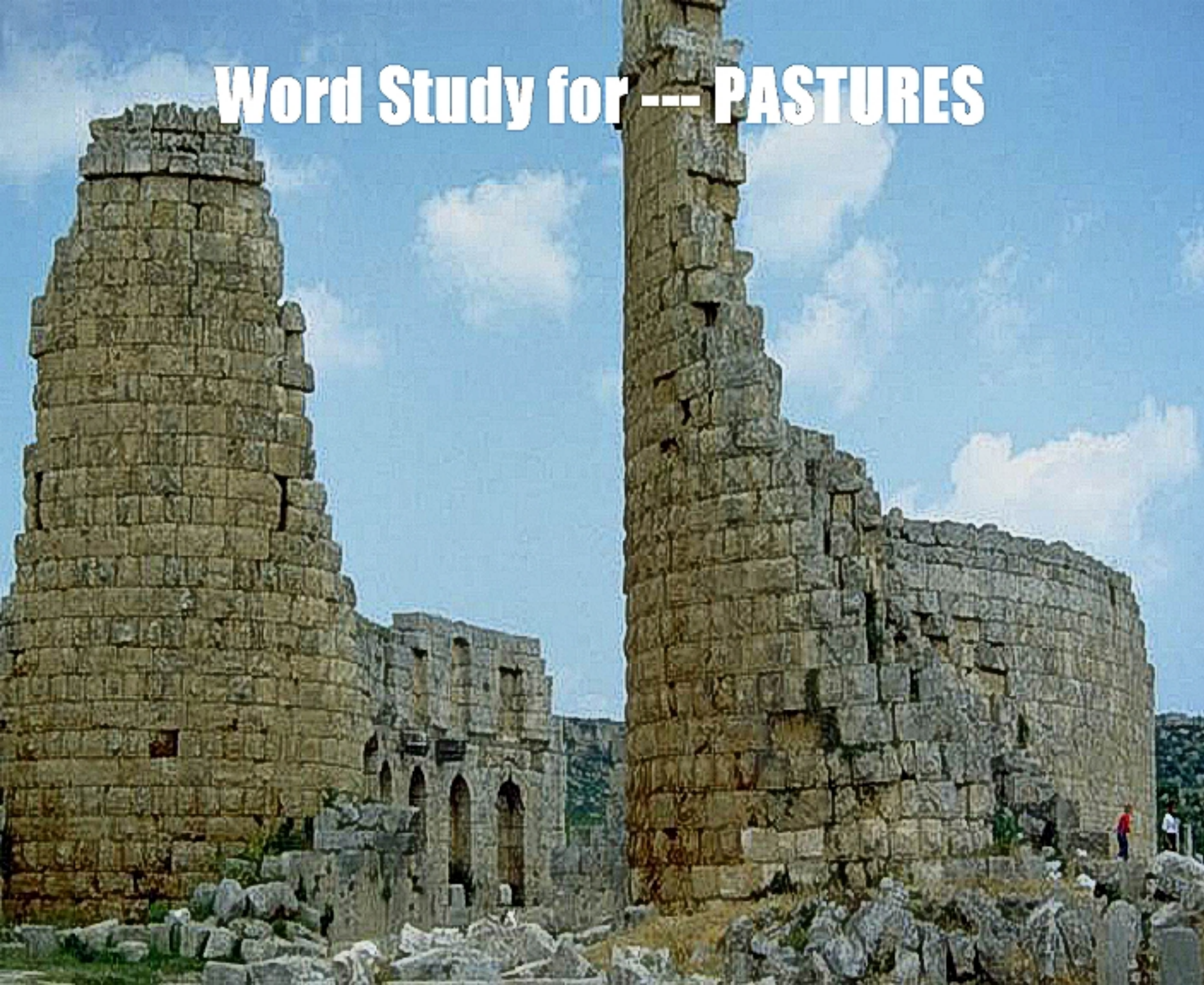

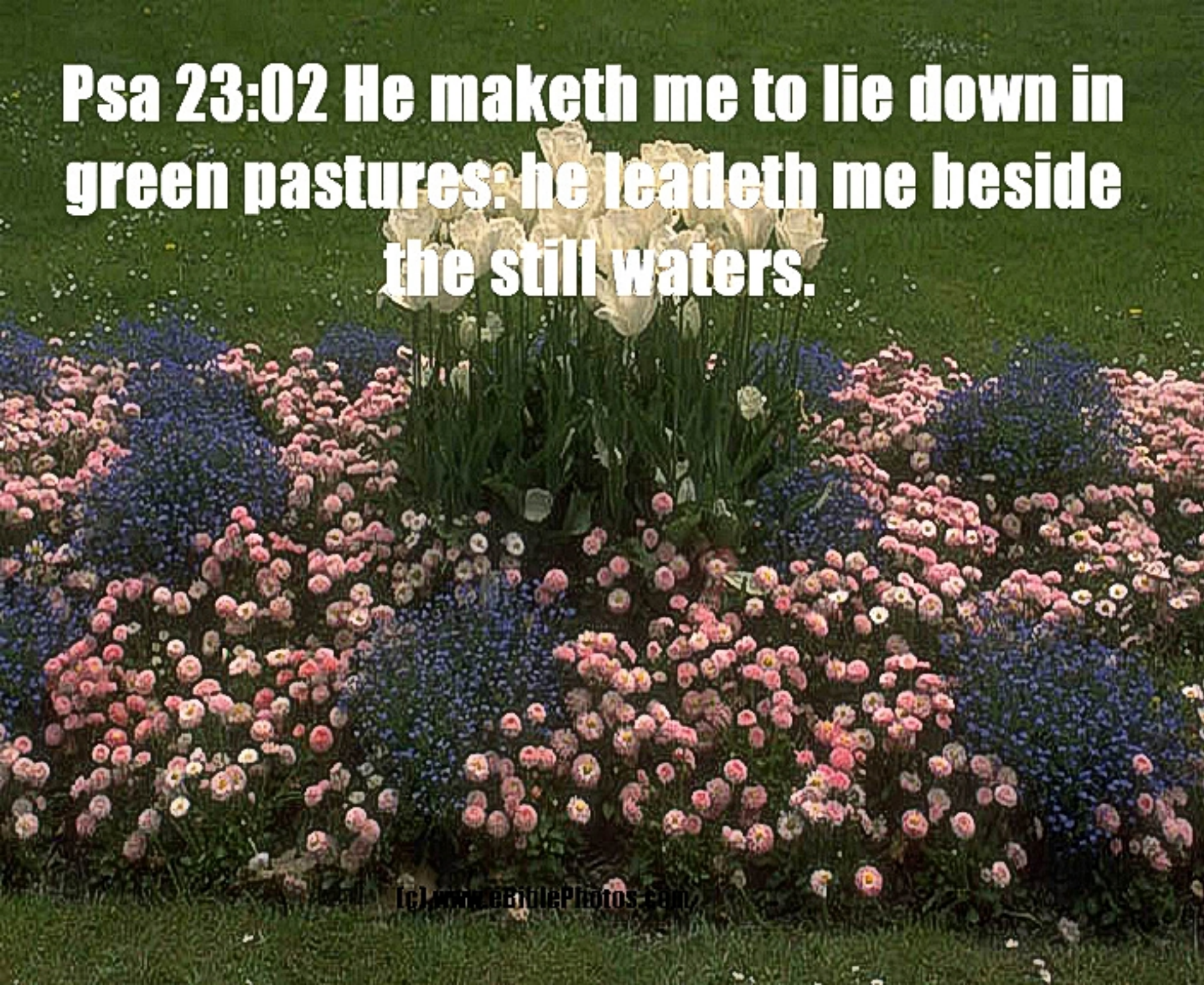

fallowdeer, and fatted fowl.**


**Psa 23:02 He maketh me to lie down in

the still waters.**




**Psa 65:12 They drop luponl the




