asked of him.**



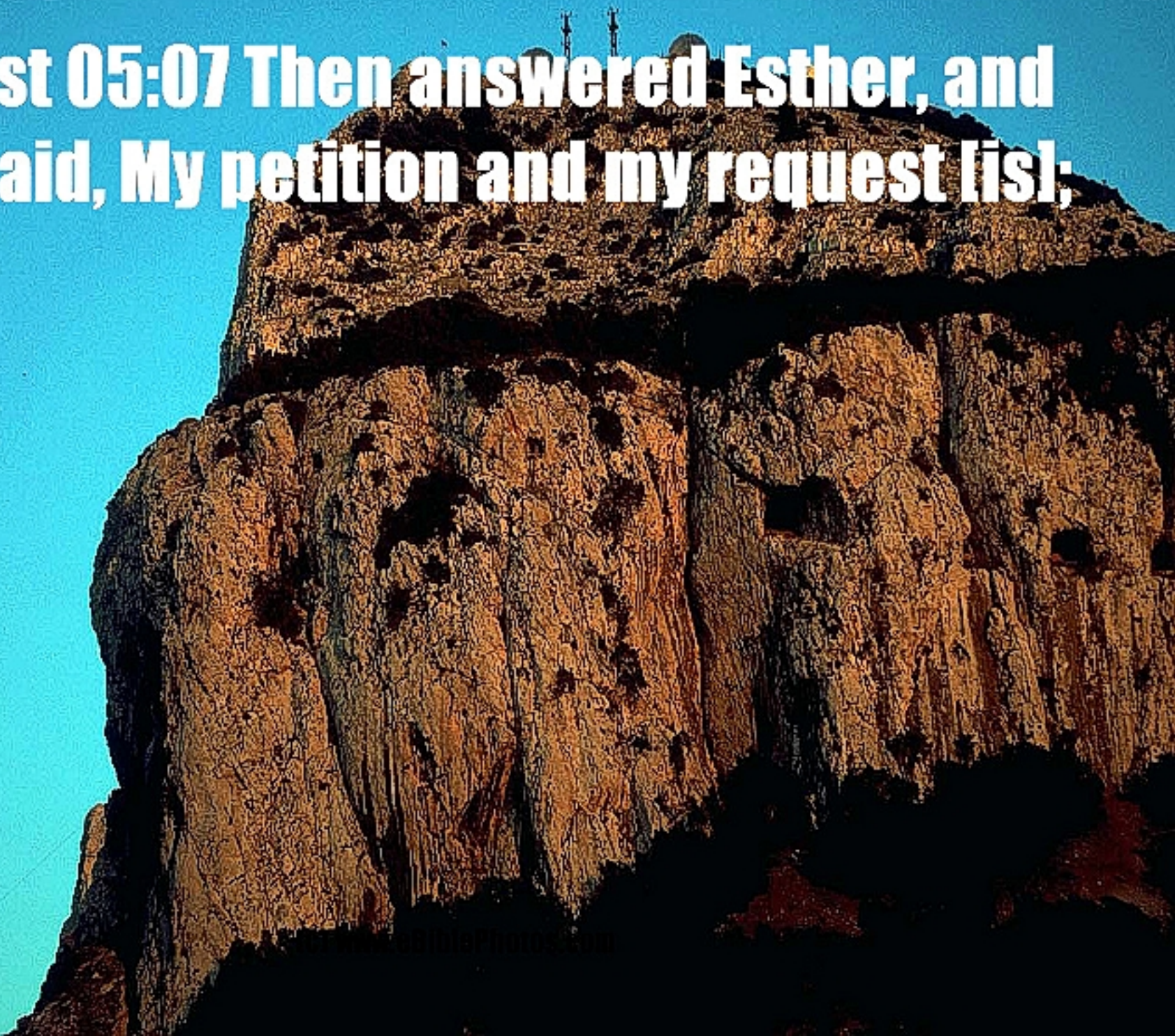
**1Sa 01:27 For this child I prayed; and

1Ki 02:16 And now I ask one petition of thee, deny me not. And she said unto him, Say on.


**1Ki 02:20 Then she said, I desire one

said, My petition and my request list;**





of the kingdom.**


