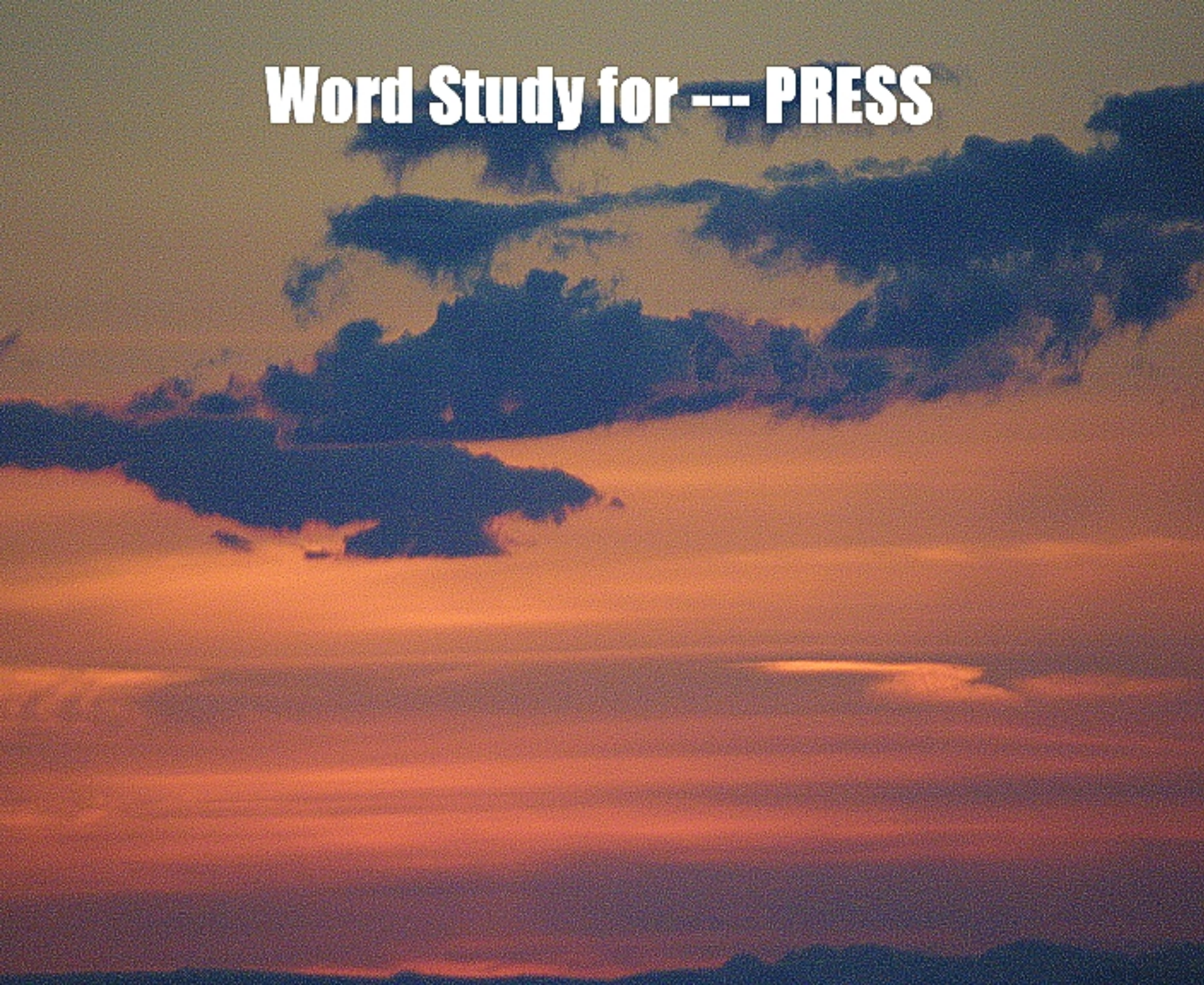



for their wickedness [is] great.**



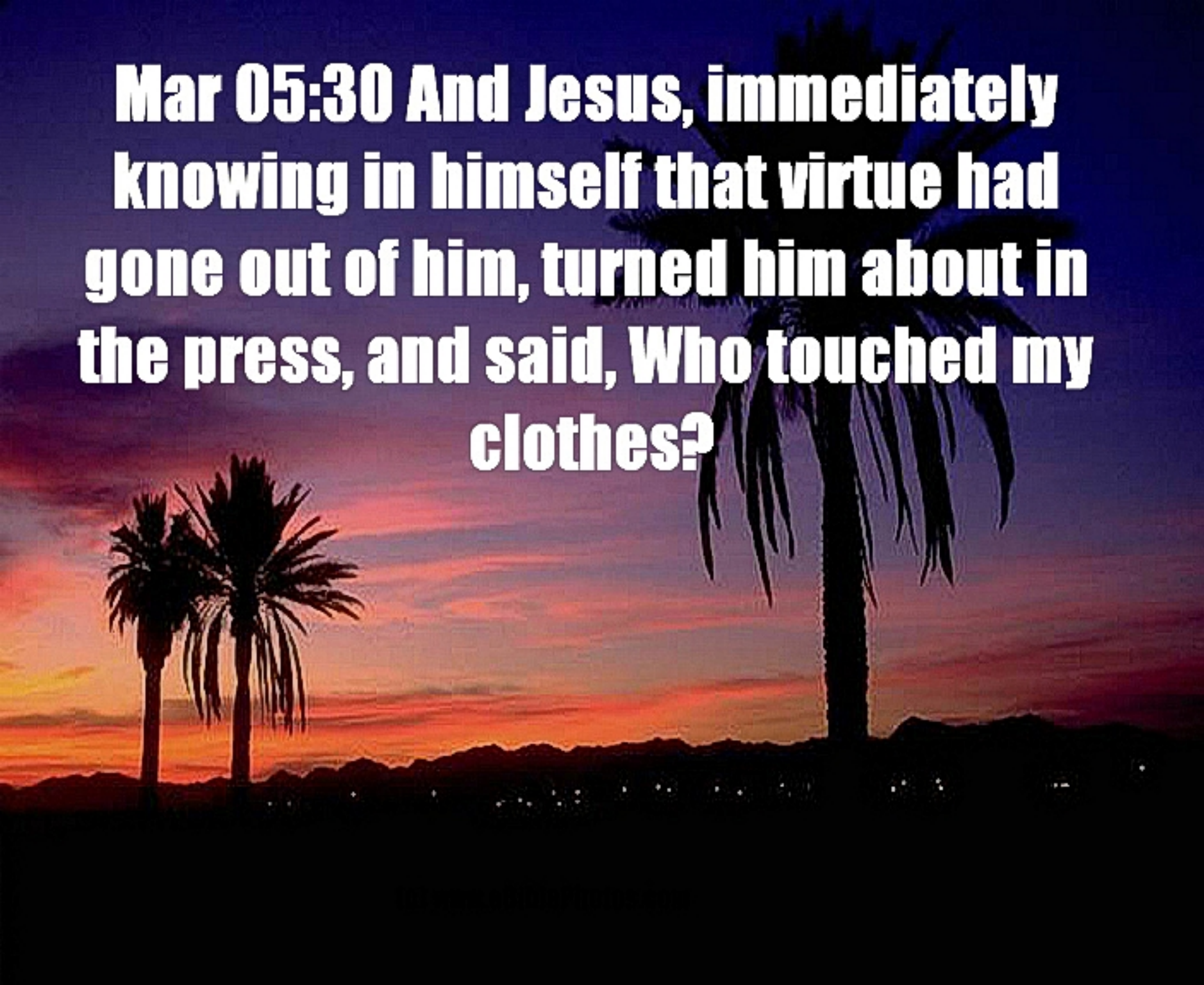
**Hag 02:16 Since those days were, when

were but twenty.**



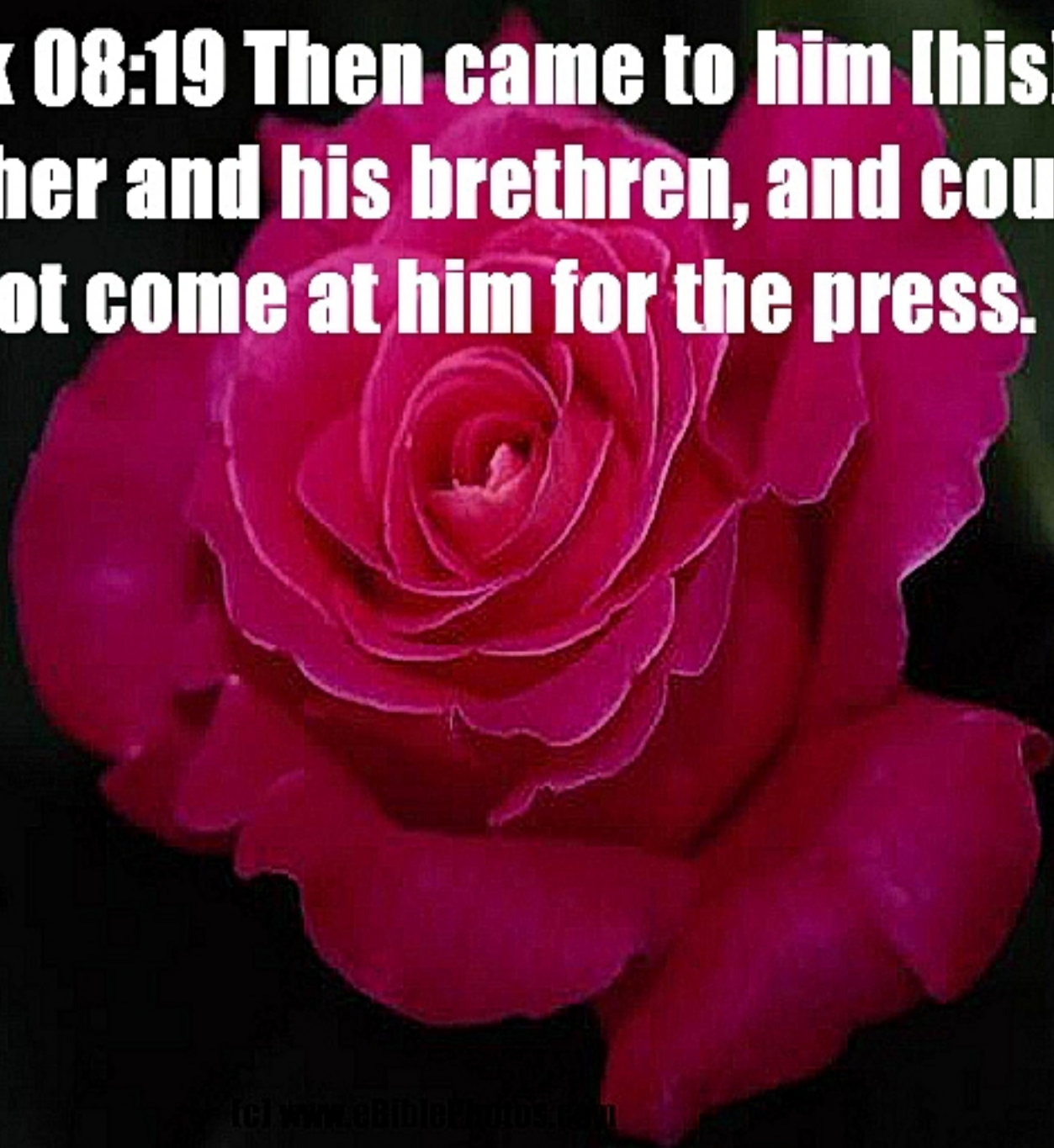
**Mar 02:04 And when they could not
